Rolys Raiders drafted like someone who had a plan, abandoned it around round six, and never found it again. The foundation is not embarrassing: Jaxon Smith-Njigba (WR3) is legitimate, Saquon Barkley (RB8) and Derrick Henry (RB12) give this roster real teeth in the backfield, and a Jordan Love (QB17) and Tucker Kraft (TE5) stack adds a floor most teams would take. But then the wheels come off in the way only a draft with four major reaches and zero steals can manage. Dallas Goedert was yanked off the board 2.4 rounds early at TE15, which is a steep price for a secondary tight end when the starter is already locked in. Tre Tucker was gone 4.4 rounds ahead of his ADP, and Elijah Sarratt was taken 7.4 rounds early, a number that belongs in a cautionary tale rather than a championship contender. The 2025 squad finished in the seventh percentile, and with a 12th-place divisional projection, the 2026 version appears to have learned nothing.

BBakeSleeper sits 11th in the Halo division and down in the 14th percentile of the field, and the draft record does not offer much hope that a correction is coming. The roster does carry genuine top-end talent: Josh Allen is a QB1 and CeeDee Lamb checks in at WR5, and both slid past their ADPs, which is exactly the kind of early-round fortune a manager needs. The problem is that the draft went sideways after those picks. Patrick Mahomes, a QB12, was taken nearly two rounds ahead of his ADP, and Josh Jacobs, a RB16, cost a similar premium at RB. Paying early-round prices for mid-tier production is how a roster gets thin in the middle, and thin in the middle is exactly what this one looks like, with Rhamondre Stevenson, a RB31, projected as the weakest starter. Allen and Lamb are real, but they cannot carry a lineup that was built with more enthusiasm than patience, and right now there is no obvious lever left to pull.

codystoots enters 2026 sitting 10th in the Halo division, and the numbers offer little reason for optimism. Last season's 28% win rate and 17th-percentile scoring were not a fluke, and the projected outlook this year is nearly as grim, landing at the 21st percentile of the field. The running back group looks genuinely impressive on paper, with James Cook at RB5 and De'Von Achane at RB6 among the starters, but the draft board tells a messier story: Achane was taken 0.6 rounds early, and the depth behind him was assembled almost entirely through reaches, with Kyle Monangai pulled two full rounds ahead of his ADP and projected as the weakest starter at RB33. Meanwhile, the quarterback situation is quietly catastrophic. Baker Mayfield at QB18 is the best of a group that also includes Aaron Rodgers at QB29 and Geno Smith at QB30, and in a positionless format where every roster spot matters, carrying that kind of dead weight at the position is a slow leak that no amount of Cook or Achane can fully patch.

MrYeahSports arrives in 2026 carrying the weight of a 6-30 record from a season that ranked in the 5th percentile in scoring, and the forecast for improvement is, to put it charitably, grim. Sitting 9th in the Halo division and in just the 22nd percentile of the field, the roster grades out as a team that drafted mostly to chalk without generating the upside needed to climb out. The draft board tells the story: two major reaches, including Alvin Kamara four rounds before the market agreed, and Kenneth Walker III nearly a full round early, burning capital on aging or uncertain contributors when patience might have delivered better. Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Caleb Williams at QB6 are legitimate building blocks, and the Kyler Murray and Jefferson stack adds a modest floor-raising wrinkle, but the projected starters behind that top tier thin out fast, with Jadarian Price grading as the weakest projected starter at RB26. There is no obvious lever left to pull, no late steal that changes the math, and last year's scoring history suggests this team has earned its skeptics.

artlessfuror enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Halo division and projected at just the 25th percentile of the field, and the draft record does not offer much reason for optimism. The most glaring problem is at quarterback, where Daniel Jones, projected QB25, was reached for a stunning 4.2 rounds before his consensus ADP. That kind of premium on a QB25 is the fantasy equivalent of paying first-class prices for a middle seat, and it leaves the starting lineup anchored to a player who grades out as one of the weakest projected starters in the entire tournament. The skill positions have some genuine bright spots, Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Tyler Warren at TE4 are legitimate building blocks, but a roster projected this deep in the field needs more than two anchors carrying the weight. With three major reaches scattered across the draft and zero steals to show for it, artlessfuror has very little surplus value waiting in reserve. There is no obvious corrective move, no hidden gem poised to flip the outlook. This one looks like a long season.

brentwalker2 enters 2026 sitting seventh in the Halo division and in just the 27th percentile of the field, and nothing in this roster construction suggests a dramatic reversal is coming. The headliner is Christian McCaffrey at RB3, which is a genuinely elite asset, but after him the projections get murky fast. The wide receiver group grades out weak, with Tee Higgins at WR19 and Jameson Williams at WR21 carrying the load while Brandon Aiyuk sits at a discouraging WR81. The quarterback situation offers little comfort either, as Drake Maye projects as a QB2 but C.J. Stroud checks in at QB22, and reaching a round early in the draft for Stroud looks like a decision that may haunt the back half of the season. Perhaps most telling is that the draft produced zero steals and zero values across the entire board, only chalk and minor reaches. A team built this way needs everything to break right, and this roster, as currently projected, looks more like a repeat of last year's 44 percent win rate than a legitimate contender.

justinsonier is the team you glance at in the standings and immediately forget, which is precisely the kind of team that sneaks into the money when the margins break right. The top of this roster is genuinely dangerous: Jonathan Taylor at RB4, Drake London at WR7, A.J. Brown at WR8, and Malik Nabers at WR12 form a starting core that can hang with anyone in the Halo division. Brown and Nabers both fell past their ADPs, meaning justinsonier got quality at a discount, and a working Jaxson Dart and Nabers stack gives the lineup a ceiling most teams in the 40th percentile cannot manufacture. The problem is the floor. RJ Harvey projects as the weakest projected starter at RB28, and a 2025 campaign that finished in the 18th percentile of scoring is a reminder that upside and output are different things. This team does not need everything to go right, but it needs enough to go right, and in the Scott Fish Bowl, that distinction is where seasons are decided.

dben13 finished 2026 at 44th percentile, which is the fantasy equivalent of a firm handshake: professional, forgettable, and unlikely to leave a mark. The core is genuinely good. Joe Burrow at QB4 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 are legitimate difference-makers, and Colston Loveland landing at TE3 while sliding to a third-round pick was one of the cleaner values in the draft. But the margins are exactly where this roster gets complicated. Bhayshul Tuten was a two-round reach at RB25, and Mac Jones at QB39 was taken more than five rounds ahead of his ADP, which means two roster spots carried real opportunity cost. The projected starters are fine across the board, but fine is a precarious place to live in the Halo Division. A couple of injury breaks go the right way and this team pushes into the top third of the field. A couple go the wrong way and fifth place in the division looks optimistic. Nothing here is decided, which is either exciting or exhausting depending on how you're wired.

Bushyhead didn't win the draft with one thunderclap pick. They won it by repeatedly letting the board come to them. Lamar Jackson at QB3 slid nearly half a round past his ADP before Bushyhead grabbed him at 2.09, and George Kittle and Isaiah Likely, projected TE9 and TE13, both fell roughly a round and a half beyond where the field expected them to go. Layer in Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, Rashee Rice at WR13, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 as projected starters, and you have a team that quietly assembled one of the more dangerous collections of playmakers in the Halo division. The Christian Kirk reach, taken more than four rounds ahead of ADP, is the one moment where discipline wavered, but Kirk sits far enough down the depth chart that the damage is limited. Finishing in the 77th percentile of the field is a step up from a 39th-percentile scoring season in 2025, and this roster, built on patience and a knack for finding where value pooled, looks like a legitimate threat to take another step forward.

CSmithTFDR finished 25-11 last season and landed in the 89th percentile in scoring, and the 2026 draft suggests the floor is staying right where it was. The headline is the receiver group, where Puka Nacua (WR1), Nico Collins (WR9), George Pickens (WR10), and Zay Flowers (WR16) give this team a starting collection that most managers would trade half their draft for, and every one of them projects as a starter. What makes the draft quietly impressive is how the value was spread around rather than concentrated in one lucky fall. Travis Kelce (TE10) slid nearly two rounds past his ADP, and Brock Purdy (QB13) came nearly a round and a half late as well, both landing as projected starters. Cam Ward (QB23) fell two and a half rounds, arriving at 12.12 as a genuine late-draft bonus. Against that backdrop, the Emanuel Wilson reach at nearly seven rounds early stings a little, but this is a team that built its edge through patience and positioning, and 86th percentile says the approach is working.

Cwalk15 sits at 95th percentile in the field and second in the Halo division, and the draft tells you exactly why. This roster was built with discipline, not desperation: 4 values, 1 steal, and only a single minor reach across the entire board. The steal is Trevor Lawrence, a QB10 projection snagged at pick 7.05 when his ADP sat at 4.11, nearly two and a half rounds of free equity. Lawrence earned that projection honestly, coming off a career year with 4,000 passing yards, nearly 30 passing scores, and a career-high 9 rushing touchdowns, all while his top weapons underperformed around him. The floor is that intriguing. Pair him with Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 anchoring the lineup, and Chris Olave sliding in as a WR11 who fell almost a full round past his ADP, and Cwalk15 has done something genuinely difficult in SFB: built a roster where the weakest projected starter is Jordan Addison at WR43. That is not a flaw. That is construction.

Ball So Hard didn't lunge for a single transformative pick and still landed at the top of the Halo division and the 98th percentile of the entire field, which tells you something about how quietly relentless this draft was. The foundation is the tight end pairing of Brock Bowers and Trey McBride, projected TE1 and TE2 respectively, both secured at good value relative to their ADP, and Harold Fannin at TE6 rounds out a group that gives this team a week-to-week advantage at one of the most volatile spots in positionless formats. Then consider that Jalen Hurts, projected QB9, was sitting there at pick 6.02 when his ADP was closer to the third round, a two-round gift that most managers in this field would frame on their wall. Jayden Daniels at QB5 came nearly a full round late as well. Ball So Hard didn't just find one discount and coast; they found value early, found it again late, and built a starting lineup with no obvious soft spot. The 2025 squad scored at the 72nd percentile. This one looks capable of more.
