As Bones Mahomes enters the 2025 fantasy football season, the outlook appears rather bleak, marred by a lackluster performance in both the division and the overall tournament standings. With a roster that boasts strong quarterback play from Josh Allen and Kyler Murray, and a solid tight end lineup featuring Sam LaPorta and Colston Loveland, one might expect better prospects. However, the team is severely handicapped by an underwhelming wide receiver corps, ranked tenth in their division, with Garrett Wilson leading the charge at WR14, trailed by Xavier Worthy, George Pickens, and Jerry Jeudy. The reliance on Dallas Goedert as a starter further highlights the frailty in their tight-end setup, despite the TE Premium scoring format. While some value picks like J.K. Dobbins and Kyle Williams provide a glimmer of hope, the team's early reach for Garrett Wilson and Sam LaPorta casts a shadow over their draft strategy. Entering the season ranked tenth in their division and sitting in

the lowly 20th percentile overall, Bones Mahomes faces an uphill battle, struggling to find their footing amidst a sea of stronger contenders.
