TylerDenniston sits in the bottom 10 percent of the field heading into 2026, and the roster map tells you why without much ambiguity. The good news is genuine: Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 are legitimate pillars, and the Kyler Murray/Jefferson stack at least gives this team a way to spike when Murray is cooking. But the floor beneath that top layer drops off in a hurry, and the draft did little to repair it. Bo Nix, the projected QB1 here, was taken 2.2 rounds ahead of his ADP, which means TylerDenniston spent early capital on a QB15 projection when the position could have been addressed later at similar cost. That is the kind of inefficiency that haunts a team sitting 12th in the division, because there is no margin to absorb it. The values were minor, the steals were nonexistent, and the roster grades out as a collection of good intentions surrounding two stars. Two stars can win weeks. They rarely win divisions.

There is no gentle way to frame what ppranks is staring down in 2026: an 11th-place division rank and a 13th-percentile tournament projection that suggests the ceiling here is mostly cosmetic. The roster has pieces worth believing in, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and James Cook at RB5 chief among them, but the draft board tells a harder story underneath. Rhamondre Stevenson, the projected weakest starter, was taken nearly three full rounds ahead of his ADP, which means ppranks paid a real price for a player grading out at RB31. Tyler Shough was drafted more than two rounds early as well, a significant bet on a QB20 projection that offers little upside to justify the cost. Carnell Tate adds intrigue, pairing with Cam Ward in Tennessee in a connection that has to produce at a high level for the projections to budge, but counting on an unproven pairing to rescue a bottom-tier outlook is less a strategy than a prayer. The math here is unkind, and there are very few levers left to pull.

There is no way to look at bxgrisak's draft and arrive anywhere good. The signature move was burning the first overall pick on Jayden Daniels at QB5, a full 1.3 rounds ahead of where the market priced him, in a positionless format where quarterback scarcity is not really a thing. That reach set the tone for a draft that logged four major reaches against zero steals, and the rest of the board confirmed the pattern: Keon Coleman at WR91 snatched 4.4 rounds early, Blake Corum at RB35 grabbed 2.1 rounds before his time, and Terrance Ferguson hauled in at 2.1 rounds early as well. The receiving corps projects weak as a group, with De'Zhaun Stribling, Tyreek Hill, Pat Bryant, and Coleman all sitting outside the top 70 at their position and none projected to start. A 36-percent win rate and a 27th-percentile scoring finish in 2025 already told this story, and the 2026 draft answered back by writing the same chapter. The Lara Croft division has bxgrisak sitting tenth, at the 14th percentile of the field, and nothing here suggests the floor is closer than it looks.

suZcute walked into the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft and somehow found four major reaches in a single session, which is less a strategy than a confession. The most damning entry in the ledger is Juwan Johnson, a TE20 projection taken 2.2 rounds early at pick 8.11, a round where roster-building decisions actually matter. That kind of reach doesn't just cost a pick, it signals a manager who was drafting names and feelings rather than value. Zay Flowers, taken 1.3 rounds ahead of his ADP, projects as a WR16, which is fine, but paying a round-three price for a round-four player in the same draft where you burned a late pick on Justin Fields, a QB38 taken nearly four full rounds early, means every inefficiency compounds the last. The stacks with Patrick Mahomes and Travis Kelce and Matthew Stafford and Puka Nacua give this roster a floor, and A.J. Brown's move to New England alongside Drake Maye keeps WR8 projections alive, but none of that erases a draft that produced zero steals. Coming off a 25th-percentile scoring season, suZcute needed a bounce-back draft. This was not it.

Last year, CambodianMilk went 35-1 and scored in the 100th percentile, which is the kind of résumé that makes people assume you know something they don't. This year's roster suggests the opposite. Sitting at the 30th percentile and eighth in the Lara Croft division, the team is carrying a receiver corps headlined by Jaxon Smith-Njigba (WR3), Drake London (WR7), and Tetairoa McMillan (WR15), which is genuinely impressive, but the rest of the roster has not kept pace with that standard. The draft offers little comfort: no steals, no values, thirteen chalk picks, and three major reaches, including Kirk Cousins burned at 15.06 when his ADP sat at 18.09, and Christian Kirk taken nearly seven rounds early. Parker Washington (WR35) is an interesting dart throw, a player who led Jacksonville in targets last year despite every organizational signal pointing elsewhere, but whether that continues with Brian Thomas Jr. and Travis Hunter in the building is a legitimate question. The gap between what CambodianMilk was and what this roster projects to be is not small, and reputation does not score points.

RaiderButts64 is parked at seventh in the Lara Croft division and the 33rd percentile of the field, and the roster map explains why. The foundation is genuinely good: Bijan Robinson (RB2) and De'Von Achane (RB6) are elite assets, and Kyren Williams (RB15) keeps the depth meaningful. But the wheels start wobbling from there. The wide receiver group is projected weak, with Davante Adams (WR25) as the lone starter worth trusting and Wan'Dale Robinson (WR47) penciled in as the projected weakest starter on the entire roster. That kind of drag at the top of the lineup is hard to overcome. The draft did not help matters either: three major reaches, including Cooper Kupp taken three full rounds before his ADP and Jared Goff grabbed nearly two rounds early, means the manager spent premium capital on players the market had already discounted. There were values found late, but chasing Goff in round four is like buying flood insurance after it rains. This roster has a real ceiling problem, and no obvious lever left to raise it.

terminalkennedy1 sits at 51st percentile and sixth in the Lara Croft division, which is exactly as comfortable as it sounds: not in danger of embarrassing anyone, not in position to frighten anyone either. The margins decide this. On one side of the ledger, the top of this roster is genuinely good, with Josh Allen at QB1 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 anchoring a starting group that can compete with most fields on any given week. On the other side, the draft reveals a manager who paid early and paid often for running backs, reaching two full rounds for Bucky Irving at RB21 when the consensus said wait, and those early expenditures leave the receiver group thin enough that Romeo Doubs, projected RB53, is the weakest projected starter. Caleb Williams falling to 4.10 at QB6 was a genuine gift that partially offsets the Irving overpay, but this roster lives and dies on whether the backfield studs stay healthy and whether the projection models are simply wrong about Doubs.

Caameron didn't reshape the landscape with one flashy pick. This team was built the way good teams get built: round after round of quietly coming out ahead. The clearest example is Isaiah Likely, a TE13 projected starter landed at pick 10.12 when his ADP said he should have been gone by round eight. That's not luck, that's patience. Nico Collins at WR9 and George Pickens at WR10 give caameron two legitimate cornerstones among the starters, and Jameson Williams at WR21 isn't far behind. Toss in a Jordan Love and Christian Watson stack that adds ceiling without requiring a sacrifice, and you have a roster where the floor stays high even when the upside hasn't kicked in yet. The draft ledger shows four values, one steal, and just two minor reaches against zero major ones, which tells you the manager rarely panicked. Sitting fifth in the Lara Croft division and in the 69th tournament percentile, caameron isn't leading anyone's conversation yet, but this team belongs in it.

BojackHorseman finished last season at 87th percentile in scoring, and the 2026 draft suggests they came back with the same instinct: know what you want and take it before the board makes the decision for you. The two major reaches tell the whole story. Jaydon Blue lands at RB70 in the projections after BojackHorseman grabbed him nearly seven rounds ahead of consensus, and Michael Mayer sits at TE39 after a four-round early pull. Those are not safe picks. Neither is the kind of move a timid manager makes. But look at what surrounds those bets: Brock Bowers at TE1, Tyler Warren at TE4, Drake Maye at QB2, Chris Olave at WR11. This roster did not get good because of the reaches, it got good in spite of the risk they represent. BojackHorseman lands at 73rd percentile in the field, fourth in the Lara Croft division, and the question worth watching all season is whether the conviction that built this roster is a repeatable skill or something that just happened to work out this time.

galaxybrainpicksfail spent draft day doing something refreshingly unfashionable: being right, repeatedly, without making a single headline move. The foundation is genuinely elite, with Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Lamar Jackson at QB3 anchoring a roster that was always going to be hard to beat on paper. But the real story is the middle rounds, where the draft quietly separated itself from the field. D'Andre Swift fell nearly two rounds past his ADP and landed at pick 9.10. Cam Skattebo slipped a full round to 8.03. Luther Burden drifted a round past his number and arrived at 6.03 as a WR22 projection. Five values scattered across the board, zero steals needed, because the patient approach kept producing without requiring luck. The Jalen Hurts and Dallas Goedert stack adds a correlation bonus that gives the roster another lever on big weeks. Finishing at the 84th percentile in 2026

scoring is a realistic floor here, not a ceiling. Third in the Lara Croft division is where this team sits entering the season, and that feels like an undercount.

Get Yer Shinebox is not hedging its bets, it is doubling down on a single beautiful conviction: Joe Burrow and Ja'Marr Chase go off together or the whole enterprise gets loud. That stack is the spine of this roster, and everything else bends toward supporting it. Chase projects as WR2, Burrow as QB4, and when those two are cooking in the same game, the points do not add, they multiply. The brilliance of the build is that the roster does not ask the stack to carry dead weight. Omarion Hampton at RB9, Derrick Henry at RB12, Josh Jacobs at RB16, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 are all projected starters capable of winning a week independently, which means Shinebox is not praying for a single outcome, it is engineering a ceiling with a sturdy floor beneath it. Draft-day execution backed this vision, with Smith falling 1.2 rounds past his ADP and landing right alongside the stack at a discount. This team sits second in the Lara Croft division and in the 90th percentile of the field, and the construction earns every bit of that standing.

DiggityDog sits at the top of the Lara Croft division and in the 99th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: seven values, one steal, and only one major reach across the whole roster. The steal is Jaxson Dart, a QB11 projection grabbed at 8.02 when his average draft position had him going in the fifth round, and he comes stacked with projected starter Malik Nabers, a WR12 who gives that pairing a genuine ceiling. The receiver group around Nabers is the real story, though. CeeDee Lamb at WR5, Rashee Rice at WR13, and Tee Higgins at WR19 are all projected starters, and Higgins, D.J. Moore, and DK Metcalf were each scooped up more than a round past their ADPs. Trey McBride at TE2 and Tucker Kraft at TE5 anchor the tight end group with equal efficiency, Kraft arriving 1.2 rounds late. There is not much to criticize here. DiggityDog drafted like someone who came with a plan and had the patience to execute it.
