There is no generous framing for what Topherk44 put together in this draft, and the standings already know it: 12th in the division, 9th percentile in the tournament, a roster that reads like a series of confident decisions that didn't quite land. The draft chart tells the story bluntly, four major reaches against zero steals, meaning Topherk44 consistently overpaid without ever collecting a discount. Stefon Diggs projects as the weakest starter at WR56, a consequence of reaching three full rounds early to grab him in round nine. CeeDee Lamb and A.J. Brown are genuinely good, but Brown cost a premium at pick 2.02 when the board hadn't asked for that urgency yet. Meanwhile, Dalton Kincaid, who might have steadied things at TE, is coming off a knee injury that Bills GM Brandon Beane described as "too early to tell" heading into 2026, which is a polite way of saying the floor is closer than you'd like. A 56% win rate last year suggests this roster can tread water. Whether treading water is enough is a different question entirely.

The Office Linebacker enters 2026 sitting 11th in the LegendofZelda:BreathoftheWild division and in just the 9th percentile of the entire field, and the draft history explains exactly how they got there: six major reaches, three minor reaches, and not a single steal on the board. The damage is concentrated where it hurts most. Marvin Harrison Jr. projects as a WR33 after three seasons of mounting disappointment, an injury-riddled year in Arizona, and a quarterback situation that currently bottoms out at journeyman Jacoby Brissett, and the team still paid up two and a half rounds early to get him. Then, as if to double down on the strategy, they reached nearly eight full rounds for Justin Fields, a QB38, and almost eight rounds for Jalen Tolbert, a WR102. Brock Bowers at TE1 is real, and Jayden Daniels at QB5 is legitimately valuable, but two strong anchors cannot carry a roster built on optimism priced at a significant premium. This team did not get unlucky. It simply drafted this way.

The YounkerShysters are sitting at the bottom of the LegendofZelda:BreathoftheWild division and projecting in the 10th percentile of the field, and the honest diagnosis is that there is no clean path out. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Chris Olave at WR11 anchoring a group that could carry any roster, but the rest of the team makes that strength feel almost cruel. The quarterback situation is the kind that keeps a manager awake at night: Kyler Murray, projected QB19, is technically the headliner, but Murray is still recovering his career after a lisfranc injury ended his Arizona tenure early and left him fighting for a starting job in Minnesota. That is not a stable foundation. The Sam LaPorta reach at pick 3.10 when his ADP sat at 6.01 now looks like a draft-defining miscalculation, inflating the back of a roster that needed reinforcement at the top. Amon-Ra can only carry so much.

There is no polite way to say this: 11 Wins Pop is staring down a season where the ceiling and the floor are uncomfortably close together. Sitting ninth in the LegendofZelda:BreathoftheWild division and in just the 20th percentile of the field, the roster's biggest problem is not one bad decision but the accumulation of them. The draft featured zero steals, two values, and six reaches, including Kirk Cousins at QB35 burned in round 14 and Kimani Vidal at RB60 taken in round 16, two picks that suggest the manager was shopping in the discount aisle and still overpaid. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Malik Nabers at WR12 give this team a pulse, and Joe Burrow at QB4 is a legitimate anchor, but the supporting cast grades out thin enough that those studs spend the whole season doing heavy lifting with nobody spotting them. After a 15-21 campaign a year ago, 11 Wins Pop needed a sharp, aggressive draft to change the trajectory. This was not that draft.

There is no kind way to say this about garyzam: the 2026 outlook is grim, and the draft did not help matters. Sitting eighth in the LegendofZelda:BreathoftheWild division and projected at just the 22nd percentile of the field, this roster needed every pick to count, and instead the draft sheet reads like a cautionary tale, zero steals, zero values, and five reaches including three major ones. Quinshon Judkins at RB22 was pulled more than two rounds early, and the late-round desperation for Kaytron Allen and Ray Davis, both taken roughly three and a half rounds ahead of their market price, produced two back-end options who barely dent the projections. The roster does have genuine anchor talent in Saquon Barkley and Jaxon Smith-Njigba, but when your quarterback situation peaks at Bo Nix at QB15 with C.J. Stroud at QB22 as the alternative, the ceiling gets uncomfortably low very fast. After a 39-percent win rate in 2025, garyzam needed a draft that opened doors. This one locked most of them.

foxhunter42 finished 9-27 last season and sits at 38th percentile entering 2026, and nothing about this roster suggests a dramatic reversal is coming. The good news, such as it is, lands at tight end: Trey McBride projects as TE2 and Juwan Johnson slots in as a starter, giving the team a genuine anchor at that position. The bad news is almost everywhere else. The receiving corps has volume, Drake London at WR7 and DeVonta Smith at WR14 leading the way, but the back end fades fast toward Zachariah Branch at WR75 and beyond. More damning is how the roster got built: sixteen chalk picks, zero steals, zero values, and three minor reaches that netted Alec Pierce at WR32 as the most notable return. That is a draft without a single moment where the manager beat the market, which means foxhunter42 came to a knife fight having paid full retail for every knife. McBride can carry a week, but he cannot carry a season, and right now there is no second lever to pull.

thowd is the team that keeps showing up to the party without ever quite owning the room. A 2025 finish at the 83rd percentile in scoring proves there is real talent here, and the draft reinforced it quietly: six good values and a steal in RJ Harvey, who slid three full rounds past his ADP to land at RB28. The projected starters read like a legitimate contender, Justin Jefferson at WR6, Lamar Jackson at QB3, and George Kittle at TE9 anchoring a group that can put up numbers on any given week. The problem is that contenders and pretenders often share the same paper roster in the Scott Fish Bowl, and at 45th percentile with a division rank of sixth, thowd is standing precisely at the fault line between the two. Jefferson's ceiling is real, but Jaylen Warren projecting as a starter at RB27 means the margin for error elsewhere is thin. No catastrophic weaknesses, no obvious knockout punch. This season gets decided by the games that go one score either way.

Bclick didn't win the draft with one thunderclap pick. They won it the way a good poker player wins a session: quietly, consistently, and by the time anyone noticed, the chips were already theirs. Patrick Mahomes slipped to 7.04 despite an ADP of 5.08, and Caleb Williams fell more than a round past where he was expected to go, landing Bclick a QB6 projection in the mid-rounds. De'Von Achane came off the board at 3.04 when consensus had him going in the second, pairing him with Bijan Robinson, the RB2, to form a backfield core that would make most managers sweat through their keyboards. The tight end group adds another layer of separation, with Tyler Warren projecting as TE4 alongside Jake Ferguson at TE12 and Isaiah Likely at TE13, all projected starters. The receiver group is thinner up and down the rankings, but in a positionless format, that simply means the top of this roster does the heavy lifting, and the top of this roster is very good. At the 79th percentile, Bclick isn't sneaking up on anyone. They just drafted better than most.

DaveBroooo reached three times by the board's count, and the board is going to have to live with being wrong. The most damning of those reaches, Rashee Rice pulled 1.2 rounds early at pick 2.12, lands as WR13 in a positionless format where receiver quality is everything. That is not a reach, that is a read. Pull back further and the whole receiver corps tells the same story: Puka Nacua at WR1, George Pickens at WR10, Garrett Wilson at WR17, all projected starters, all drafted by someone who apparently trusted their board over the consensus. The Stafford-Nacua stack adds a correlated floor underneath it. Trevor Lawrence, meanwhile, fell more than two full rounds past his ADP and landed in DaveBroooo's lap as QB10, the definition of a gift for a manager who probably would have paid up anyway. The 2025 season was a disaster, fourth percentile in scoring, but that roster has nothing to do with this one. This draft looks like conviction, and conviction at this level of execution is awfully hard to argue with.

FavelaBoyz landed at 83rd percentile and third in the division, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The most impressive thing here is not any single pick but the discipline behind the whole board: six good values, one steal, and just one minor reach across an entire roster. That minor reach was Emeka Egbuka, taken one round early at WR18, and if that is the worst thing you can say about a draft, you are doing fine. The steal was Bhayshul Tuten, a projected RB25 who fell more than two full rounds before FavelaBoyz snapped him up. Josh Allen anchors the room at QB1, and Justin Herbert, a QB8 projection, cost fifth-round capital despite sitting at a third-round ADP. Mike Evans adds intrigue lower in the lineup, a proven WR27 now with a new team in San Francisco after injuries derailed his 2025 campaign. This roster is not flashy. It is built correctly, and in a field this competitive, those two things are often the same.

zxmays23 didn't win the draft with one flashy pick, they won it by tilting almost every transaction in their favor. The headliner is Jahmyr Gibbs, a projected RB1 who anchors a starting group that also includes Ashton Jeanty (RB7) and Omarion Hampton (RB9), giving this roster a top-end punch that most managers in the field simply cannot match. But the real signature of this draft was the efficiency behind those names. Jalen Hurts landed at QB9 nearly three full rounds after his ADP suggested he would be gone, and Jaxson Dart followed as a QB11 projection at similar discount. Neither pick required gambling, they just required patience while the board cooperated. The minor reaches scattered across the back half of the draft are the only real blemish, though none rise to a level worth losing sleep over. Coming off a 78-percent win rate and a 96th-percentile scoring season in 2025, zxmays23 arrives in 2026 as a legitimate contender in the LegendofZelda:BreathoftheWild division, and this draft did nothing to change that outlook.

Playalistic55 sits at 98th percentile in this field and first in the LegendofZelda:BreathoftheWild division, and neither number feels like a surprise once you look at how this roster was built. Five values and zero reaches across the entire draft is the kind of discipline that separates managers who understand the board from managers who fall in love with names, and the names here are genuinely excellent. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Drake Maye at QB2 give this lineup a ceiling most teams in this tournament cannot touch, and Maye came off the board a full round after his ADP, which is the sort of quiet theft that compounds over a season. The RB group is deep and well-ranked, anchored by Jeremiyah Love at RB13 and Breece Hall at RB14, with Josh Jacobs at RB16 still in the mix pending resolution of an ongoing legal situation that clouds his availability. Even the weakest projected starter, Michael Pittman at WR44, is a reasonable floor. This roster is not built on hope. It is built on process.
