There is a particular kind of fatigue that sets in when you look at a roster and realize the ceiling and the floor are uncomfortably close together. FFJonny is staring at that reality heading into 2026, sitting 12th in the Jak & Dexter division and projecting in just the 7th percentile of the field. The draft offered the clearest window into how this team got here: no steals, no values, 13 chalk picks, and two major reaches headlined by Patrick Mahomes, taken nearly three rounds ahead of his ADP and projecting as QB12. Brock Bowers at TE1 is a genuine anchor, and the cluster of projected starters around Zay Flowers, Jameson Williams, and Christian Watson gives this roster a functional pulse. But functional is doing a lot of heavy lifting when your last-place finisher in the starting lineup is a TE20 in Juwan Johnson, and your 2025 season produced a 19 percent win rate. FFJonny is not rebuilding. FFJonny is just hoping the projections are wrong.

PortArthur409 sits 11th in the Jak & Dexter division and in the 9th percentile of the field, and the roster anatomy explains why. The draft was defined by impatience at running back: Kyren Williams cost 2.3 rounds more than his ADP warranted, Chase Brown cost 1.1 rounds more, and both are projected starters worth owning at the right price rather than the price paid. That kind of draft capital inefficiency compounds quickly when your projected floor is already this low. Josh Allen is the obvious anchor and the Allen/D.J. Moore stack adds a layer of upside, but the rest of the lineup grades out as thoroughly average, with Romeo Doubs sitting at WR53 as the weakest projected starter. Mike Evans, now in San Francisco after his injury-shortened final season in Tampa Bay snapped an 11-year consecutive 1,000-yard streak, feels more like a prayer than a plan at this stage of his career. When your best hope is that several middling projections are wrong simultaneously, you are not building toward something. You are waiting on luck.

msc7363 sits 10th in the Jak & Dexter division and in just the 28th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason to expect a turnaround. Twelve chalk picks and five minor reaches with zero steals means this roster was built without the surplus value that separates contenders from also-rans in a tournament this competitive. The backfield is genuinely strong, with Jonathan Taylor (RB4) and Kenneth Walker III (RB10) anchoring a group that grades out well, but the supporting cast fades quickly, and the projected starters thin out enough that RJ Harvey (RB28) is the weakest link among them. The receiver group is average at best, with Emeka Egbuka (WR18) and Luther Burden (WR22) providing a reasonable top end but Wan'Dale Robinson (WR47) arriving two-plus rounds earlier than his WR47 projection could ever justify. The one bright spot is a Baker Mayfield / Egbuka stack that could pop on the right week, but hoping a stack carries a bottom-tier roster through a full season is less a strategy than a prayer.

There is no delicate way to put this: Daxter is a bottom-third team in the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl, sitting ninth in the division and projected around the 30th percentile of the field, and the roster does not hide why. The receiver room is genuinely excellent, with Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), Justin Jefferson (WR6), and Chris Olave (WR11) forming a legitimate top-tier core, and Harold Fannin (TE6), George Kittle (TE9), and Travis Kelce (TE10) give this team more at tight end than most managers could dream of. But the running back group is soft at the top, and that drags the whole projected floor down in a format where you need quality depth at every turn. What makes the outlook harder to stomach is that the draft did not surface a hidden gem to change the calculus. Two major reaches, Harold Fannin burned 1.4 rounds early and Michael Mayer burned 4.4, consumed capital that might have addressed the thin backfield. The stars are real. The path to contention is not.

SiegelFF enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Jak & Dexter division and projecting at just the 37th percentile of the field, and the roster's construction does not suggest a dramatic reversal is coming. The single biggest lever on this team is Joe Burrow, a QB4 talent who, when healthy, is as good as it gets at the position, but "when healthy" is doing an enormous amount of work in that sentence. Burrow has missed massive stretches in multiple seasons, including nearly all of 2026 with a grade-3 turf toe injury, and betting a fantasy season on his availability is a wager this roster can barely afford to lose. The Burrow and Tee Higgins stack is a genuine asset, and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and DeVonta Smith at WR14 give the team a real foundation, but after those names the lineup grades out thin, with Josh Downs projecting as the weakest projected starter at WR46. A 44 percent win rate and a 48th percentile scoring season in 2025 suggest this is not a team trending upward, and nothing in this draft, which produced three major reaches and zero steals, changes that math.

Dark Jax for the win. sits seventh in the Jak & Dexter division and checks in at just the 39th percentile of the field, and there is not much in the draft history to suggest a turnaround is coming. The roster has genuine upside at the top, with Jahmyr Gibbs projected as the overall RB1 and Tyler Warren slotting in as TE4, but the supporting cast thins out fast and the draft did nothing to paper over that. Twelve chalk picks and zero steals is a draft that trusted the process and got back exactly what it paid for, while two major reaches compounded the damage. Trey Benson, grabbed 6.6 rounds ahead of his ADP, grades out as RB64, and Brenton Strange cost a sixth-round pick for a TE17 projection that probably did not require that kind of urgency. When your margin for error is already thin, spending premium draft capital to land players projected this low is not bold roster building, it is paying full price for a discount product. Gibbs and Warren give this team a floor, but a floor is not a ceiling.

PopelsDope24 sits at 64th percentile in the field and sixth in the Jak & Dexter division, and the draft that got them there was less about home runs than about relentless competence. The anchor is Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, a genuinely elite projection that gives this roster a ceiling most managers in this tournament cannot match. Colston Loveland at TE3 and Sam LaPorta at TE8 add another layer of projected starter quality that kept showing up round after round. The values reinforce the same story: Jadarian Price at RB26 fell nearly two rounds past his ADP, and Jordan Mason at RB41 slipped even further. Neither is a star, but both arrived at a discount, which is exactly how a draft built on accumulation is supposed to work. Jaxson Dart stacking with Isaiah Likely gives the roster a correlated upside piece that could punch above its weight on a big week. This team did not win the draft in one moment. It just kept not losing it.

First Hit Basher didn't win the draft on one flashy pick. They won it by repeatedly being in the right place when the board slipped. Kyle Pitts fell nearly two full rounds before this team grabbed him at TE7, and Dak Prescott slid a round and change before landing as a QB7 anchor who also connects with Jake Ferguson in a stack that adds another layer of upside. Quentin Johnston arrived a round late as well, and while he projects as the weakest starter on the roster at WR41, the fact that a WR41 is the soft spot tells you something about the depth above him. Garrett Wilson at WR17 and Nico Collins at WR9 are legitimate building blocks, and Bijan Robinson at RB2 gives the team a true bell cow at the top. The major reaches on Jordan James and Skyler Bell are real, but they live at the back end of the roster where swings cost less. This team sits 66th percentile in the field, fifth in the Jak and Dexter division, and drafts a strong enough top line to make both of those numbers look improvable.

Pausa de Hidratacin didn't splash on a single flashy move, and that's exactly what makes this roster worth respecting. The draft was a quiet accumulation of correct decisions: Quinshon Judkins landed nearly two rounds after his ADP suggested he would, and Denzel Boston and Malik Washington each slipped almost two rounds past consensus before this manager scooped them up. That kind of patience, repeated across the board, is how you build a team that holds up. At the top, Jayden Daniels projects as QB5 and Trey McBride as TE2, giving the roster a genuine foundation rather than a lottery ticket. Drake London at WR7 and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 only deepen it. The one legitimate question mark is Brian Thomas Jr., a projected WR31 whose 2025 season raised real doubts about his chemistry with Trevor Lawrence after a dazzling debut. If Thomas rediscovers that connection, this team climbs. If he doesn't, the depth cushions the blow. Fourth in the division and 68th percentile in the field is fine for now. The ceiling is higher than that.

mjivler didn't win the draft on one flashy pick. They won it the same way a good poker player wins a session, by consistently getting more than they paid for. The centerpiece of that approach is a receiver group that reads like a fever dream: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, CeeDee Lamb at WR5, George Pickens at WR10, and Malik Nabers at WR12, all projected starters, all anchoring a lineup that sits at 74th percentile before a single snap is played. What makes it sharper is how it was assembled. Lamb fell to pick 2.04 against an ADP of 1.11, Pickens slipped nearly a full round, and DK Metcalf came nearly a round late at WR36. Five values drafted, zero major reaches, and the two minor reaches, Jordan Love and Troy Franklin, were calculated bets rather than desperation moves. Third in the Jak and Dexter division is the current standing, but this roster has the texture of a team that finishes well ahead of that projection.

DustinF10 didn't stumble into a good roster. This team was built with intention, and the draft sheet backs it up: five values landed, zero reaches taken, a clean ledger that reflects the kind of patience most managers preach and few actually practice. The headliners are exactly what you want. Lamar Jackson sits at QB3, Jalen Hurts at QB9, and Christian McCaffrey anchors the backfield at RB3, giving this team a ceiling that genuinely warrants the 86th percentile tournament standing it earned. But the craftwork shows in the margins. Saquon Barkley fell nearly a full round past his ADP before DustinF10 scooped him at RB8. Tucker Kraft slipped over a round to become the TE5 on this roster. TreVeyon Henderson drifted a full round and landed at RB19. Those are not accidents, those are a manager reading a draft room and taking what the table offers. The weakest projected starter is Tony Pollard at RB30, which tells you everything about how much runway exists at the top of this lineup.

CrazySteeveeee didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. The roster was built the way good rosters get built, by coming out ahead on deal after deal until the advantages stacked up into something formidable. Puka Nacua landed as WR1 and anchors a receiving group that also includes A.J. Brown at WR8 and Rashee Rice at WR13, with Rice arriving as a value after sliding nearly a full round past his ADP. On the ground, James Cook at RB5 and Derrick Henry at RB12 were both taken after the market had already moved on, which is how you build a position from the top down without paying full price. Josh Jacobs at RB16 adds another projected starter to the mix, though his situation off the field remains unsettled, and how that resolves will matter more than anything the draft board says about him. The result is a team sitting first in the Jak and Dexter division and in the 96th percentile of the field, not by accident, but because the process was sound from round one to round eighteen.
