Super Smash QBros entered the Scott Fish Bowl draft with a genuine gift at the top of the board, landing Josh Allen and Lamar Jackson in the first two rounds, and then proceeded to spend the next fifteen rounds proving that having good ideas and executing them are entirely different skills. Four major reaches litter this roster, and the deepest concentration of that damage falls at receiver, where Stefon Diggs at WR56, Ja'Kobi Lane at WR89, and Malachi Fields at WR90 were each yanked off the board two to three rounds ahead of market with the apparent urgency of a man who just discovered coupons expire. The projected weakest starter is J.K. Dobbins, a WR-adjacent RB36 who returns from a Lisfranc injury to a Denver backfield that has since added more bodies and all the hallmarks of a messy committee, meaning the floor here is not soft so much as it is load-bearing. Sitting second percentile in the tournament and last in the Fallout: New Vegas division, this is the rare team that drafted its way into a worse situation than the one it started with.

Carfig rolled into the Scott Fish Bowl draft like someone who had a plan and then immediately abandoned it, and the 8th percentile tournament standing confirms the carnage. The most damning evidence lives in the reach column: five major reaches across the roster, headlined by Troy Franklin (WR80) pulled nearly six rounds early and Pat Bryant (WR86) yanked off the board more than six rounds ahead of consensus, two players projected outside the top 80 at their position burning premium draft capital that could have built something real. Zay Flowers (WR16) came off the board nearly two rounds early in round two, a slot where the positionless format demands near-certain starters, not optimistic bets. The one genuine windfall, Patrick Mahomes (QB12) sliding nearly four rounds past his ADP, barely registers as a silver lining when the rest of the board looks like this. Carfig finished in the 79th percentile last season, so the talent to draft well was apparently somewhere in there. Whatever it was, it did not show up in the Fallout: New Vegas division this year.

There is no polite way to dress this up: SCFF enters 2026 sitting 10th in the Fallout: New Vegas division and in the bottom 10 percent of the entire field, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The receiver group is genuinely elite, anchored by Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and supported by a string of projected starters through Tetairoa McMillan, Garrett Wilson, and beyond, so the raw material at the top is real. But a fantasy roster runs on more than one position, and everywhere else the news is grim. Bryce Young and Geno Smith grade out at QB26 and QB30 respectively, the kind of quarterback pairing that functions less like a strategy and more like a white flag. The draft did not help matters either, with six minor reaches and a major reach on Wilson costing capital that could have shored up the roster's weakest links. Chase can carry a week, but he cannot carry a season, and right now SCFF is asking him to try.

There is weary, and then there is whatever this is. rcharchian arrives in the Fallout: New Vegas division at 12th percentile after a 2025 that produced a 9th-percentile finish, and the 2026 draft offered no corrective. Five major reaches define the board, starting with Sam Darnold pulled nearly three rounds early to land a QB21 when patience might have delivered the same tier for free. Tucker Kraft cost a full round of premium capital at 3.08 for a TE5 projection that was fine but not urgent, and then Jauan Jennings arrived at WR63, nearly three rounds ahead of consensus, to anchor a receiver group that projects weakly even with that kind of investment. Bijan Robinson at RB2 is real, and the manager deserves credit for landing him with a slight discount, but Robinson cannot fix a roster where the supporting cast was bought at retail and above. Isaiah Likely follows John Harbaugh to a light Giants tight end room and could outperform TE13, but one optimistic subplot does not rewrite a draft that went sideways almost everywhere it could.

There is no charitable way to spin kickinbass420's situation heading into 2026. Sitting 8th in the Fallout: New Vegas division and projecting at just the 15th percentile of the field, this roster has the look of a team that drafted with conviction and got punished for it. The draft tells a quiet, damning story: zero steals, one value, and a trail of reaches headlined by Blake Corum pulled more than two rounds early. The anchors of the lineup, Justin Jefferson at WR6 and James Cook at RB5, are real, but the supporting cast fades fast, and the QB room is a source of genuine concern. Justin Herbert carries the QB8 projection and some intrigue now that Mike McDaniel is running the Chargers offense, but with the team leaning on ball control the last two seasons under Jim Harbaugh, Herbert's ceiling has been consistently capped. Behind him sits Malik Willis at QB24, the weakest projected starter on the roster. There is no lever left to pull here, just a long season and a hope that projections are wrong.

Mr. Chows Bell Cows finished 64th percentile in scoring last year and projects at 51st this season, which is basically the definition of a team that lives in the margins. The upside is real: Puka Nacua at WR1, Nico Collins at WR9, and Malik Nabers at WR12 give this roster a legitimate top-end punch, and Travis Kelce at TE10 anchors the back end with the kind of reliability that makes roster construction feel almost easy. But the draft board tells a more complicated story. Four major reaches, including Darnell Washington taken five full rounds before his ADP and Brandon Aiyuk reached nearly four rounds early, mean this manager paid premiums that could haunt them in a format where efficiency matters. The wildest swing is Rashee Rice, a projected WR13 starter who is currently sidelined with a knee procedure, carrying off-field legal entanglements that make his availability genuinely

uncertain. Rice healthy is a difference-maker. Rice unavailable is a gap nobody on this roster was priced to fill. Seventh in the Fallout: New Vegas division feels about right.

kpulsi01 didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't chase upside at the expense of the floor, just drafted well, round after round, and the results speak for themselves. The centerpiece is a Joe Burrow and Tee Higgins stack, pairing a QB4 with a WR19, meaning every Burrow touchdown that finds Higgins is double-dipping fantasy value in the same lineup. Brock Bowers at TE1 is the kind of anchor that quietly wins weeks, because while other managers are cobbling together at the position, this team isn't thinking about it at all. The values came in quietly too: Brock Purdy fell nearly two rounds past his ADP, and Chris Rodriguez slipped over two and a half rounds before kpulsi01 picked him up. Neither pick made headlines on draft day. They don't have to. The team is sitting in the 69th percentile of the field with a legitimate QB room and a receiving corps anchored by Higgins, Jaylen Waddle, and Rome Odunze. This isn't a boom-or-bust roster. It's a steady, well-constructed team that earns its optimism.

nipponcracker did not win the draft with one flashy swing. They won it by consistently putting the needle on the right side of the ledger. The headliner is a tight end group that would make most managers envious: Trey McBride at TE2, Colston Loveland at TE3, and Sam LaPorta at TE8 are all projected starters, and that trio was assembled through steady positioning rather than panic. Yes, LaPorta cost a reach of nearly two rounds, but when your floor looks like that, you can afford to pay a small premium. Kenneth Walker III arriving at RB10 when his ADP suggested a third-round cost is the kind of quiet win that separates competent drafts from good ones. The Caleb Williams and Loveland stack adds a layer of upside that could punch above the team's already-solid 70th-percentile standing. Matthew Stafford gives Williams a credible backup, and Stafford is anything but a throwaway name, coming off an MVP-caliber season at 37 with plenty left to prove. This roster did not announce itself loudly. It just kept making the right call.

The Fantasy Football Show entered the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft with a plan and executed it nearly to perfection. The blueprint was straightforward: let value come to you, stay disciplined, and do not force anything. Three steals, three values, twelve chalk picks, and just one minor reach across the entire board. The steal column alone tells the story. Trevor Lawrence, projected QB10, fell more than two rounds past his ADP and landed at 7.06. Jared Goff, projected QB16, slipped another 2.2 rounds and cost almost nothing. RJ Harvey came in at RB28 in the twelfth round when his ADP suggested he should have been gone by round ten. Meanwhile, the receiver group is quietly the backbone of this roster, with A.J. Brown at WR8, Chris Olave at WR11, and Emeka Egbuka at WR18 all projected as starters. The one blemish, Mike Evans taken slightly ahead of his ADP, is barely worth mentioning. At 71st percentile in the field, this team is built the way championship contenders get built, quietly and correctly.

The Wildomarians finished third in the division and landed in the 78th percentile of the field, which is a fine result by any measure, but the draft log makes it look like it should not have worked. Four major reaches, three minor reaches, and a draft board that probably had their neighbors wincing throughout. And yet here we are. The top of this roster is genuinely formidable: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, Drake London at WR7, George Pickens at WR10, and Jalen Coker at WR55 all projecting as starters, with Harold Fannin at TE6 and George Kittle at TE9 giving the manager two strong options at tight end. That collection of talent did not happen by accident. The Wildomarians reached for Coker two full rounds early and grabbed Tory Horton nearly four rounds ahead of consensus, and both land in a starting lineup that projects as one of the better ones in the tournament. You can call it conviction, you can call it luck, but at some point the roster just is what it is, and this one is legitimately good.

LaserJane did not stumble into the 89th percentile. This roster was assembled with the kind of deliberate patience that turns a 12-round draft into a masterclass, and the evidence is written all over the board. Christian McCaffrey at RB3, Ashton Jeanty at RB7, Saquon Barkley at RB8, Derrick Henry at RB12, Breece Hall at RB14, and Kyren Williams at RB15 form a projected-starter group that reads less like a fantasy roster and more like a declaration of intent. The draft discipline behind it is just as impressive: Barkley fell nearly a full round past his ADP before LaserJane pounced at 4.01, and Javonte Williams slid a round and a half before getting scooped at 7.12. That is not luck, that is a manager who knew exactly what they wanted and let the board come to them. Four steals, three values, and ten chalk picks against a single minor reach is the kind of draft ledger most managers spend years chasing. Second in the Fallout: New Vegas division and sitting comfortably in the top 10 percent of the field, LaserJane has the talent and the receipts to prove it was earned.

KingsMen sit first in the Fallout: New Vegas division and at the 97th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The centerpiece is a Dak Prescott and CeeDee Lamb stack, both acquired at genuine value, Prescott sliding to 6.03 despite projecting as QB7 and Lamb slipping to 2.03 despite projecting as WR5. That kind of patience and board awareness is what separates a sharp manager from a lucky one. De'Von Achane, a projected RB6, also fell 1.2 rounds past his ADP, meaning KingsMen collected three of their most important pieces below market rate before the draft was half over. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 anchors the backfield alongside Achane, and a receiver group that includes Lamb, DeVonta Smith, Jameson Williams, Alec Pierce, and Marvin Harrison Jr. as projected starters gives this roster a ceiling that most teams in this tournament cannot match. The Mike Washington Jr. reach at 13.10 is the one blemish, but one minor overpay does not cloud what is otherwise a masterclass in disciplined drafting.
