Guidocreedo came into the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl and promptly spent a second-round pick on Patrick Mahomes at QB12, a position that costs nothing in a positionless format until you've already torched the draft capital to get there. That's the kind of decision that poisons a board, and the rest of the sheet confirms the infection spread. Jake Tonges, a TE34, was taken nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP, and Troy Franklin, a WR80, got pulled 3.2 rounds early, both of them swallowing picks that might have shored up genuine contributors. Travis Kelce lands as the TE10 and at least came at a slight discount, and the pairing with Mahomes is a real stack, but Kelce is trying to claw back into the top-12 conversation after a long winter of doubt about whether he'd return at all, which is a thin thread to hang a roster on. Last season's 7-29 record already had Guidocreedo sitting at the seventh percentile in scoring, and nothing about this draft suggests the floor has been found yet.

There is no charitable read on corey128's 2026 roster, and the draft log makes it hard to even try. The headline move was taking Joe Burrow at 1.11, which is a curious way to open a draft when Drake Maye is sitting right there as a QB2 with A.J. Brown now in the fold and a genuine ceiling play. Instead, corey128 grabbed Burrow a half-round early and left Maye for someone else to enjoy. It gets messier from there: three major reaches on the board, zero steals, and a receiver group headlined by Jakobi Meyers at WR45 and Stefon Diggs at WR56, which is not a group that wins you anything in a field this competitive. The worst part is that Darnell Washington, a projected TE38, cost a 13th-round pick that could have been used almost anywhere else to better effect. Sitting 11th in the Link Division and in just the 2nd percentile of the tournament, corey128 does not need a miracle. They need about six of them.

SHORUKEN sits at the bottom of the Link Division and in the 5th percentile of the field, and the draft record does not offer much hope for a turnaround. The two most damaging decisions came early, when the manager burned a second-round pick on Jalen Hurts and followed that up by taking Brock Purdy a full two rounds ahead of schedule in round three. Hurts grades out as QB9 and Purdy as QB13, which means neither one is a projected starter in a positionless format where only the best players see the field. Spending that kind of draft capital on players who are not even projected to dress is the fantasy equivalent of buying two business-class seats and flying coach anyway. Meanwhile, the projected lineup relies on Kenyon Sadiq, the team's weakest projected starter, to contribute meaningful weeks. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Zay Flowers at WR16 give SHORUKEN a real floor, but with the draft's upside already mortgaged in rounds two and three, there is simply no remaining lever to pull.

Pierce & Desist sits ninth in the Link Division and checks in at just the 35th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains why. The manager reached on six players by the team's own definition of "major," including Elijah Sarratt at WR98, taken a staggering 8.5 rounds before his ADP, and Cooper Kupp at WR88, grabbed four full rounds early. Those are the kinds of swings that need to hit to justify the premium paid, and neither Sarratt nor Kupp projects as a difference-maker. The saving grace is Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Trey McBride at TE2, genuine pillars who arrived at genuine value, but two anchors can only hold so much weight when the surrounding cast is this thin on upside. Sam Darnold at QB21 adds another layer of uncertainty: even coming off a Super Bowl, his fantasy ceiling is capped by a Seattle offense that funneled targets almost exclusively to Jaxon Smith-Njigba last season, and Kenneth Walker's departure hasn't magically unlocked more production. There is no obvious lever left to pull here.

Last year GoBlueDude finished in the 91st percentile, went 27-9, and scored 5,010 points. This year the projection has them sitting at the 39th percentile, eighth in the Link Division, and the roster tells you why. The draft is the clearest indictment: four major reaches against zero steals, including Jared Goff taken nearly two rounds early at a QB16 projection and Carson Beck pulled almost seven rounds before his ADP at QB40. That is not aggressive drafting, that is paying a premium for quarterbacks who are not going to carry anyone anywhere. Brock Bowers at TE1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 are legitimate weapons, and Rashee Rice at WR13 gives this team a real top end, but the supporting cast thins out fast, with Jordan Addison at WR43 projected as the weakest starter. The gap between who GoBlueDude was in 2025 and who they appear to be in 2026 is not a slump waiting to reverse itself, it looks like a draft that mortgaged the depth to chase a reputation that the numbers no longer support.

There are rosters built to compete and rosters built to teach humility, and _mitch's 2026 squad lands firmly in the second category. Sitting seventh in the Link division and projecting at just the 41st percentile of the field, the team's best case for optimism runs directly through its quarterback group, where Lamar Jackson grades out as QB3 and Jayden Daniels sits at QB5, though reaching a full round early on Daniels in the first round was the kind of aggressive bet that looks either visionary or reckless depending on how the season unfolds. The real trouble is everywhere else. Marvin Harrison Jr. is the top projected receiver on the roster and he comes in at WR33, with projected starter Josh Downs sitting at WR46 as the weakest link in the starting group. Harold Fannin and Kyle Pitts give the team genuine upside, and Pitts in particular showed last year that quarterback uncertainty in Atlanta doesn't have to slow him down, but two strong players at one position can only carry a lineup so far when the rest of the roster projects this thin.

Mipha's Grace didn't light the draft board on fire, but they didn't need to. This is a team built on consistent, quiet execution, and the result is a starting lineup that holds up from top to bottom. Bijan Robinson projects as RB2, a borderline-elite anchor who makes the whole roster easier to field. George Pickens comes in at WR10 and pairs with Dak Prescott in a stack that gives the team a built-in ceiling booster on game days. From there, the depth doesn't fall off a cliff: Garrett Wilson at WR17, Sam LaPorta at TE8, and Isaiah Likely at TE13 all project as starters, and none of them are filler. The one blemish on an otherwise disciplined draft is Christian Kirk, taken nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP as the WR100, a swing that looks hard to justify on paper. Still, one reach at that price point doesn't define a draft that was otherwise all chalk and still came out ahead. Sitting 69th percentile in the field, Mipha's Grace is a team that earned its standing the boring way, and boring tends to win.

Darunia finished 23-13 last year and sits at the 71st percentile heading into 2026, which is a fine place to be, but the draft sheet is the more interesting document. Three major reaches, two minor reaches, zero steals. By the numbers, this manager spent the whole draft swimming upstream. By the roster, it mostly worked. Puka Nacua at WR1 and A.J. Brown at WR8 are both projected starters, and Colston Loveland at TE3 was scooped up nearly a full round past his ADP, which qualifies as the draft's quiet victory. The reaches are harder to dismiss, though. Mac Jones at QB39 cost a late-round pick that could have been spent somewhere useful, and Parker Washington at WR35 is genuinely interesting as a starter while also being the kind of player who leads a team in targets one season because the preferred options underperformed, not necessarily because the coaching staff has converted. Whether Darunia's conviction on the reached players pays off or quietly drags down a talented core is the question that will define this season.

Happy Mask Salesman didn't win the draft with one flashy move. They won it by consistently coming out ahead on value, picking up five players below their ADP without a single major reach to cancel the gains out. James Cook landing at RB5 a half-round late is the kind of small edge most managers shrug off, but those edges compound. TreVeyon Henderson fell nearly two full rounds to become a projected starter at RB19, and Tyrone Tracy slipped a full two and a half rounds to give this roster genuine depth at a position where it is already carrying Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1. The one real variable is Kyler Murray, a projected starter at QB19 who arrives in Minnesota with a lisfranc injury in his recent history and a quarterback competition that looks more like a formality than a genuine threat. If Murray holds the job and holds up physically, this team has a legitimate argument as one of the better-constructed rosters in the field, a point the 81st-percentile projection quietly makes without needing to shout.

gjeckert didn't win the draft with one bold move. He won it by never losing a round. Five values across the roster, zero major reaches, and the kind of receiver depth that quietly becomes a points machine by Week 8. The centerpiece is Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, but the more interesting story is how the rest of the receiver room filled in: Drake London at WR7 and Nico Collins at WR9 were both taken at or past their ADP, and Malik Nabers slid a full round to land at WR12. That's three projected starters in the top 12 at the position, none of them overpaid for. The quarterback situation adds another layer, with Jaxson Dart stacked alongside Nabers and Baker Mayfield paired with Emeka Egbuka, meaning gjeckert isn't just rotating signal-callers, he's manufacturing correlated upside. A 93rd-percentile finish would be impressive in any field. In the Link division, where gjeckert already sits third, it makes this roster one of the most legitimate threats in the building.

CrazyAmbassador finished 2025 at the 52nd percentile and came back with a plan, not a prayer. The draft tells the story: six values, thirteen chalk, and almost nothing given away, a quiet accumulation that landed Josh Allen at QB1 a few picks later than his ADP suggested and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 heading into what looks like a genuine upgrade situation. Waddle moves from one of the more dysfunctional passing offenses in the league to Denver, where Bo Nix led the league in pass attempts last year and suddenly has the weapons to justify them. That kind of context is easy to miss on draft day, and CrazyAmbassador did not miss it. Add Justin Jefferson at WR6 anchoring the top of the board and a Herbert-McConkey stack that gives the roster a built-in multiplier on certain weeks, and you have a team sitting second in the division and at the 98th percentile tournament-wide for a reason. This roster was built round by round, quietly and correctly.

There are drafts where a manager gets lucky once or twice and there are drafts where every single round tells the same story, and afuller's 2026 SFB entry is firmly in the second category. The foundation is almost unfair: CeeDee Lamb at WR5 slid nearly a full round past his ADP and afuller was right there to take him at 2.08, and Travis Etienne fell two full rounds before getting snapped up at 8.08 as RB18. Those are not accidents, they are the product of a manager who knows what a player is worth and has the patience to wait. Layer in De'Von Achane at RB6, Derrick Henry at RB12, and Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 as projected starters, and you have a lineup that would make most SFB managers uncomfortable just looking at it. The Deshaun Watson reach in round 15 is the one blemish on an otherwise disciplined sheet, but Watson is buried deep enough that it barely registers. First in the division, 99th percentile in the field. afuller did not get here by accident.
