Super Computer enters 2026 sitting in 12th place in the Caesars Palace division and down in the 9th percentile of the field, and nothing in this roster suggests a dramatic reversal is coming. The backfield has real depth, with James Cook (RB5) and Chase Brown (RB11) projecting as legitimate contributors, but the receiving corps is where this roster bleeds out quietly. Davante Adams checks in at WR25 and Xavier Worthy at WR49, and those are the top two options at the position, which is a ceiling problem more than a depth problem. The draft did nothing to soften the concern. Of 20 picks, the manager logged zero steals and only one value, while taking Josh Jacobs a full round and a half before his ADP and somehow circling back to spend a late pick on Kaytron Allen ahead of schedule too. Drake Maye offers genuine upside at QB2, but one strong quarterback cannot paper over a receiving group that projects this thin at the top. The math here is simply unkind.

There is no sugarcoating what davidmavfan is looking at in the Caesars Palace division this season. Sitting 11th in the division and in just the 9th percentile of the field, the roster grades out as a team running out of rope before the season even starts. The one genuine asset is Joe Burrow at QB4, except the manager reached nearly a full round early to land him at 1.09, which means he paid top-of-draft equity to secure a position this format does not require you to prioritize. Worse, the clearest attempt to build real depth around Burrow backfired: RJ Harvey, the weakest projected starter on the roster at RB28, was grabbed 2.7 rounds before his ADP, a reach that now looks like the kind of bet that costs you twice, once at the draft table and once every week Harvey disappoints. Travis Kelce fell a full two rounds past his ADP and is a genuine find at TE10, but late-round value at tight end does not fix a roster that overspent up top and is now watching the margin disappear.

There is a particular exhaustion that comes with being the person at the table who remembers when this team was good. FantasyGoats finished in the 81st percentile in 2025, and whoever is managing this roster in 2026 is clearly aware of that fact, because the draft reads like someone trying to will that version of the team back into existence through sheer stubbornness. The problem is the projection: 19th percentile, tenth in the Caesars Palace division. The core has real pieces, Josh Allen at QB1 and Malik Nabers at WR12 are legitimate anchors, but the draft decisions around them reveal the strain. Justin Herbert, projected QB8, was reached for more than a round early in the second round. Terrance Ferguson, projected TE28, cost nearly four rounds of draft equity before his ADP. That is two significant early investments in a QB1 backup and a weak-position afterthought, and the roster is now paying the opportunity cost of both. The reputation from 2025 is real. The roster built to defend it is something else entirely.

There is a version of this draft where jaymar57 looks at the board, exercises patience, and builds something functional. This is not that draft. Six major reaches across 20 rounds tells the whole story, and the two that hurt most are Caleb Williams at 2.08 and Cam Ward at 7.05, taken a combined four rounds ahead of their ADPs. Burning a second-round pick on Williams, a QB6, in a positionless format is the kind of decision that echoes all season, and then doubling down on Ward, a QB23, three rounds early in round seven confirms this was a philosophy, not a lapse. The receiver group is genuinely good, anchored by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, with Garrett Wilson and Tee Higgins rounding out a strong top three, and Saquon Barkley at RB8 is a real asset. But those wins were on the board for anyone. Everything jaymar57 reached for, from Jauan Jennings at WR63 to Chimere Dike at WR84, confirms a drafting hand that keeps playing after the hand is already lost. Twenty-fourth percentile in the field feels about right.

Billclctr sits 8th in the Caesars Palace division and projects out at just the 30th percentile of the field, and there is no easy fix hiding in this roster. The foundation looks passable on paper: Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give the team genuine upside at the top, and Tyler Warren projecting as TE4 is a real asset. But the drop-off after those names is where the season likely gets buried. Chris Olave checks in at WR11 and Ladd McConkey at WR20, solid enough contributors, yet the projected lineup leans on Tony Pollard as a starter despite his RB30 ranking, which is not exactly a trump card. The draft board does not offer much comfort either. Billclctr landed a few values, McConkey and Warren among them, but countered with five reaches including Ray Davis taken nearly three rounds before his ADP. This roster was not blown up by one bad pick; it was assembled at a slight deficit almost everywhere, which is the hardest kind of problem to solve come September.

rugbyrob10 arrives in the Caesars Palace division sitting seventh and projected at just the 36th percentile of the field, and the roster construction explains exactly why. The receiver group is legitimately elite, with Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), CeeDee Lamb (WR5), DeVonta Smith (WR14), and Zay Flowers (WR16) anchoring a starting lineup that would make most managers envious. But a fantasy roster needs more than one good thing, and nearly everywhere else this team is running on fumes. The quarterback situation is grim, with Kyler Murray projected as a QB19 and Mac Jones as a QB39 sitting behind him. The backfield offers Rico Dowdle (RB32) and Kenneth Gainwell (RB34), the latter taken a painful 2.3 rounds ahead of his ADP. When your two most impactful non-receiver pieces grade out that far below average, even a transcendent receiver group cannot fully compensate. A 12-24 record in 2025 suggests this is not a new problem for rugbyrob10, and nothing in this year's draft indicates the cycle is about to break.

brucea didn't win the draft with one splashy pick. They won it by compiling, round after round, a receiver corps that reads like a fever dream for a positionless format. Puka Nacua at WR1, A.J. Brown at WR8, Nico Collins at WR9, Emeka Egbuka at WR18, Luther Burden at WR22, and Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31 are all projected starters, and that's before you get to Jordyn Tyson at WR34 and Quentin Johnston at WR41 filling out the bottom of the lineup on most weeks. The draft wasn't flashy, leaning heavily on chalk with 13 picks near consensus ADP, but the values came through where they mattered, and last year's 78 percent win rate and 91st percentile scoring suggest brucea knows how to translate a paper roster into actual points. The one question mark worth watching is Matthew Golden, a WR52 taken nearly three rounds early, which is the kind of conviction bet that either looks genius by

October or serves as the answer to a trivia question about this draft. Sitting sixth in Caesars Palace at the 60th tournament percentile, brucea has the ceiling to climb considerably higher.

TheFFBuffalo didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it by being right, over and over again. The centerpiece is Brock Bowers, the TE1, landed at 2.03 when the field let him slide nearly a full round past his average draft position. That's the kind of quiet malpractice that wins leagues. From there, the core holds up: Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Derrick Henry at RB12 give this team a legitimate one-two punch in the backfield, while Rashee Rice at WR13 and Jameson Williams at WR21 provide real upside at receiver, with the Mahomes-Rice stack adding a ceiling most managers would envy. Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 rounds out a starting group that projects to compete every week. The roster isn't without blemishes, Jonathon Brooks was taken nearly three rounds early and Patrick Mahomes is projecting as a QB12, which is a number that doesn't match the name. But with a 2025 finish in the 89th percentile and a draft that produced more right answers than wrong ones, TheFFBuffalo enters the Caesars Palace division as a genuine contender.

Some rosters win with depth. pcminfan wins with peaks. Christian McCaffrey (RB3), Kyren Williams (RB15), TreVeyon Henderson (RB19), and Quinshon Judkins (RB22) give this team four running backs who would be the centerpiece of most fantasy rosters, and that's before getting to the quarterbacks. Jayden Daniels (QB5) fell nearly a full round past his ADP, which in a field this competitive qualifies as outright theft, and Jalen Hurts (QB9) gives pcminfan a second elite signal-caller to rotate in. Then there's Trey McBride (TE2), snagged at 2.05 when his ADP sat at 1.08, delivering top-two production at the position for the price of a late first-rounder. Add Dalton Kincaid (TE11) and Mark Andrews (TE14) behind him and the tight end group alone carries more upside than most teams' full rosters. A team that went 32-4 and scored at the 99th percentile in 2025 has done nothing but reload at the positions that matter most. The Caesars Palace division should be worried.

KillerClownz didn't make any splashy moves that will dominate the offseason conversation, but when you look at where this roster was built versus where the value landed, the quiet competence is hard to ignore. Justin Jefferson at WR6 is the centerpiece, taken nearly a full round after his ADP, and the Jefferson situation deserves more optimism than last season generated. His 2025 struggles tracked closely with JJ McCarthy's inability to get him the ball, and with Kyler Murray now in Minnesota competing for the starting job, Jefferson's projection as WR6 suggests the market has mostly moved on from attributing those problems to the receiver himself. Pair that with Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Breece Hall at RB14 headlining a deep backfield, and the lineup's ceiling is genuinely high. Tyler Shough fell more than two rounds past his ADP to give KillerClownz a QB20 option at a relative discount. This team sits third in the division and at the 82nd percentile tournament-wide, and nothing about that placement looks like luck.

BrendaSue did not build this roster on one splashy gamble. She built it by consistently coming out ahead, and the cumulative effect is a team that lands in the 82nd percentile of the field with a clear ceiling. The draft story is five legitimate values against a single minor reach, and those values were not scraps. Jordan Love at QB17 slid nearly two rounds past his ADP. Kyle Pitts at TE7 and George Kittle at TE9 both fell past their price points before BrendaSue collected them in back-to-back rounds. Bijan Robinson at RB2 anchors the skill positions, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 gives this team a second high-end weapon that most rosters cannot match. Layer in George Pickens at WR10 and Harold Fannin at TE6 among the projected starters, and the floor here is genuinely difficult to attack. BrendaSue also gains stacking bonuses connecting Purdy with Kittle and Love with Christian Watson, correlation advantages that did not cost her anything extra because the players were already worth owning on their own merits.

Noomair sits first in the Caesars Palace division and in the 94th percentile of the entire field, and the draft log explains exactly why. Out of 20 picks, nine came in as good value and one as a steal, against just two minor reaches and zero major ones. That is not luck, that is discipline applied at scale. The headliners are obvious: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give this roster an elite foundation, with Achane landing nearly a full round after his ADP. The tight end group is where the draft really separates itself, though. Colston Loveland at TE3 and Tucker Kraft at TE5 are both projected starters, and Dallas Goedert at TE15 slides in behind them after quietly re-signing with Philadelphia, where he was one of the few reliable weapons in that passing game last season. Noomair went 29-7 a year ago and scored in the 86th percentile. The 2026 draft gave no reason to expect a step back.
