Mission Control is sitting at the bottom of the Space Invaders division and projecting in the 9th percentile of the field, and the roster construction makes it hard to see how that changes. The receiver group is genuinely impressive on paper, with Justin Jefferson, Drake London, DeVonta Smith, and Ladd McConkey all projecting as starters, but this is a positionless format and all that receiving talent still needs someone to feed it. That someone is Kyler Murray, who grades out as a QB19 and whose path to relevance runs directly through Jefferson. The Jefferson-Murray connection in Minnesota carries real hope, given that Jefferson's 2025 struggles tracked more with JJ McCarthy than with any decline in Jefferson's own ability, but "real hope" is not the same as "reliable production," and Murray is still in a competition for the starting job. The draft offered little relief, with two major reaches and zero steals across the board. Mission Control went 18-18 last season sitting in the 62nd percentile in scoring. This year the arrow is pointing the wrong direction.

There is a particular misery reserved for the manager who did everything right and still ends up here. bigharrywang ran one of the cleaner drafts in the Space Invaders division, with 18 chalk picks, one modest value, and not a single major reach on the board. The process was sound. The result is an 11th-place division projection sitting at the 28th percentile of the field. The problem is not how the picks were made, it is what the picks produced: a starting receiver corps anchored by Jordyn Tyson at WR34 and Xavier Worthy at WR49, which is the kind of ceiling that makes Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 feel almost beside the point. You can have two projected top-10 players at their position and still finish near the bottom if the depth of your scoring options flattens out fast, and that is exactly the math working against this roster. bigharrywang trusted the board, the board cooperated, and the universe did not care. That is the cruelest kind of losing.

brascodubs enters 2026 sitting 10th in the Space Invaders division and in the bottom third of the field, and the roster makes it hard to argue with either number. The one genuine anchor here is Ja'Marr Chase, projected WR2, and he is doing a lot of heavy lifting for a team that otherwise grades out as frustratingly middling at almost every turn. Caleb Williams slots in as a QB6 with real upside, but the supporting cast thins out quickly: Rhamondre Stevenson projects as RB31 and is the weakest projected starter on the board. The draft did nothing to change the calculus, producing zero steals and zero values against 13 chalk picks and two major reaches, including Chris Brazzell II taken more than six rounds ahead of his ADP. And then there is Dalton Kincaid, projected TE11, who comes attached to a knee injury that Bills GM Brandon Beane described as too early to call for 2026. Chase is the kind of player you can build around, but brascodubs may not have enough left around him to matter.

We Will Brock You sits ninth in the Space Invaders division and in just the 33rd percentile of the field, and the roster underneath those numbers does not argue back. The foundation is genuinely elite at one position, Brock Bowers checking in as TE1 with Oronde Gadsden and Hunter Henry offering real depth behind him, but that strength does not travel far enough up the standings on its own. The rest of the projected starters are a study in mediocrity: Travis Etienne at RB18, RJ Harvey at RB28, and Tee Higgins at WR19 are capable players who project as middling contributors, not difference-makers. The draft board compounds the problem. Two major reaches, Hunter Henry at TE18 pulled three-plus rounds early and Jayden Higgins at WR54 grabbed nearly three rounds before his market price, suggest a manager who paid premium costs for players who project to return value-priced results. Joe Burrow and Higgins form a promising stack, but Burrow grading out as QB4 is the kind of ceiling that makes you feel better about a team than the surrounding pieces deserve.

The Shraminators enter 2026 as a team that looks better on paper than it probably is in practice, which is a polite way of saying the paper is not very good either. The backfield is legitimately elite, Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and De'Von Achane at RB6 giving this roster a foundation most managers would envy, but the draft decisions surrounding that foundation are harder to defend. Taking Achane at 1.09 when his ADP sat at 2.07 is one thing, a modest aggression, but reaching 4.5 rounds early for Brandon Aiyuk, who projects as WR81, and 3.3 rounds early for Rashid Shaheed at WR57 suggests a manager who kept forcing the issue long after the market was telling them to stop. This is a positionless format, so quality is everything, and outside of McCaffrey and Achane, the projected starters are not inspiring confidence. The 2025 campaign finished in the 30th percentile of scoring, and nothing about this offseason suggests the Shraminators have found the lever that changes that trajectory.

Blueset enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting seventh in the Space Invaders division and in just the 41st percentile of the field, and the roster offers little reason for optimism. The headliners are real, Lamar Jackson rates out as a QB3 and CeeDee Lamb as a WR5, and the Prescott-Lamb stack adds a layer of upside on the right week. But after those anchors, the floor drops quickly. The projected starters include Mike Evans at WR27, Omarion Hampton at RB9, and Kyren Williams at RB15, solid enough names, but the depth behind them is where things get uncomfortable, with Jayden Reed projecting as the weakest starter at WR48. The draft did not do much to change the trajectory either, producing zero steals and only three values against one major reach in Elic Ayomanor, taken more than five rounds before his ADP. Blueset is not without talent at the top, but this is a roster that needs everything to break right, and the construction suggests it probably will not.

The Joshfather sits at 43rd percentile in the field, and nothing about this roster screams "move the needle." The top end is legitimately good: Josh Allen is a QB1, Saquon Barkley projects as RB8, and the Allen/D.J. Moore stack gives the manager bonus equity when Buffalo moves the ball. But the margins cut both ways here. The draft featured four major reaches, and two of the most glaring ones, Rachaad White at RB39 and Ted Hurst at WR85, were taken two and four-plus rounds early, respectively. Those late-round decisions matter in a format where tournament survival often comes down to which bench pieces actually deliver. Derrick Henry at RB12 is a fine player, but pulling him at 2.10 against an ADP of 4.01 meant overpaying for production that was already priced into the market. The Joshfather is not losing this season because of its stars. It may lose it because the cost of those stars in draft capital left the depth without a safety net when the ceiling cases didn't pan out.

ryankirby915 didn't need a home run swing to build something worth watching in the Space Invaders division. The WR group alone makes a case: Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), Tetairoa McMillan (WR15), Zay Flowers (WR16), and Luther Burden (WR22) are all projected starters, and that depth doesn't come from luck, it comes from a draft that kept finding value on the way down. Brock Purdy (QB13) arriving in the seventh round when his ADP sat nearly two rounds earlier is exactly the kind of quiet win that separates good drafters from great ones, even if the injury cloud hovering over San Francisco's receiving corps makes him a genuine week-to-week concern. The Mac Jones (QB39) spend fifteen rounds early is puzzling and worth watching as a potential drag, but this roster has enough projected production baked in that one late-round misfire doesn't crack the foundation. At 47th percentile entering 2026, there's upside here that the number undersells.

ItsTeraTime did not win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by being right, repeatedly. Five value selections and a steal across the board paint the picture of a manager who let the board come to them, and the results show up all over the starting lineup. Trey McBride at TE2 and Colston Loveland at TE3 form the kind of elite top-end advantage that quietly inflates a roster's ceiling week after week, and Chris Olave at WR11 and Rashee Rice at WR13 give this team legitimate receiver equity before you even get to Emeka Egbuka at WR18, who fell a full round past his ADP into the fifth. The Baker Mayfield and Egbuka stack and the Tyler Shough and Olave stack add upside correlation to what is already a well-constructed floor. The reaches on Kenneth Gainwell and Keenan Allen are real blemishes, and the quarterback group is the thinnest part of the roster by projection. But a 69 percent win rate in 2025 suggests this manager knows how to convert talent into results, and the 2026 build gives them plenty of talent to work with.

Wont U B My Nabers didn't win the draft in one flashy moment. They won it in increments, pick after pick, until the scorecard looked almost unfair. Jahmyr Gibbs lands as RB1 and anchors everything, but the supporting work is where this team quietly separated itself. Malik Nabers slid a full round past his ADP and came off the board as a projected WR12 starter. Brian Thomas Jr. fell a round and a half before this team scooped him at WR31. George Kittle, when healthy a genuinely dominant fantasy force, dropped nearly two rounds before landing here as a projected TE9. The asterisk on Kittle comes with real uncertainty after a late-2025 Achilles tear, and his Week 1 availability is anything but guaranteed, but even accounting for that risk, the value captured across this draft is difficult to argue with. Three values, one outright steal, and barely a whiff of regret anywhere in the first dozen rounds. That kind of consistent execution is how a team earns a 78th-percentile projection, not with one swing, but with seventeen good decisions.

thomas1991 sits second in the Space Invaders division and in the 83rd percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains why without any single flashy moment carrying the load. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and A.J. Brown at WR8 form a top-end receiving pair that most managers would envy, and Brown arriving a round later than his ADP suggested he should is exactly the kind of quiet draft-room win that separates good rosters from great ones. Tucker Kraft at TE5 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 give this team two genuinely elite options at a position where most of the field is scraping. The big value play, though, is Kyle Monangai at RB33, who slipped more than three full rounds past his expected landing spot, sitting in thomas1991's lap at pick 15.07 when his ADP implied he'd be long gone by then. Fourteen chalk picks in a draft would normally read as passive, but when you're landing Brown ahead of schedule and Monangai as an afterthought, chalk just means you knew what you were doing.

Nacua Matata is sitting at the top of the Space Invaders division for a reason, and that reason is craft. This roster was built with the kind of quiet discipline that separates good drafters from great ones: seven values pulled across the board, zero major reaches, and a projected WR1 in Puka Nacua landed at 1.06 when his ADP sat at 1.01. That is not luck, that is timing. Drake Maye comes in as a projected QB2, taken at 2.07 with value still on the board. Harold Fannin at TE6 fell more than a round past his ADP and slots in as a starter. The weakest projected starter is Michael Pittman at WR44, which tells you everything, a receiver integrating into a new offense alongside DK Metcalf in Pittsburgh, and that is the floor. A 94th-percentile tournament ranking with a 64 percent win rate from 2025 as the foundation, this team does not have a glaring flaw to exploit. Nacua Matata came to draft, and it shows.
