they found some draft steals with Caleb Williams and Brenton Strange, their overall composition leaves them languishing at 10th place in their division and within the disheartening 15th percentile overall. As the season unfolds, Talledega Nights will need more than sheer speed to steer clear of the pitfalls that lie ahead.
