There is no easy way to dress this up: tro926 is sitting at the 16th percentile of the field and dead last in the Ken division, and the roster construction explains why. The receiver group is genuinely impressive, with CeeDee Lamb (WR5), Rashee Rice (WR13), and Zay Flowers (WR16) all projected as starters, but a fantasy team is only as good as its weakest projected starter, and here that honor belongs to Sam Darnold (QB21). In a positionless format where managers can flood their lineup with the best players available, having your quarterback situation top out at Jared Goff (QB16) and bottom out at Darnold is the kind of anchor that keeps a strong receiver corps from ever fully paying off. The 2025 campaign went 14-22 with a 34th-percentile scoring finish, and the 2026 outlook offers no obvious corrective. The draft delivered zero steals, zero values, and a slate of mostly chalk picks that did nothing to close the gap. The pieces to compete are not here yet, and right now there is no visible lever left to pull.

ShanFan finished 33rd percentile in scoring last year and then drafted like someone determined to stay there. The draft chart tells the story without mercy: zero steals, one mild value, and three major reaches scattered across a board that was apparently being read upside down. The most egregious of those reaches is RJ Harvey, projected RB28, taken two and a half rounds before his ADP and now penciled in as the weakest projected starter on the roster. That is not a calculated gamble on upside, that is a panic bid at an auction nobody else was attending. Lamar Jackson anchors this team legitimately, and Jonathan Taylor gives ShanFan a real RB4 floor to lean on, but the supporting cast collapses fast. Kayshon Boutte, projected WR76, was grabbed nearly three and a half rounds early, and Jauan Jennings at WR63 cost more than two rounds of draft capital he was never worth. ShanFan sits 11th in the Ken division and 18th percentile in the field. The draft confirmed what last season suggested.

AZROGERS51 did almost everything right on draft day. Fourteen chalk picks, barely a reach in sight, and a patient hand that let the board come to them. The cruelest part is that it barely moved the needle. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is a genuine foundation, and the Caleb Williams and Rome Odunze stack gives the roster a ceiling other teams in the Ken division cannot match. But Chase is doing a lot of load-bearing work here, because after him the drop-off is steep and unforgiving. Williams projects at QB6, which is fine, and Kyren Williams at RB15 and Chase Brown at RB11 provide some cushion, but the projected sixth starter is Chuba Hubbard at RB29, and no amount of draft discipline corrects for that math. When you play the value game correctly and still land in the 26th percentile of the field, the draft just told you something honest and painful: the talent was not there to find. AZROGERS51 did not miss picks. They ran out of room.

JMoneyMoney ran a disciplined draft, letting the board come to them and finishing without a single reach across 19 picks. The problem is that discipline and results are two different currencies, and this roster is proof. The tight end group anchored by Colston Loveland (TE3), Tucker Kraft (TE5), and Sam LaPorta (TE8) is genuinely elite, the kind of positional depth that wins weeks on its own. The wide receiver corps has real production behind Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), DeVonta Smith (WR14), and Tee Higgins (WR19). But the rest of the roster deflates that promise fast. The projected starters at quarterback are Baker Mayfield (QB18) and Daniel Jones (QB25), which is the sort of ceiling that caps everything above it regardless of how good the other pieces are. JMoneyMoney sits ninth in the Ken division and at the 29th percentile, a finish that stings more because it was built correctly on paper. Doing everything right and still landing here is the cruelest verdict a draft can return.

The outlook for downinahole in 2026 is grim, and the draft did little to change the math. Sitting eighth in the Ken division and hovering around the 47th percentile, this roster has one genuine ace in Brock Bowers (TE1) and a respectable receiving corps anchored by Chris Olave (WR11) and Emeka Egbuka (WR18), but the ground beneath those pieces is shaky. The quarterback situation is where hope quietly exits the building: Tyler Shough (QB20) and Cam Ward (QB23) were both taken before their ADPs, meaning the manager paid a premium to field a starting QB group that still grades out as one of the weaker in the field. James Cook (RB5) offers a legitimate top-end punch at his position, but after Cook the depth falls off fast, and drafting Mike Washington Jr. (RB59) nearly three rounds ahead of consensus suggests the back end of this roster was assembled more on instinct than value. A 44% win rate in 2025 was a warning, and nothing here suggests the trajectory bends upward.

Grayduck8480 sits at the 51st percentile, seventh in the Ken division, and the roster reads exactly like that sounds: good enough to win on any given week, not good enough to coast. The engine is Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 paired with Drake Maye at QB2, two projected starters who give this team a genuine ceiling, and the margins between a playoff push and an early exit will hinge almost entirely on how cleanly that top end performs. The complication is Patrick Mahomes, a QB12 projection who was reached for 2.5 rounds early and who is still working back from a torn ACL and LCL. Mahomes ahead of schedule is great news, but "ahead of schedule" and "starting Week 1" are not the same sentence, and Grayduck8480 spent real draft capital on that uncertainty. If Mahomes steps on the field healthy and Gibbs stays in the backfield, this team earns its way into contention. If either wobbles, the rest of the roster is too chalk-heavy to manufacture points out of nowhere.

ProfDogwood sits at 52nd percentile and sixth in the Ken Division, which tells you everything about where this team lives: firmly in the contested middle, where outcomes are decided by small edges rather than dominant rosters. The real strength here is at the top. Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Joe Burrow as QB4, and Tyler Warren as TE4, a trio that gives ProfDogwood genuine ceiling in any given week. The problem is what happens after that top layer thins out. Three major reaches in the draft, including Theo Johnson at TE37 pulled nearly three and a half rounds early and Darnell Washington at TE38 grabbed over three rounds before his ADP, suggest the manager was hunting upside and paying a steep price for it. Those picks carry real bust risk, and in a format this competitive, late-round reaches that miss hurt more than they would elsewhere. Burrow came as a mild value at 2.10, which softens the blow slightly. But ProfDogwood is not a team that can absorb many misses. The margins here are thin, and the draft history suggests ProfDogwood already spent some of them early.

musbynice didn't light the draft board on fire, but they didn't need to. The blueprint here is consistency: a QB group headlined by Jayden Daniels at QB5 and Justin Herbert at QB8, a starting corps that includes Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Malik Nabers at WR12, and enough depth to absorb a bad week without flinching. Nabers arriving at WR12 despite slipping nearly a full round past his ADP is exactly the kind of quiet win that separates well-managed rosters from lucky ones. The one spot worth watching is Rico Dowdle, the projected weakest starter, who followed up back-to-back thousand-yard seasons in Carolina only to land in Pittsburgh behind Jaylen Warren, which raises fair questions about his weekly ceiling. It's a real concern, but one blemish on an otherwise clean sheet. Sitting fifth in the Ken division and at the 55th percentile, musbynice isn't the favorite, but this is a roster that was built to be in the conversation, and it is.

Hambino0224 didn't need a lottery-ticket gamble to build something worth watching in the Ken division. The foundation is legitimately strong: Josh Allen at QB1 was sitting there at 1.09 when his ADP said he should have been gone by 1.05, and Justin Jefferson, projected WR6, slid all the way to 2.04 despite an ADP of 1.12, meaning Hambino0224 effectively collected two top-shelf players for the price of slightly better timing than the rest of the room. Layer in Kenneth Walker III at RB10, Derrick Henry at RB12, and a Stafford-to-Adams stack that gives the roster a built-in floor on any given week, and you have a team constructed on consistent execution rather than one miracle pick. The draft profile is mostly chalk with a handful of values mixed in, which is exactly the profile of a manager who knew what they wanted and took it. Sitting fourth in the division and at the 60th percentile of the field, there's room to climb, and this roster is built to do exactly that.

DwainFL didn't win the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft with some audacious swing for the fences. They won it pick by pick, round by round, quietly building something that lands at the 65th percentile of the field and third in the Ken Division. The spine of this roster is a receiving corps that reads like a fever dream: A.J. Brown at WR8, Nico Collins at WR9, Garrett Wilson at WR17, and Ladd McConkey at WR20 are all projected starters, and that's before you even get to Mike Evans at WR27. Bijan Robinson anchors the backfield at RB2, giving the roster an unimpeachable centerpiece. What elevates this beyond a simple talent-accumulation story is the draft discipline underneath it. C.J. Stroud fell a full round past his ADP into round ten, Josh Downs slipped a round to round eleven, and DwainFL collected both without flinching. No wasted capital chasing hype, no panicked reaches at critical junctures, just a manager who recognized value when the board delivered it and moved on.

Gooberr13 didn't need a lottery ticket to build something serious in the Ken division, just a draft that kept finding the discount bin at full retail. Four players came in as certified values, and the names attached to those bargains are not afterthoughts: Saquon Barkley fell a full round past his ADP before Gooberr13 scooped him at RB8, Josh Jacobs drifted nearly two rounds before getting claimed at RB16, and Jeremiyah Love and Cam Skattebo followed the same pattern. Stack those four behind Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and you have a starting group built almost entirely on either elite projection or draft-room patience. The 2025 campaign posted a 64 percent win rate and landed at the 65th percentile in scoring, a respectable foundation rather than a ceiling. Now sitting second in the division and at the 83rd percentile tournament-wide, Gooberr13 arrives in 2026 not as a gamble that paid off but as a carefully constructed machine that simply ran better than the competition every single round.

SteveOSlice enters 2026 sitting first in the Ken Division and in the 91st percentile of the field, and the draft tells you exactly why. This was not a roster built on lottery tickets. It was built on the kind of quiet, consistent discipline that compounds over 20 rounds. Dak Prescott landed nearly a full round past his ADP, Jordan Love fell a round later than the board expected, and the receiver group accumulated enough firepower, Drake London at WR7, George Pickens at WR10, Jameson Williams at WR21, Terry McLaurin at WR24, that the Prescott-Pickens stack feels less like a bonus and more like a cherry on top of an already well-constructed sundae. Trey McBride at TE2 quietly anchors the whole thing. The 2025 numbers back the approach: 26 wins, 4848 points, 82nd percentile in scoring. Love carries real question marks about whether his fantasy output will ever match his NFL value, but on a roster this loaded, he does not need to be a hero. SteveOSlice drafted for a margin, and they found one nearly every single round.
