There is no graceful way to spin an 11th-percentile projection and a last-place divisional ranking, so let's not try. Vegasbaby3825 built this roster around a clear top end, Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 anchoring a group that looks respectable on paper until you scroll down, and then you keep scrolling. The draft tells its own grim story: three major reaches against zero steals, meaning this manager consistently overpaid without ever getting paid back. Taking Jaxson Dart two full rounds ahead of his ADP in the third round is the kind of move that forecloses options everywhere else, and those options never materialized. Trevor Lawrence projects as a QB10 and provides some steadiness at the top, but Kenneth Gainwell grades out as the weakest projected starter on the entire roster at RB34, which is less a depth chart and more a warning label. When your draft is heavy on hope and short on bargains, you need the projections to bail you out. These projections are not volunteering.

Last year, easokol1994 went 30-6 and scored in the 96th percentile, a season that demands respect and, apparently, demands very little accountability, because the 2026 roster looks like it was assembled by someone trying to forget what made them great. The receiving corps is genuinely elite, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, Drake London at WR7, and Rashee Rice at WR13 form a top of the roster that any manager in the Kirby division would envy. But this is a positionless format, and that means the quality of your tenth-best player matters, and Chuba Hubbard at RB29 is the weakest projected starter on this team, a meaningful drop-off from the names above him. The draft offered almost no help at the margins, zero steals across the entire board, and the most aggressive move was reaching 2.1 rounds early for Jared Goff at QB16. Goff at least stacks with St. Brown, which is something. But sitting at 12th percentile in tournament projections, easokol1994 is learning the hard way that last year's legend does not carry over.

There is a specific kind of grief reserved for the fantasy manager who watched their team finish in the 80th percentile last season and now has to watch a 17th-percentile projection stare back at them. That is where philly811 lives right now. The pieces that made 2025 work are harder to see in this roster. Jalen Hurts sits at QB9 and projects as a starter, but the offseason loss of AJ Brown to New England puts his passing game under a microscope it has never faced before, and if the Eagles offense sputters, those rushing touchdown opportunities that fueled five consecutive top-10 fantasy finishes start to dry up too. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Malik Nabers at WR12 give this team genuine upside at the top, but the roster falls off quickly after that, with the weakest projected starter being Jadarian Price at RB26. philly811 ranked 10th in the Kirby division. The reputation earned in 2025 is real. The roster built to defend it is a different conversation entirely.

There is no soft way to say this: cdecker613 is staring down a long autumn. Sitting ninth in the Kirby division and projected in just the 26th percentile of the field, the roster lacks the kind of top-end firepower that wins Scott Fish Bowl weeks. Bijan Robinson projects as RB2, which is legitimately elite, and a Caleb Williams and Luther Burden stack gives the lineup a real ceiling on good weeks. But after those anchors, the drop-off is steep and unforgiving. Mike Evans, projected WR27, arrives in San Francisco carrying the rust of an injury-shortened season that snapped his legendary consecutive 1,000-yard streak, and at WR27 he is not the savior a team at this percentile needs. The draft did nothing to change the calculus, producing zero steals and rolling chalk on 14 of 20 selections. When your best hope of a bargain is Jacory Croskey-Merritt falling less than two rounds past his ADP, the margin is already gone. cdecker613 is not broken, just quietly outgunned, and hope is not a roster strategy.

Shaun Bradley's 2026 season sits at 31st percentile in the field and dead last in the Kirby division, and the roster doesn't offer much reason for optimism. The foundation looks serviceable enough: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give Bradley a pair of legitimate difference-makers, and Kyle Pitts at TE7 adds a credible weapon at a position where most managers are scraping. But the receiver group is where this roster quietly bleeds out, with Jameson Williams at WR21 functioning as the headliner and Wan'Dale Robinson projected as a starter at WR47. That's not a depth issue, that's a ceiling issue. The draft didn't help clarify anything either, producing zero steals and 15 chalk selections, meaning Bradley built this roster almost entirely at market rate and got what the market offered. There's no late-round heist to point to, no hidden gem quietly waiting to crack the lineup. What you see is what you get, and what you get projects to be last in the division.

CB326 sits seventh in the Kirby division and checks in at just the 35th percentile of the field, and the draft log does not offer much hope for a turnaround. Thirteen chalk picks, three minor reaches, and three major reaches tell the story of a manager who kept paying premium prices without pocketing any surplus. Kyler Murray at QB19 was taken more than two rounds early, Aaron Rodgers at QB29 was taken nearly two and a half rounds early, and those two swings account for a significant chunk of capital that could have gone toward shoring up the roster's middle tier. The best projected starters are Trey McBride at TE2 and Colston Loveland at TE3, which is genuinely elite, but the drop-off is steep: the weakest projected starter is Jordan Addison at WR43, and Parker Washington, while interesting as a flex option, carries real ceiling concerns given that the Jaguars may not actually want him as their lead receiver long-term. McBride and Loveland give CB326 a foundation, but foundations do not score points on their own, and right now there is no obvious second act.

wonkypenguin is the kind of team that makes you squint at the standings trying to figure out exactly where things went sideways, or exactly right. A 45th percentile projection and a sixth-place division slot don't scream danger, but they don't invite pity either. The backfield is genuinely strong, with James Cook at RB5, Chase Brown at RB11, and Kyren Williams at RB15 all projecting as starters, and all three came in at value relative to their draft positions. That kind of quiet efficiency in the middle rounds is where margins get built. The wilder bet is Bo Nix, taken three full rounds before his QB15 projection suggested anyone needed to panic, a reach that only pays off if Denver's offense takes another step forward. Nix has the floor of a volume monster, having led the league in attempts last season, but wonkypenguin spent serious draft capital betting on a ceiling that hasn't fully materialized yet. In a season decided by margins, that is either the difference-maker or the one thing the autopsy report mentions first.

GSchulteis didn't win the draft on one bold swing, and that's exactly the point. The foundation is a receiver corps that is quietly one of the more dangerous in the Kirby division, anchored by Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and reinforced by Nico Collins at WR9 and Chris Olave at WR11, both projected starters despite Olave costing a modest reach at pick 3.01. The tight end group adds another layer of comfort, with Tucker Kraft at TE5 and Harold Fannin at TE6 both projecting into the starting lineup. Where GSchulteis consistently came out ahead was in letting the board come to them: Brian Thomas Jr. fell nearly a round and a half past his ADP before being scooped at 8.12, and De'Zhaun Stribling dropped more than two full rounds to round 18. The quarterback situation with Baker Mayfield and Daniel Jones won't inspire confidence, but at 51st percentile and fifth in the division, this roster has the ceiling to move. The draft was steady, and in a tournament this deep, steady beats flashy more often than people admit.

Deejobag3 didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by being right more often than wrong. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 give the lineup a pair of legitimate difference-makers at the top, and Bucky Irving at RB21 and Bhayshul Tuten at RB25 provide real depth behind them, with Tuten arriving as a genuine value after slipping nearly two rounds past his ADP. Justin Jefferson at WR6 anchors the receiving corps, and Emeka Egbuka at WR18 quietly fell over a round past his price, making him one of the cleaner wins on the board. The one place where Deejobag3 burned currency without a clear return was drafting Patrick Mahomes at the top of the fourth, a round and a half before the market asked for him. He projects as QB12, which is fine, but paying that premium on a quarterback in a positionless format is the kind of decision that can haunt you if a cheaper option outperforms. Fourth in the Kirby division right now, this roster has enough quality to move up.

mikeinlalaland did not try to win the draft with one audacious swing. This roster got built the way good ones usually do: pick by pick, consistently coming out ahead. The centerpiece is Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, a top-of-the-market selection that gives this team a genuine weekly advantage, and then Saquon Barkley fell a full round and a half past his ADP to land at RB8, which is the kind of gift that changes a roster's ceiling without requiring anything clever from the manager. Lamar Jackson at QB3 slid past his ADP as well, arriving as a legitimate difference-maker rather than a consolation prize. The one subplot worth tracking is A.J. Brown, now in New England alongside Drake Maye, whose MVP runner-up campaign last season suggests Brown could be drafting into a genuine opportunity despite his habit of missing games. A 2025 finish in the 89th percentile in scoring tells you

what kind of manager this is, and third in the Kirby Division at the 68th tournament percentile looks like a floor, not a ceiling.

Kirby sucks (*rimshot*) didn't need a miracle pick to land at 98th percentile in the field. They just kept winning small battles. The receiver group tells the story most clearly: Puka Nacua at WR1 anchors a corps that includes Tetairoa McMillan (WR15), Ladd McConkey (WR20), and D.J. Moore (WR26), and McConkey alone represents nearly two rounds of surplus value, slipping to pick 6.09 against an ADP of 4.10. Behind the wheel at quarterback, Joe Burrow (QB4) and Jayden Daniels (QB5) give this team the kind of ceiling insurance most managers can only envy. Then there is Dallas Goedert (TE15), who quietly steadied himself in Philadelphia last season, including a four-touchdown stretch during the fantasy playoffs, and returns on a fresh deal that keeps him in a familiar system. The weakest projected starter is Michael Pittman at WR44, which is the kind of floor most teams would trade for. This roster was built the hard way: pick by pick, edge by edge.

VIRAIDERSFF sits at the top of the Kirby division and in the 99th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The methodology here is almost surgical: six good values and a steal, only one minor reach across the entire board, and the steals landed where they hurt opponents most. Derrick Henry at RB12, Breece Hall at RB14, and Travis Etienne at RB18 were all taken well past their ADPs, and Brock Bowers at TE1 anchors the lineup as the best projected tight end in the tournament. The crown jewel, though, is Quinshon Judkins at RB22, grabbed a full two rounds late after a fractured fibula clouded his draft-day stock. Reports have Judkins on track for Cleveland's training camp, which means VIRAIDERSFF may have paid discount prices for a player who returns fully healthy. George Pickens at WR10 rounds out a projected starting group that has almost no exploitable seams. The 2025 ledger was a rough one, but the 2026 construction suggests someone learned from it and answered with a very tidy draft.
