SuisseTony sits 12th in the FIFA Football division and projects into just the 8th percentile of the field, and the roster itself explains why there is so little reason for optimism. The receiver group is the clearest drag: Tee Higgins at WR19 anchors the position, but the next two starters project as Jakobi Meyers at WR45 and Jayden Reed at WR48, which is a thin margin for error at the top of a tournament. The draft did not help matters much either. SuisseTony reached 3.1 rounds early on Dallas Goedert, a TE15 who does not profile as a difference-maker at his price, and spent a first-round pick on Joe Burrow at QB4 before the market agreed it was time. The Joe Burrow and Tee Higgins stack is a genuine asset and the one credible path to a big week, but stacking a QB4 with a WR19 does not generate enough ceiling to paper over a receiver room where the third starter is a WR48. This roster is not broken, it is just short, and short rosters in deep tournaments tend to have very quiet Octobers.

Deadmanmoz comes into 2026 sitting 11th in the FIFA Football division and inside the bottom quarter of the entire field, and the roster makes it easy to understand why. The saving grace here is a genuinely elite collection at tight end, headlined by Brock Bowers at TE1, Colston Loveland at TE3, Tucker Kraft at TE5, and Harold Fannin at TE6, a run of top-tier production that would be the envy of most managers in this tournament. The problem is that nothing else holds up. Tyler Shough checks in at QB20 and Jacoby Brissett at QB28, a quarterback room that inspires roughly zero confidence. The draft board tells its own grim story: four major reaches against just one steal, including Romeo Doubs pulled nearly four rounds before his ADP and Wan'Dale Robinson projected as the weakest expected starter at WR47. Last year's 71st-percentile scoring finish feels like a high-water mark this roster cannot reach again. Bowers is real, but one transcendent player cannot drag a bottom-tier quarterback situation and a middling receiver corps into contention by himself.

There is not much mystery here. gjlreid sits 10th in the FIFA Football division and checks in at just the 25th percentile of the field, and the draft did not generate the kind of surplus value that might paper over a thin projection. Twelve chalk picks, four minor reaches, and two major reaches tell the story of a manager who mostly paid market rate and occasionally overpaid, with MarShawn Lloyd taken nearly five rounds early and Kayshon Boutte nearly three rounds before his ADP. The one genuine bright spot is Jaylen Waddle, whose move from Miami's dysfunction to a Denver offense that led the league in pass attempts last year gives him a real path to outperforming his WR23 projection. Jahmyr Gibbs as a projected RB1 gives this roster a genuine anchor, and Jayden Daniels at QB5 is legitimately strong. But after those two, the projections fade fast, Jalen Coker profiles as the weakest projected starter at WR55, and there is no obvious piece left to move. This roster needs things to break right, and right now it is not built to survive when they do not.

There is a creeping hopelessness to JJNUFC's 2026 outlook, and the numbers do a poor job of hiding it. The receiver group is genuinely good, anchored by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and supported by Tetairoa McMillan, Garrett Wilson, and Luther Burden, and Tyler Warren at TE4 gives the lineup a dependable foundation. But quality at the top only goes so far when the rest of the roster is projecting toward the basement, and JJNUFC sits ninth in the FIFA Football division at the 25th tournament percentile. The projected weakest starter is Rico Dowdle, a back who spent 2025 surpassing 1,000 yards for Carolina only to get shown the door, and who now lands in Pittsburgh behind Jaylen Warren with an unclear path to consistent fantasy relevance. That is a thin margin for error in a spot that desperately needs more. Last year's 9-27 record placed the team in the 11th scoring percentile, and nothing in this draft, which produced three major reaches and only one genuine steal, suggests the trajectory is changing.

GTWGTC arrives in 2026 sitting eighth in the FIFA Football division and in just the 37th percentile of the field, and the roster construction doesn't suggest a dramatic reversal is coming. The draft is where the wheels started to wobble: Rashod Bateman was taken nearly five rounds ahead of his ADP, Calvin Ridley nearly three and a half rounds early, and those kinds of reaches tend to cost a manager the late-round depth that separates good rosters from great ones. The top of the lineup has genuine upside, Christian McCaffrey grades out as RB3 and Lamar Jackson as QB3, but the rest of the projected starters fade quickly, with Rhamondre Stevenson projected as RB31 anchoring the bottom of the lineup. The Kyler Murray situation adds fog rather than clarity: a lisfranc injury that didn't heal properly, a midseason shutdown in Arizona, a fresh start in Minnesota, and a "true competition" with JJ McCarthy that could easily go sideways. GTWGTC isn't without talent, but the margin for error is thin and the draft gave most of it away.

HashtagBelieve sits at 44th percentile and seventh in the division, which is precisely as medium as it sounds. The receiver group is genuinely good, with Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), Nico Collins (WR9), and Malik Nabers (WR12) all projected starters and all capable of winning a week outright. It is the margins around that core where this season gets decided. Nabers is the clearest example: his redraft value cratered from a top-10 receiver in May to WR21 in July after a torn ACL, then clawed back with a clean training camp. Every week he suits up healthy, this roster gets incrementally harder to beat. Every week he does not, the math tightens. The draft told a similar story of threading needles, three steals, including Patrick Mahomes (QB12) falling more than two full rounds past his ADP. None of those finds are transformative alone, but stacked together they represent the kind of quiet edge that separates a team that finishes around .500 from one that sneaks into the money.

OneDaveHendo sits 6th in the FIFA Football division and at the 55th percentile of the field, numbers that look modest until you consider how cleanly this draft was constructed. There was no single transcendent pick, just a consistent ability to let value come to them. Caleb Williams, a projected QB6, slid more than a round past his ADP before OneDaveHendo scooped him at 4.10, and De'Von Achane, a projected RB6, was similarly available a full seven picks later than he should have been. That kind of patience adds up. The one blot on the draft sheet is Matthew Stafford, taken at 2.10 when his ADP sat at 6.02, a reach of more than three rounds that spent premium capital early. The saving grace is that Stafford anchors two live stacks with Puka Nacua, a projected WR1, and Davante Adams, a projected WR25, meaning the reach at least came with connective tissue. This roster did not win the draft on one bold swing. It won it pick by pick, and that tends to age well.

RyanGriffiths21 did not build this roster on one flashy gamble. They built it play by play, and the result is a starting group that is quietly difficult to argue with. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and James Cook at RB5 form a backfield foundation that most managers would trade half their draft for, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 arriving nearly a round late counts as the kind of low-key win that separates sharp drafters from lucky ones. Chase Brown at RB11 and Breece Hall at RB14 only deepen the case. The Jordan Love steal, pulled at pick 12.03 against an ADP of 7.06, adds a QB17 projection at a discount that pairs neatly with a Christian Watson stack for tournament-week upside. The draft sheet reads mostly chalk, which sounds boring until you realize the chalk was right: sixteen picks near consensus value, one legitimate steal, and a starting group whose weakest projected contributor is Jadarian Price at RB26. That is not a complaint. That is a well-constructed team sitting at 60th percentile and pointed upward.

SteveyH6 finished 26-10 last season and landed in the 81st percentile in scoring, so when the draft board shows three major reaches, the instinct is to wince. But look at what those reaches bought. Josh Jacobs, pulled 1.4 rounds early, projects as RB16 and slots in as a starter alongside Ashton Jeanty, who fell nearly a full round past his ADP and lands as RB7. That is a backfield core that looks a lot better than the draft-room optics suggest. The reach on Cade Otton at TE27 is the one that raises an eyebrow, especially with Hunter Henry, David Njoku, and two others already sitting at the position, but in a positionless format the surplus is an asset, not a problem. Justin Jefferson rounding out the top of the roster as WR6 after falling more than half a round adds another layer of legitimacy. Baker Mayfield's trajectory in Tampa is genuinely murky without Mike Evans, but Josh Allen as QB1 keeps that concern from mattering much. This roster could absolutely be a product of conviction. It could also be luck. At 62nd percentile, the gap between those two answers matters.

paynotron didn't reshape the landscape with one blockbuster swing. They just kept winning the exchange, round after round, until the roster quietly became something worth respecting. The headliner is Trevor Lawrence, snagged a full two rounds past his ADP and projecting as QB10, a player of that caliber sitting in the sixth round because the room slept on him. That kind of value doesn't happen twice in a draft, but paynotron also pulled Brock Purdy at QB13 more than a round after he should have been gone. The skill position core backs all of it up: Bijan Robinson projecting at RB2 anchors the top of the lineup, while A.J. Brown at WR8, Rashee Rice at WR13, and Emeka Egbuka at WR18 give paynotron a tier of projected starters that most managers in the FIFA Football division simply cannot match. Thirteen chalk picks and only three minor reaches tells you this wasn't a gambler's draft. It was a patient, disciplined accumulation of upside, and it landed paynotron comfortably in the 75th percentile before a single week is played.

connorahumpage didn't win the draft in one flashy moment. They won it pick by pick, round by round, and the standings are already reflecting it, with a division rank of 2 and a place in the top 10 percent of the field. The foundation is Ja'Marr Chase, a WR2 who barely needs an introduction, paired with Drake London at WR7 and Zay Flowers at WR16, giving this roster a top end that most managers spent their whole draft chasing. Then consider that Jared Goff, a QB16 projection, was still on the board at pick 11.04 when his ADP sat at 6.04, a five-round freefall that connorahumpage was simply alert enough to catch. Carnell Tate at WR29 is the kind of bet that rewards patience, a pass-catcher now linked with Cam Ward in Tennessee after going fourth overall in the NFL Draft, a pairing that carries genuine upside if it clicks. Fifteen chalk picks on a roster this good means the value came from precision, not gambling, and that is a difficult combination to beat.

AlexG86 didn't build this roster with one flashy move, and that's exactly the point. Landing Trey McBride at TE2 with a second-round pick when his ADP sat nearly a round earlier is the kind of quiet win that separates disciplined drafters from lucky ones, and pulling Jaxson Dart at QB11 in round eight when the market had him going in round five is the sort of late-round patience that compounds. Pair those values with a core that already includes CeeDee Lamb at WR5, Jalen Hurts at QB9, and the Hurts-DeVonta Smith stack baked right in, and you're looking at a team that didn't need a single home-run swing because it was consistently winning the smaller arguments round by round. The 2025 season, a 64-percent win rate and a top-quarter scoring finish, reads less like a fluke than like a proof of concept. AlexG86 sits first in the FIFA Football division and in the 90th percentile of the field, and nothing about this draft suggests that was accidental.
