There is a version of this draft where andresgartiles0 walks away looking shrewd. This is not that version. The defining move came at pick 2.03, where this team reached nearly a full round early for Jayden Daniels, a QB5 in a format that asks managers to start ten players in almost any mix they choose. Quarterbacks matter here, but not enough to justify burning a second-round pick on one while the board was still loaded with difference-makers. The cost of that impatience compounds when you look at what followed: Josh Jacobs, an RB16, yanked almost two rounds ahead of his price at pick 4.03, and Emanuel Wilson, an RB69, snatched nearly six rounds early in round eighteen. Zero steals across the entire board, three major reaches, and a tournament percentile that lands at eighth. Brock Bowers at TE1 is a genuine anchor and the Daniels-Terry McLaurin stack is at least coherent, but coherence does not win leagues. andresgartiles0 drafted with urgency and got impatience instead, and the standings will likely say so.

There is no polite way to frame an 11th-place division ranking and a 12th-percentile tournament projection, so SonicJedi's 2026 preview will not try. The lone star is Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, a genuinely elite asset, but the supporting cast thins out fast and the receiver group is where this roster quietly falls apart. Carnell Tate projects as WR29 and Travis Hunter comes in at WR62, and those two are the entire wideout corps worth mentioning. That weakness matters because the draft offered no real correction: SonicJedi reached for Caleb Williams nearly a full round early, reached for Tate a round and a half early, and the one legitimate steal, Hunter, slid to the manager three rounds late partly because the field already knew what the projections now confirm. Last season's 18th-percentile scoring finish was not a fluke to overcome, it was a baseline to repeat. Gibbs can carry a week; he cannot carry a season. The lever SonicJedi needs does not appear to exist on this roster.

bigbs26 did almost everything right on draft day. Justin Jefferson fell nearly a full round past his ADP and landed at 2.04. George Pickens slid too, and Wilson and Omar Cooper Jr. padded the ledger further. Four values, minimal reaches, a draft sheet that would make process-brained managers nod approvingly. And yet here is the cruel punchline: the team sits 10th in the Kingdom Hearts division and in just the 19th percentile of the field, because getting value only matters if the players you are getting value on are actually good enough. Jefferson at WR6 and Pickens at WR10 are legitimate, but the projected starters thin out quickly after that, and Sam Darnold at QB21 is the kind of quarterback situation that quietly poisons a roster. Darnold won a Super Bowl in Seattle, but with Kenneth Walker gone and the offense increasingly built around Jaxon Smith-Njigba, his fantasy upside is murkier than his job security. bigbs26 bought the tickets at a discount. The show itself may still disappoint.

KingJthe4th sits ninth in the Kingdom Hearts division and at the 39th percentile of the field, and the roster tells you why without much argument. The top end is real enough, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 give the lineup a genuine pulse, and Jalen Hurts projected at QB9 keeps the quarterback situation from becoming a crisis. But from there the drop-off is steep and the draft offered no relief. Eighteen chalk picks, zero steals, zero values, and a major reach on Dontayvion Wicks taken nearly four rounds before his ADP suggest a manager who drafted cautiously and still came away short. When Jayden Reed at WR48 is your weakest projected starter, you are not one waiver pickup away from turning this around. You are hoping St. Brown and Lamb carry you past opponents who drafted better, which is less a strategy than a prayer, and the standings suggest the division is not inclined toward charity.

Last year aDiZzlewhatsthesitch finished in the 87th percentile, and the 2026 roster reads like someone tried to rebuild that machine from memory and ended up with a very expensive approximation. The receiver corps is genuinely impressive, with Ja'Marr Chase (WR2), Chris Olave (WR11), DeVonta Smith (WR14), and Garrett Wilson (WR17) all projected as starters, and that group alone could carry a season. The problem is what surrounds it. Jaxson Dart checks in at QB11 and cost a full round less than his ADP suggested, which is either sharp shopping or a quiet admission that the manager leaned on receivers and hoped the quarterback sorted itself out. Olave, meanwhile, was taken nearly a full round ahead of schedule, a reach that made sense only if the manager was building around a specific vision of the roster. That vision has Chase at its center and a 41st-percentile projection that sits well below where this team played last season. The gap between what this team was and what it is projected to be is not a rumor. It is the story.

The Keyblade Killers sit at 57th percentile and seventh in the Kingdom Hearts division, which is precisely the kind of standing that demands everything go right without offering much margin for error. The foundation is real: Lamar Jackson at QB3 paired with Zay Flowers at WR16 gives this roster a genuine stack with upside, and Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Derrick Henry at RB12 are both projected starters who can carry a week. Tucker Kraft is the wildcard threading through all of it. He was pacing toward 1,000 yards before a November ACL injury interrupted what looked like a breakout, and while he came off the preseason PUP list before August, the question of whether he fully recaptures that form is not a minor one for a team projected at TE5. If Kraft gets back to where he was, this roster has a top-end punch that could move the needle in close weeks. If he doesn't, the Killers are hoping chalk holds and that no one notices how little room they have to absorb a bad beat.

After finishing in the 16th percentile in scoring last season, NanduriNFL enters 2026 looking like a completely different operation, and the roster backs that up. The engine of this rebound is a backfield anchored by Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and Saquon Barkley at RB8, two projected top-ten backs who give this team a weekly floor that simply did not exist a year ago. Layered on top of that is a receiving corps headlined by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Malik Nabers at WR12, meaning NanduriNFL has four projected starters who rank inside the top 15 at their respective positions. That kind of concentrated upside is how you climb from a 33 percent win rate to something worth watching. The one genuine question mark is at quarterback, where Kyler Murray projects as a QB19 and Malik Willis sits at QB24, leaving the position as more of a coin flip than a cornerstone. But in a positionless format that rewards depth at skill positions, NanduriNFL has built exactly the kind of roster that turns a bad memory into a fresh start, landing at the 62nd percentile of the field heading into the season.

The Hash-Slinging Slasher didn't build this roster with one bold swing, they just kept winning the small battles until the edge compounded into something real. The foundation is genuinely strong: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Breece Hall at RB14 give this team a top-end punch most managers would envy, and the Justin Herbert, Ladd McConkey stack adds the kind of correlated upside that turns a good week into a great one. What makes the draft tick, though, is how consistently this team came out ahead on value. Michael Pittman landing at WR44 more than a round past his ADP, and Michael Penix Jr. slipping nearly a round and a half to round 18, are exactly the quiet wins that separate a well-constructed roster from a lucky one. The one blemish is Troy Franklin, a reach of three and a half rounds that sticks out on an otherwise disciplined sheet. Still, sitting 64th percentile in the field with a starting group that includes Robinson, Hall, Herbert, and Nico Collins at WR9, the Slasher is very much in the conversation.

mattwalsh didn't need a headline-grabbing move to build something worth taking seriously in the Kingdom Hearts division. The foundation is Jonathan Taylor at RB4, taken just half a round past his ADP, and Tyler Warren at TE4, who slid a full round further than he should have. Those two picks alone represent the kind of quiet, compounding advantage that separates good drafts from great ones. Layer in Omarion Hampton at RB9, Kyren Williams at RB15, and Cam Skattebo at RB20, all projected starters, and mattwalsh is fielding a group at the top of the position that most managers would envy. The one genuine question mark is Marvin Harrison Jr., who carries WR33 projections but has spent two years underperforming his billing, dealt with injuries in 2025, and now faces another unsettled quarterback situation in Arizona. If Harrison finds his footing, this roster climbs. If he doesn't, mattwalsh still has enough firepower elsewhere to compete at 68th percentile and push higher in the division.

VStroke didn't chase lightning in a bottle during the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft. They just kept winning small. The headliner is Joe Burrow at QB4, secured with the kind of quiet confidence that only looks obvious in hindsight, and Trey McBride at TE2 gives this roster a genuine positional advantage at a spot where the field gets thin fast. Then there's A.J. Brown at WR8, taken at 3.11 when his ADP sat a full round earlier, which is the sort of patient, disciplined pick that separates a good drafter from a great one. The projected starting group, which includes Kyle Pitts at TE7 and Davante Adams at WR25, carries real depth of quality rather than just depth of names. The 2025 season already validated the approach, a 58 percent win rate and a 62nd percentile scoring finish showing this isn't a team discovering itself. Sitting third in the Kingdom Hearts division and in the 73rd percentile of the field, VStroke looks like a team that did the boring work exceptionally well and arrived exactly where it intended.

TheDeliMarket33 didn't need a single flashy gamble to build one of the more quietly dangerous rosters in the Kingdom Hearts division. The foundation is Puka Nacua at WR1, a genuinely elite anchor, stacked alongside Matthew Stafford at QB14 in a pairing that compounds value on both ends. Stafford himself is a case study in the approach: taken at 7.04 when his ADP sat at 6.02, a full round of free equity collected without breaking a sweat. That same discipline shows up in D'Andre Swift, grabbed a round and a half past his ADP and projecting as a RB24 starter, and in Colston Loveland coming in at TE3 to give the lineup a genuine positional advantage at the top of the tight end market. Five values against one minor reach in Jared Goff, who is still a projected QB16, is not a dramatic story. It is just a draft that kept winning small edges until they added up to something real. Sitting second in the division at the 78th tournament percentile, TheDeliMarket33 earned that standing one steady pick at a time.

The Oathkeepers finished 2025 in the 10th percentile and came back with something to prove, and the 2026 draft suggests they proved it mostly through sheer stubbornness. Three major reaches on the board, zero steals, and yet here they sit: first in the Kingdom Hearts division and in the 87th percentile of the field. The engine of this thing is real. Josh Allen at QB1 is the kind of anchor that makes a roster feel safe even when the rest of the decisions get creative, and Drake London at WR7 landing two picks past his ADP is the sort of quiet good fortune that compounds. Harold Fannin is the name worth lingering on, though. The Browns are a difficult situation, Watson's job security is tenuous at best and a crowded receiving corps does not help, but Fannin's WR6 projection reflects what he actually did last year, not optimism. The Oathkeepers reached for Kaytron Allen, Rashod Bateman, and Michael Mayer in the late rounds and may well regret all three. The starters are good enough that it probably will not matter.
