As the 2025 fantasy football season looms, David Leisure finds itself at the bottom of the Indiana Pacers division and on the fringes of the competitive spectrum. Ranked 12th in their division and languishing in the unenviable 0 percentile overall, the team faces an uphill battle in the months ahead. Their roster is a curious mix of strengths and glaring weaknesses, particularly at the running back position where Bhayshul Tuten's performance as RB45 leaves much to be desired. However, their tight ends remain a beacon of hope, boasting the most formidable lineup in the division with Trey McBride, George Kittle, Dalton Kincaid, and Isaiah Likely—the latter of whom, despite being TE18, is still set to start. Their wide receiver corps, led by Puka Nacua, ranks 8th in the division and offers some flashes of potential with names like Tetairoa McMillan and Deebo Samuel. Strategic decisions during the draft saw some players selected at great value, such as Jordan Love and Dalton Kincaid, while others like Jaxson Dart and Isaiah Likely were acquired much sooner than consensus

rankings would advise, casting a shadow over their roster management. With a season poised on the precipice of the unexpected, David Leisure must navigate their options carefully if they hope to rise above their early season projections.

Reaching embarrassingly early for Joe Burrow and Davante Adams has drained their roster of potential depth, and the inclusion of Tre Harris as a starter, despite being a lackluster WR55, highlights glaring weaknesses in their receiving corps. Even their expected strengths feel shaky, with Amon-Ra St. Brown anchoring a WR group that needs miracles to salvage

their position. Without significant turnarounds or unexpected breakouts, Nuckin Futs may find themselves enduring a long and frustrating season, struggling to differentiate from the pack and facing an uphill battle in every matchup.

The team boasts a strong quarterback lineup with stalwarts like Patrick Mahomes, Caleb Williams, and J.J. McCarthy, offering a glimmer of hope to lead the charge. However, the wide receiver corps leaves much to be desired, where Marvin Mims, who ranks 56th at his position, is unfortunately a projected starter, underscoring a glaring weakness in their lineup. On the brighter side, Brock Bowers, ranked as the top tight end in this TE Premium format, adds crucial depth and is expected to be a key contributor. While the running backs are solid with Josh Jacobs and promising talents like Omarion Hampton and

TreVeyon Henderson, it's the team's bold drafting strategies that stand out; securing Caleb Williams and J.J. McCarthy well below their ADPs was a masterstroke that could pay dividends. Despite some questionable early picks like Trey Benson and Marvin Mims, mikeymo1525's reliance on strategic stack bonuses with Mahomes and Xavier Worthy may add a competitive edge. As they march into the season, the team hopes these calculated risks and youthful exuberance can propel them beyond their current standings, though they know full well that the road ahead will test every ounce of their resilience.
