SleeperReaper13 finished right at the waterline in 2025, a 50 percent winning record and a 48th-percentile scoring output that suggests a roster coasting on mediocrity rather than building toward anything. The 2026 outlook is worse. The draft offered almost no relief, logging zero steals against one major reach and four minor ones, headlined by Patrick Mahomes at QB12 gobbled up 3.3 rounds before consensus said he was worth the pick. That kind of capital misallocation is brutal in a format where early picks are everything, and the roster reflects it. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 is a genuine building block, and Derrick Henry at RB12 still has teeth, but the projected lineup bottoms out at Jordan Addison at WR43, and the supporting cast around those two anchors is thin on upside. This team sits 12th in the Final Fantasy VII division and in the 5th percentile of the field. There is no obvious trade target to upgrade, no late-round lottery ticket quietly outperforming its ADP. SleeperReaper13 is not rebuilding. It is simply waiting.

safbrocktails sits 11th in the Final Fantasy VII division and in just the 12th percentile of the tournament field, and the roster explains why. The receiver group is genuinely impressive, anchored by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and supported by projected starters in DeVonta Smith, Garrett Wilson, Brian Thomas Jr., Parker Washington, and Chris Godwin, with Tyler Warren at TE4 and Sam LaPorta at TE8 adding real punch at tight end. But this is a positionless format, and having your best players clustered doesn't stretch your lineup the way elite depth at the top does, and the top of this roster simply doesn't have enough of it. Geno Smith grades out at QB30, Rico Dowdle projects as the weakest starter on the team at RB32, and the draft offered no relief: zero steals, zero values, and two major reaches that burned precious capital on Smith and a faded Brandon Aiyuk. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, no late-round sleeper who changes the math. This team is what it is, and what it is isn't enough.

NatesNerds sits 10th in the Final Fantasy VII division and in just the 13th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record doesn't offer much hope that the standings will move. Of the 17 picks made, 10 came at chalk and three qualified as major reaches, including Justin Herbert taken nearly a full round early at QB8 and Jared Goff pulled almost a round and a half ahead of schedule at QB16. Burning premium draft capital on two quarterbacks that grade out as QB8 and QB16 is the kind of organizational decision that haunts a roster for months. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 is a genuine anchor, but the projected starter pool falls off quickly after him, bottoming out at RJ Harvey as the weakest projected starter at RB28. Makai Lemon was drafted more than two rounds early and projects as WR40. There are no steals on the board, the values were minor, and the margins are thin. Nate needed a plan B. It's not clear there is one.

KingBowerKuppa sits ninth in the Final Fantasy VII division and projects in just the 15th percentile of the field, and there is very little in this roster construction to suggest a reversal is coming. The one genuine star, Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, is real, and the Jayden Daniels and Terry McLaurin stack gives this team a coordinated upside swing on the right week. But the rest of the puzzle does not hold together. Jeremiyah Love grades out as a serviceable RB13, yet KingBowerKuppa reached 1.3 rounds early to land him, spending premium draft capital on a player who was always going to be available. The deeper problem is at the bottom of the projected lineup, where Malik Willis sitting at QB24 is the kind of floor that costs managers in close weeks. Two major reaches, including Khalil Shakir at WR51 taken nearly three rounds before his market price, compressed the margin for error this roster needed. Chase can carry a team only so far, and right now there is no obvious second engine to help him do it.

Dynomechanic arrived in the Final Fantasy VII division carrying a 92nd-percentile résumé from 2025, which is exactly the kind of credential that makes a 30th-percentile projection sting. The backfield is genuinely strong, with James Cook at RB5, Chase Brown at RB11, and Cam Skattebo at RB20 giving the manager real weekly weapons, and Lamar Jackson at QB3 stacking with Zay Flowers adds the kind of ceiling game that can carry a week on its own. But ceilings require floors, and the receiver group beyond Flowers thins out quickly: Matthew Golden projects as the weakest projected starter at WR52, and Rashid Shaheed, Jalen McMillan, and Tank Dell are all hovering in the WR57-to-WR74 range without a starter's asterisk among them. The draft sheet is almost entirely chalk, zero steals, which means this roster is basically what it looks like on paper. That was fine when the paper said 92nd percentile. In 2026, the paper says 8th in the division, and the gap between who Dynomechanic was and who they project to be is the season's entire story.

Country for Old Men is the team that won't lose you sleep as an opponent but won't let you rest easy either. The engine here is a backfield anchored by Christian McCaffrey (RB3), De'Von Achane (RB6), and Saquon Barkley (RB8), a trio that gives this roster a ceiling most managers in Final Fantasy VII would envy. The problem is what surrounds it. The receiver group tops out at Mike Evans (WR27) paired with Jalen Hurts (QB13) in a stack that at least props up its own value, but Jayden Reed at WR48 is the projected starter drawing the short straw, and in a tight tournament, that floor matters. The draft was almost entirely chalk, twelve picks landing near consensus with no steals to speak of, which means the manager got exactly what the market expected and nothing more. A 2025 finish in the 81st percentile in scoring confirms there is real talent here. But 56th percentile projections heading into 2026 tell you the margins are razor-thin, and Country for Old Men needs things to break right, not just play out as expected.

cpalmer1 walked out of this draft looking like someone who kept bidding past their budget and somehow walked away with the house. The board says they reached four minor times and twice more in a meaningful way, with De'Zhaun Stribling taken 3.4 rounds early and MarShawn Lloyd claimed 3.3 rounds ahead of consensus. On paper, that is the profile of a manager who fell in love with players the market had not. But then you look at the roster and the argument gets complicated. Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10, both projected starters, form a genuinely elite foundation, and Colston Loveland at TE3 stacking with Caleb Williams adds a layer of upside that most rosters at the 60th percentile simply do not have. The 2025 record of 64 percent wins and a 78th percentile scoring season suggest this manager can build. The question hanging over 2026 is whether those early-round gambles on Lloyd and Stribling reflect sharp conviction or just got bailed out by the studs at the top, and nobody will know the answer until the season actually plays out.

JdubKCMO didn't build this roster with one splashy move. They built it pick by pick, and the ledger shows it: one steal, four values, and only three minor reaches across the entire draft. The foundation is a receiver group that's genuinely difficult to argue with, led by CeeDee Lamb (WR5), Chris Olave (WR11), and Rashee Rice (WR13), all projected starters. Rice comes with real baggage, between a recent probation violation, a pending jail stint, and a knee procedure that will keep him sidelined early in the season, but if Rice finds his way onto the field and stays there, he's still a difference maker at WR13. Carnell Tate (WR29) rounds out the receiving corps as another projected starter landed a full round past his ADP. Harold Fannin (TE6) and Drake Maye (QB2) give this team a credible ceiling at the positions that typically separate the field. Fifth in the Final Fantasy VII division and sitting at the 68th percentile, JdubKCMO has the profile of a team that quietly beats you, not with fireworks, but with consistency baked in from draft day.

TR3Y 6 Mafia sits at 81st percentile in the field, and the draft tape explains exactly why. This roster was not built on a single splashy pick or a lucky slide, it was built round by round with a quiet consistency that adds up fast. The foundation is legitimate: Justin Jefferson at WR6 anchors the skill positions, Trey McBride at TE2 is among the most valuable players at his position in the entire tournament, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 gives this team a true workhorse to lean on. What makes the construction sharper is where the manager found extra value in the middle and late rounds. Kyler Murray fell more than a round past his ADP and landed at QB19, a number that looks even better when you factor in the Murray-Jefferson stack that gives this team a built-in ceiling raiser on big weeks. Dak Prescott similarly slid past his number and arrived at QB7. Fifteen chalk picks and three genuine values, zero reaches. That is not a dramatic story, it is just a well-managed draft, and well-managed drafts tend to show up in the standings.

JPeekFF lands at 86th percentile in a loaded field and sits third in the Final Fantasy VII division, and the draft tells you exactly why: this was not a team built on lottery tickets but on steady, repeatable advantages. Joe Burrow at QB4 is the centerpiece, and the fact that he slid to pick 3.08 against an ADP of 2.05 is the kind of quiet gift that good drafters cash in on. Yes, the injury history is real, the turf toe that wiped out most of 2025 being only the latest chapter, but when Burrow plays full seasons he produces at a level that justifies every bit of that ranking. Pair him with Brock Bowers at TE1 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4, and you have a core that most rosters in this tournament would envy. The rest of the roster filled in at chalk without ever reaching, which means JPeekFF did not mortgage anything to land that top tier. Sixteen chalk picks and two values, zero reaches. That is not a flashy draft summary, but it is a winning one.

sethdiewold did not win the draft with one flashy swing. He won it by being right, repeatedly, across the board. The clearest evidence is at receiver, where Puka Nacua projects as WR1, A.J. Brown as WR8, and George Pickens as WR10, all projected starters, all acquired at chalk prices, all quietly adding up to a receiving corps that most managers would trade their entire draft for. Then consider that Matthew Stafford, projected QB14, fell a full round past his ADP and landed in sethdiewold's lap at 7.02, with the Nacua stack baked right in. Jordan Love, projected QB17, fell even further, a round and a half, giving the roster legitimate quarterback depth without sacrificing value anywhere else. Fourteen chalk picks in a draft this clean is not a sign that sethdiewold played it safe. It is a sign that he knew what things were worth, paid fair prices, and walked away with the better end of almost every deal. That is how you build a roster that sits second in the Final Fantasy VII division and at the 89th percentile of the field.

Cstroud1 enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting at the top of the Final Fantasy VII division and in the 98th percentile of the field, and the draft tape explains why. This wasn't a team built on one flashy pick; it was built on a pattern of quietly coming out ahead. Ashton Jeanty fell nearly a full round past his ADP before Cstroud1 scooped him up as a projected RB7. Malik Nabers slipped similarly, landing as a projected WR12 starter at a cost that reflected last year's uncertainty rather than this year's outlook. Josh Jacobs, a projected RB16, arrived a round and a half late. Five values across the draft, no outright steals needed, just a manager who kept finding the board drifting in their direction and taking advantage every time. The J.K. Dobbins reach at RB36 is a real conversation, and Quentin Johnston projects as the weakest starter at WR41, but on a team this loaded at the top, those are footnotes. Cstroud1 didn't reinvent anything. They just drafted better than almost everyone else.
