Though Kenneth Walker III might spark some optimism being taken slightly after his ADP, the overzealous reaching for others like Omarion Hampton and Rome Odunze suggests that lx2 remains committed to its strategy of bemusing decision-making. As one of the younger teams in the league, with an average starter age of 24.9, fans can look forward to watching these sprightly athletes run circles around their opponents—if only in a metaphorical sense.

With Trevor Lawrence and Geno Smith failing to inspire confidence, both ranking poorly among quarterbacks, the team's passing game lacks the spark needed to compete effectively. Despite boasting an impressive stable of running backs led by Ashton Jeanty and Jonathan Taylor, the imbalance within the roster is glaring. The wide receiver corps, led by Jerry Jeudy and Ricky Pearsall, struggles to make an impact, offering little relief in a league where aerial threats are king. Overextending on Quinshon Judkins and Jonnu Smith, whose value doesn't equate to their draft position, suggests a strategy lacking foresight. Any

optimism from snagging Trevor Lawrence later than expected feels overshadowed by these missteps. As they enter this season sitting near the bottom of their division and languishing in a low percentile overall, it seems the RYNOS might just be in for a long, uphill battle in 2025.

Despite having nabbed Luther Burden and Romeo Doubs for a song, reaching for other players such as Keon Coleman and Mason Taylor

earlier than advisable has left them grappling with the consequences. In the grand scheme of nearly 5,000, DiNasty7 languishes in the 29th percentile, a testament to the long, arduous journey that lies ahead if they hope to rise above the shadows of the Las Vegas Aces division.

As For Kyren Out Loud gears up for their 2025 fantasy football season, there's a blend of anticipation and uncertainty surrounding their prospects. The wide receiver lineup presents challenges, with Tre Harris, Chris Godwin, and Jakobi Meyers needing to outperform their rankings to elevate the team's standing. Stefon Diggs, somewhat unexpectedly not in the top tier this year, adds an element of unpredictability. However, an impressive running back group, led by Bucky Irving and Kyren Williams, offers optimism, providing a solid foundation for the

team's offensive strategy. Intriguing draft choices could define their campaign. While securing talents like Drake Maye significantly below his ADP suggests potential upside, reaching for players such as Jakobi Meyers earlier than anticipated could test their strategic depth. On the whole, For Kyren Out Loud faces a season that could veer in several directions, contingent upon key players stepping up and the wide receiver group defying expectations.
