There is no elegant way to spin a 7th-percentile projection, so Sportstlk365 might as well hear it plainly: this roster is in trouble, and the draft did not provide much of a lifeline. Sixteen chalk picks and one modest value across the entire draft means there was almost no margin created on cost, leaving the team entirely at the mercy of its talent grades, which simply are not there. The tight end group is legitimately strong, with Tyler Warren (TE4), Harold Fannin (TE6), Sam LaPorta (TE8), and Jake Ferguson (TE12) all projecting as starters, but in a positionless format that group has to drag a receiving corps whose best projected starter after Drake London (WR7) and DeVonta Smith (WR14) bottoms out at Michael Pittman (WR44). Meanwhile the running back group grades weak across the board, with no projected starter ranking better than Kenneth Gainwell (RB34). Sitting 12th in the King K Rool division, Sportstlk365 is essentially hoping the projections are wrong, which is not a strategy so much as a prayer.

There is no elegant way to dress up an 11th-place division ranking and a 10th-percentile tournament projection, so jdubb2626 is stuck with the truth: this roster is in trouble and the draft did not help. Of the 20 picks logged, not one qualified as a steal, and the two major reaches, Bo Nix at QB15 and Tua Tagovailoa at QB31, consumed capital on quarterbacks who grade out as fringe starters at best. Burning a fourth-round pick on Nix, a full 1.8 rounds ahead of consensus, is the kind of decision that haunts a team when the rest of the board thins out. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 is a genuine anchor, and Colston Loveland at TE3 gives the team a top-end tight end most managers would envy, but two stars cannot carry a squad that projects this far down the field. There is no late-round savior lurking in the depth, no obvious trade chip that flips the calculus. jdubb2626 is not rebuilding toward something better. This is the something better.

There is a version of devilz13s that looks almost functional on paper. Kenneth Walker III at RB10, Chase Brown at RB11, and then the crown jewels, CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Justin Jefferson at WR6, stacked with Kyler Murray no less. That version is real, and it is also not enough. The team sits 10th in the King K Rool division and only at the 31st percentile of the field, because the talent thins out fast once you scroll past the top names, and the draft did almost nothing to change the calculus, producing zero steals and fifteen chalk picks. Murray himself is the symbol of the whole enterprise: a QB19 whose last healthy season feels like a distant memory, now competing for a starting job in Minnesota after a lisfranc injury ended his Arizona tenure early, which is precisely the kind of uncertainty you cannot afford when your quarterback room is already this fragile. Barring a breakout from someone who has not given you a reason to believe in one, devilz13s is a team waiting on luck that the draft never earned.

IceDiddy enters 2026 sitting ninth in the King K Rool division and in just the 36th percentile of the field, and the roster doesn't offer much of an argument against either number. The top of the lineup is genuinely good: Joe Burrow at QB4, Trey McBride at TE2, Chris Olave at WR11, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 give this team a ceiling worth respecting. The problem is that the floor drops off a cliff almost immediately after that. The running back group grades out weak across the board, with J.K. Dobbins projecting no better than RB36, and the projected starter at the bottom of the receiver group is KC Concepcion at WR50. Worse, the draft offers no reason for optimism about future course corrections: zero steals, zero values, and two major reaches, including Deshaun Watson taken nearly four rounds before his ADP. IceDiddy has a few legitimate weapons, but the path from ninth place to relevant runs directly through a series of projections that simply don't cooperate.

RichBilkey is betting the whole season on correlation, and in a positionless format, that is either genius or a slow-motion disaster waiting to reveal itself. The twin stacks are the engine here: Patrick Mahomes feeding Rashee Rice, and Matthew Stafford connecting with Puka Nacua, a projected WR1. When both pairings fire, this roster can put up monster totals, and the 2025 résumé, 81st percentile in scoring, suggests RichBilkey knows how to build ceilings. But correlation cuts both ways. If Mahomes has a quiet week and Rice disappears with him, or if Stafford's shoulder whispers something the injury report never quite captured, the floor drops fast. The weakest projected starter is Jordan Addison at WR43, and there is no safety valve beyond hoping the stacks compensate. The draft itself offered no margin for error, zero steals, zero values, and a major reach on MarShawn Lloyd taken more than three rounds early at RB66. At 8th in the division and 44th percentile overall, RichBilkey has the ceiling of a co-winner and the floor of someone watching Nacua haul in targets while Stafford throws behind schedule.

Sluggos & Darters is the kind of team that makes you nod rather than gasp, and in the Scott Fish Bowl, nodding gets you to the middle of the pack but rarely through it. The foundation is real: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and A.J. Brown at WR8 give this roster a genuine top end, and the 2025 campaign, a 72-percent win rate good for the 72nd scoring percentile, proves the manager knows how to build around it. The problem is that the margins cutting for this team are also cutting against it. The draft was almost entirely chalk, 14 of 20 picks landing right at expectation, with the three values, Khalil Shakir, Antonio Williams, and Jerry Jeudy, coming in the back half of drafts where the floor is already low. Trevor Lawrence as a QB10 is a fine streaming option but not a difference-maker. Seventh in the King K Rool division and sitting at the 45th tournament percentile, Sluggos & Darters needs McCaffrey and Brown to hit every week, because there is no margin elsewhere to absorb a quiet one.

Eddie9211 sits at 46th percentile and sixth in the King K Rool division, which tells you everything about the margins this team is operating within. There is real upside here: Josh Allen at QB1 is as safe a foundation as anyone in this tournament can claim, and the receiver group is quietly deep, with Nico Collins (WR9), Emeka Egbuka (WR18), and Tee Higgins (WR19) all projecting as starters. The problem is that the draft revealed some habits that could bite. Rashod Bateman (WR92) and Christian Kirk (WR100) were taken 5.2 and 8.2 rounds ahead of their ADPs respectively, which means Eddie9211 burned mid-round capital on the bottom of his own roster while the field was grabbing players ranked two tiers higher. Dallas Goedert (TE15) quietly steadies things, a player who proved last year he could deliver when Philadelphia needed him most. But steadiness only gets you so far at the margins. Allen carries this team to the playoff bubble; those late-round reaches may determine whether he ever gets there.

Gimino's draft sheet reads like a manager who trusted the board less than their own instincts, and the roster that came out the other side is genuinely hard to argue with. The major reaches tell the story: Michael Mayer off the board six rounds early, Ray Davis snagged three rounds before his number came up. Neither pick screams consensus wisdom. But zoom out and you find a projected starter group built around Derrick Henry (RB12), Kyren Williams (RB15), Josh Jacobs (RB16), Jaxon Smith-Njigba (WR3), Drake Maye (QB2), and Jayden Daniels (QB5), which is the kind of lineup that makes a 71st-percentile projection feel almost low. The one spot where the conviction narrative gets tested is Matthew Golden (WR52), projected as the weakest starter and carrying real pressure to take a leap after a quiet first year in Green Bay's thinned-out receiver room. Whether Gimino's aggressive approach was vision or variance, this team sits fifth in the King K Rool division with enough firepower to climb. The reaches bought something. The question is whether they bought enough.

Nitecaps didn't build this roster on one flashy pick. They built it by winning exchange after exchange throughout the draft, and the cumulative effect lands them at the 73rd percentile in the field. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 slipped just enough past his ADP that Nitecaps walked away with genuine top-five value at 2.08, and pairing him with a Caleb Williams to Luther Burden stack gives this team a connected core that can run hot on the right week. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 needs no asterisk to justify his spot. The reach concerns are real, Jaydon Blue taken nearly seven rounds ahead of consensus is a gamble that will either look genius or quietly get buried by the end of the season, but the rest of the roster absorbs that risk comfortably. Quinshon Judkins, coming off a fractured fibula that cut his last campaign short, carries some uncertainty, but reports out of Cleveland suggest he arrives at training camp

healthy, which makes him a meaningful upside piece at RB22. Consistent drafting, not luck, put Nitecaps in this position.

Captain K. Rool's draft looked reckless on paper and reads like a plan in hindsight. Three major reaches, zero steals, and a board that probably had scouts wincing at picks 8, 11, and 13. But here is the thing: the roster that came out of it sits at 79th percentile in the field with Bijan Robinson (RB2) and Saquon Barkley (RB8) as the engine and Malik Nabers as the upside lottery ticket worth buying. Nabers is the reach that defines the team's ceiling. Dropped to WR21 at his July low after a torn ACL and a training camp video that had dynasty managers spiraling, he has since looked every bit his spectacular quick-twitch self in camp, and his value is still climbing back toward what it was before the injury scared everyone off. That is exactly the kind of player you want to own when the price was fear rather than talent. Whether Captain K. Rool was being fearless or fortunate with that pick, and with Chigoziem Okonkwo (TE19) taken 2.4 rounds early at pick 8.06, the roster makes the case that conviction and luck are not always easy to tell apart once the draft ends.

Cats and Rats landed in the top 16 percent of the field not by swinging for the fences but by winning the small edges, pick after pick. The foundation is genuinely elite: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this roster two projected top-ten backs who both figure into the starting lineup in a positionless format, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 means the quality doesn't fall off a cliff after them. Then the draft started doing quiet work in the middle rounds. Jordan Love came off the board at 8.10 despite an ADP of 7.06, and Jadarian Price slipped to 11.03 when his ADP sat at 9.09, the kind of patient, opportunistic picking that adds up over 20 rounds without ever producing a single headline moment. Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and Zay Flowers at WR16 round out a receiving corps that is competitive without being spectacular. This team didn't need a lottery ticket. It needed a coherent plan executed cleanly, and that's exactly what the board shows.

Annexation of Puerto Rico enters 2026 sitting first in the King K Rool division and at the 91st percentile of the field, and the draft sheet does not entirely explain how they got there. Six picks landed before their ADP, including three major reaches, and yet the roster hums. The engine is a pair of elite backfields: James Cook at RB5 and De'Von Achane at RB6, both projected starters, both falling to a manager who was patient enough to let the board come to them on those picks specifically, even while swinging early elsewhere. The crown jewel, though, is a starting tight end corps headlined by Brock Bowers at TE1, Tucker Kraft at TE5, and Kyle Pitts at TE7, built in part through the kind of aggressive early commitments that look reckless until they look brilliant. Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 carries real uncertainty given two underwhelming seasons and a still-unsettled quarterback situation in Arizona, which makes him the one question mark embedded in an otherwise enviable core. The reaches were real. So is this roster.
