Git Gud or Get Benched sits 12th in the Hollow Knight division and in the 12th percentile of the field, and the roster doesn't offer much reason for optimism about either number improving. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and James Cook at RB5 are genuinely elite, but in a positionless format, a strong backfield only carries a team so far when the rest of the lineup is grading out near the bottom of the tournament. The quarterback situation is particularly grim: Jared Goff projects as QB16, Sam Darnold as QB21, and Aaron Rodgers as QB29, which reads less like a depth chart and more like a support group. Making matters worse, the manager grabbed Rodgers as a supposed steal, six roster slots after his ADP suggested he would still be available, so the "value" came at the cost of options that might have shored up a genuinely thin ceiling. Two major reaches, Kimani Vidal and Jalen Tolbert, round out a draft that spent capital in the wrong direction. There is no obvious lever left to pull here.

There is a particular kind of exhaustion that comes not from losing badly but from never quite having enough, and College Fantasy OG feels it heading into 2026. The roster grades out at the 20th percentile of the field, slotting 11th in the Hollow Knight division, and the draft did not generate the surplus needed to change that math. Patrick Mahomes arrives as a QB12, which sounds fine until you notice that the team burned a second-round pick on Kenneth Walker III, taken 1.3 rounds ahead of his ADP, when a more patient approach might have unlocked the kind of capital that fixes a roster at the margins. Tua Tagovailoa, reached 2.8 rounds early at QB31, is the kind of depth move that drains future flexibility rather than building it. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Kenneth Walker at RB10 give the lineup a real spine, but Jaylen Warren projecting as the weakest projected starter at RB27 is a number that points squarely at a ceiling. Last year's 47 percent win rate was not a fluke. It was a baseline, and nothing here suggests the floor has risen.

JokerChad finished 2025 in the 94th percentile and now sits at 26th percentile in tournament projections, which is the kind of freefall that demands an explanation. The receiver room looks the part on paper, Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 are legitimate stars, but the roster underneath them is held together by question marks. Rashee Rice, projected WR13 and technically a starter, is heading into the season with a knee procedure, a probation violation, and a potential jail stint shadowing his every rep. That is not a depth piece absorbing uncertainty, that is a projected starter absorbing all of it. Meanwhile, J.J. McCarthy was drafted nearly five full rounds ahead of his ADP, a QB37 whose early selection now looks like the kind of confident reach that only looks smart if everything goes right. Reputation built on a 28-8 record does not automatically transfer to a new season, and right now JokerChad is running on fumes from a 2025 that this roster, honestly, does not resemble.

TheMailMan19 finished 55th percentile last season and somehow drafted their way down from there. The top of this roster is real: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Lamar Jackson at QB3 give this team a foundation most managers would envy. But the draft unraveled almost immediately after those picks, and the evidence is damning. Five major reaches across the board, including Emanuel Wilson at a projected RB69 taken nearly seven rounds before his ADP, and Elijah Sarratt at WR98 grabbed almost seven rounds early, suggest a manager who fell in love with names and ignored the board entirely. The result is a receiving corps built around a WR18 in Emeka Egbuka and then a steep cliff to Romeo Doubs at WR53 and below. The team currently sits ninth in the Hollow Knight division and in the bottom third of the field, and there is nothing in the construction of this roster that argues those numbers are wrong. Gibbs deserves better than this draft.

Zote the Mighty did almost everything right on draft day. Fourteen chalk picks, only three minor reaches, and two values landed in the ledger, including Bhayshul Tuten and Tony Pollard, each arriving a round or more after their ADPs. The process was clean. The result is a team sitting eighth in the Hollow Knight division and in the 42nd percentile of the field, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether drafting well even matters. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is a genuine anchor, and the Caleb Williams and Rome Odunze stack gives the roster a ceiling. But projected starters like Javonte Williams at RB17 and Courtland Sutton at WR37 are useful without being special, and the lineup bottoms out at Jakobi Meyers, projected WR45. The tight end group does not project a starter worth leaning on. Zote drafted like someone who read every article and ignored none of it, and still ended up with a roster that quietly adds up to not quite enough.

Grubfather sits at the 47th percentile, and that number is almost too precise, a team built exactly well enough to hang around but not quite well enough to pull away. The foundation is genuinely excellent: Josh Allen at QB1 and Colston Loveland at TE3 give this roster two of the more reliable anchors in the field, and Travis Kelce at TE10 and Mark Andrews at TE14 only deepen that core. The problem is that the margins Grubfather needs to win close weeks are being decided by the players at the bottom of the projected lineup, and that's where the draft history tells a quieter, more uncomfortable story. Malachi Fields came off the board nearly six rounds ahead of his ADP, Christian Kirk nearly seven rounds early, and both land outside WR82 in projections. Those are the kinds of dart throws that feel clever in the moment and cost you a playoff spot in November. Allen and Loveland keep this team competitive. Fields and Kirk might keep them out of the money.

JoelCoxOn3 sits at the 49th percentile and sixth in the Hollow Knight division, which is precisely as unremarkable as it sounds, and the margin between a respectable run and an early exit probably comes down to two players pulling in opposite directions. Trey McBride at TE2 and Tyler Warren at TE4 give this roster a genuine elite foundation, and Joe Burrow at QB4 means the passing upside is real. But Jalen Hurts is the pressure point. Five straight top-10 fantasy finishes make him easy to trust, yet the departure of A.J. Brown means Hurts' arm now has to carry more weight than it ever has, and if the Philadelphia offense sputters, the rushing touchdowns that padded his fantasy floor will dry up too. A roster built on a strong top end can survive that kind of variance, but only if the rest of the lineup holds. The draft produced three values and no steals, which is the kind of efficient-but-not-inspired construction that tends to finish right around where the projections say it will.

JPW25 landed at 54th percentile and fifth in the Hollow Knight division, which sounds middling until you look at what they actually assembled. The receiver corps alone is quietly remarkable: Malik Nabers (WR12), DeVonta Smith (WR14), Tee Higgins (WR19), and Carnell Tate (WR29) are all projected starters, and that is before you factor in Brock Bowers (TE1), who is as close to a guaranteed weekly advantage as this format offers. De'Von Achane (RB6) anchors the backfield. The price paid for all of this, though, is where the story gets interesting. JPW25 pulled the board early on Fernando Mendoza (QB27), a 3.4-round reach, and swung even harder for Skyler Bell (WR103) at nearly six full rounds ahead of consensus. Neither pick looks defensible on paper. Neither one cracks the projected starting lineup. What they reveal is a manager who was chasing a vision rather than following the sheet, spending draft capital on depth bets to protect a core they clearly believed in. The core looks good. The bets may never pay off. Right now, the core is carrying the argument.

Grimm Troupe did not swing for the fences on draft day, and that restraint is exactly why they look so good heading into 2026. The engine here is a receiving corps anchored by Puka Nacua at WR1 and Drake London at WR7, both projected starters, with London landing in Grimm Troupe's hands half a round after his ADP suggested he would. That kind of quiet, repeatable efficiency is the whole story: no flashy reaches, no panic picks, just a roster that consistently came out a little ahead. Jameson Williams as a projected starter at WR21 adds genuine upside further down the board, and Tucker Kraft at TE5 gives the team a real edge at that position. The one spot that warrants watching is C.J. Stroud, the projected second quarterback, who has been sliding since an impressive debut and whose concussion-shortened 2025 did little to rebuild confidence. If Stroud finds his footing, this roster climbs. If he does not, Dak Prescott at QB7 is steady enough to keep Grimm Troupe right where they belong, which is squarely in the conversation at fourth in the Hollow Knight division.

The Mantis Lords look like a team that did their homework and then actually acted on it. The receiver group is the engine here: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, A.J. Brown at WR8, George Pickens at WR10, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 form a projected starting core that most managers in this field would trade half their roster to acquire. But what elevates this draft beyond just landing good players is the discipline behind it. Sixteen chalk picks keep the roster grounded, and the value hunting was surgical where it counted. Brian Robinson fell a staggering 3.5 rounds past his ADP and landed at RB45, a steal at a position where late-round finds are rare. Michael Wilson came in nearly two rounds late at WR39 and projects as the weakest starter, which tells you something about how deep this group runs. The one genuine cloud is George Kittle, a projected starter at TE9 who is working back from a torn Achilles and whose Week 1 availability is anything but certain. Even with that caveat, third in the division and 73rd percentile overall is a floor that looks beatable.

dcaron28 didn't chase the big swing. There's no single jaw-dropping steal that anchors this roster, just a draft that kept finding value round after round and arriving at a lineup that sits in the 80th percentile of the field. The engine of it all is a backfield headlined by Bijan Robinson (RB2) and Omarion Hampton (RB9), two projected starters who give this team a ceiling most managers can't touch. Then there's the Nix-Waddle stack, which quietly might be one of the more underrated connections in the tournament. Jaylen Waddle spent last year grinding through a dysfunctional Miami offense and still produced. Now he moves to Denver alongside Bo Nix, who led the league in pass attempts, and the arrow is pointed sharply upward. Harold Fannin (TE6) rounds out a starting group that has almost no weak links, with Chris Godwin (WR38) functioning as the floor rather than the ceiling. Coming off a 75 percent win rate in 2025, dcaron28 looks less like a fluke and more like a blueprint.

bumzhabum sits first in the Hollow Knight division and in the 85th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. This team was built with the patience of someone who actually read the room. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 form a genuinely elite foundation, and then bumzhabum kept adding quality without chasing names off the board. Jayden Daniels, a QB5 projection, slipped to the fourth round when his ADP said he should have been gone in the third, and bumzhabum was right there. Jake Ferguson fell two full rounds past his ADP and lands as a projected starter at TE12. That is the kind of discipline that separates a good draft from a clean one. Bucky Irving, Rhamondre Stevenson, and Michael Pittman all came in at better value than the market expected. The steals and values outnumber the reaches by a margin that does not exist anywhere on this sheet, because bumzhabum never had any reaches to count.
