There is no charitable reading of rorschacher's 2026 outlook, and believe me, this team has been stared at long enough for one to emerge. Sitting 12th in the Mario Division and at just the 7th percentile of the field, the roster grades out as one of the weakest in the tournament, and the draft did nothing to change the trajectory: zero steals, zero values, and a pair of major reaches headlined by Khalil Shakir at WR51, a player who projects as the weakest starter on a team that cannot afford weak starters. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 is a genuine anchor, and the receiving corps has real names, George Pickens at WR10 and Tee Higgins at WR19 among them, but the backend collapses fast toward Jauan Jennings and Jerry Jeudy territory. Even the Dak Prescott and Pickens stack, while sensible, feels less like a weapon and more like a coping mechanism. This team needed the draft to be a lifeline. It was not.

There is no polite way to say this: girlldad is projected 11th in the Mario Division and sits in just the 16th percentile of the field, and the roster does not hide why. The draft offered almost no help, producing zero steals, just two values, and a pair of major reaches that sting in hindsight, most notably Kyler Murray taken more than two rounds ahead of his ADP when the shelf was not yet bare. The saving grace is a genuinely elite top end at tight end, where Brock Bowers checks in at TE1 and Colston Loveland at TE3, a pairing that is legitimately unfair to most of the field. But above-average tight end play only carries a lineup so far when the rest of the projected starters grade out as middling at best, and Kenneth Gainwell, the weakest projected starter on the roster at RB34, is the kind of name that keeps a manager awake in August. Rashee Rice and Garrett Wilson give the passing-game contributors some real teeth, but the margin for error here is essentially gone before the season begins.

There is something particularly brutal about doing almost everything right and still landing at 10th in the Mario Division. Hahdee drafted with patience and discipline, finishing with 14 chalk picks, one steal in Cam Ward and almost no costly reaches, which is the kind of draft that should produce a competitive roster. And yet here we are. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with CeeDee Lamb, A.J. Brown, and Chris Olave all projecting as starters, and that trio alone would carry most teams. But the rest of the roster never quite delivers on the promise those names suggest. Jordan Love checks in at QB17 with Ward at QB23 behind him, and the combined quarterback picture is thin enough to matter in a format where top-end scoring wins weeks. Jaylen Warren projects as the weakest starter at RB27, and last year's 14th-percentile scoring finish is less a fluke than a warning. Hahdee assembled the right pieces in the right order and still ended up with a puzzle that doesn't resolve. That is the cruelest thing a draft can do to a manager.

GrumpyRaider is sitting ninth in the Mario Division and hovering around the 25th percentile of the field, and the roster data offers little reason to feel differently about the ceiling. The foundation is not nothing: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 give this team two genuinely elite weapons, and on a good week those two alone can carry a lineup. The problem is what surrounds them. The draft was almost entirely chalk, with 17 picks landing right at ADP and zero genuine steals to show for it, meaning GrumpyRaider built this team without manufacturing a single edge. Worse, the one moment the manager swung with conviction, taking Rhamondre Stevenson a staggering 3.2 rounds ahead of schedule, they landed the projected weakest starter on the roster at RB31. The tight end group is the thinnest on the sheet, and the quarterback room leans on Justin Herbert and Trevor Lawrence without inspiring much confidence beyond that. McCaffrey and Jefferson are real. Everything else feels like a team that drafted cautiously and reached in exactly the wrong spot.

FFJuunkie enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Mario Division and at just the 43rd percentile tournament-wide, and the roster offers precious little reason for optimism. The top of the lineup is genuinely good: Trey McBride projects as TE2, De'Von Achane as RB6, and Malik Nabers, when healthy, is the kind of WR12 talent who can carry a week by himself. That last qualifier is doing a lot of heavy lifting here. Nabers spent most of last year recovering from a torn ACL that his new head coach called "not simple," and while he escaped the PUP list and flashed his old self in training camp, a full Week 1 workload remains an open question. Peel back those top names and the drop-off is steep: Chuba Hubbard projects as the weakest projected starter at RB29, the quarterback room tops out at Bo Nix as QB15, and last season's 37th-percentile scoring tells you this foundation has underperformed before. The pieces to contend simply are not there, and FFJuunkie may need Nabers to be fully himself just to stay relevant.

RYNOS is the team that exists in the tournament's uncanny valley, too good to fade quietly, not quite built to make noise. The floor is real: James Cook (RB5), Omarion Hampton (RB9), and Derrick Henry (RB12) give this roster a punishing ground-level foundation, and Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) is a genuine difference-maker at the top of the receiving corps. But a 44th-percentile projection does not lie, and the margins are where RYNOS will either climb or dissolve. The Brock Purdy (QB13) and Mike Evans (WR27) stack adds a ceiling that a flat roster would lack, yet Purdy's asterisk feels like it comes with fine print attached, and the drop to Malik Willis (QB24) or Jacoby Brissett (QB28) is steep enough to matter in close weeks. Sixteen chalk picks out of twenty drafts means RYNOS built by the book, which is not a crime, but it does mean there is no hidden arbitrage quietly waiting to flip the standings.

Seventh in the Mario Division is where this team lives right now. Whether it stays there depends entirely on the margins going right.

Coachspeak Index finished last year right around the tournament median and enters 2026 with a roster that quietly looks better than that. The draft board will not be kind to this manager's reputation: two major reaches, two minor reaches, and not a single steal among the 19 selections. But the players themselves keep arguing back. Josh Allen at QB1 is a foundational piece almost no one else can claim, and the decision to pair him with Jaxson Dart at QB11, taken a full round after his ADP, shows that when the board broke right, this team grabbed it. The real question is Jonathon Brooks, pulled two-plus rounds ahead of schedule and slotted as a projected starter at RB37. That is either the kind of conviction that separates sharp managers from the field, or the kind that shows up in a postmortem. The supporting cast, Saquon Barkley, Breece Hall, Nico Collins, and Marvin Harrison Jr. all projecting as starters, is genuinely strong. Whether Brooks vindicates the approach or exposes it will likely decide whether this team climbs out of the middle of the field or stays there.

FTHOSEGUYS didn't swing for the fences and miss, they just kept making the right call, round after round, and the roster reflects it. Lamar Jackson at QB3 landed a tick past his ADP at 2.08, a small discount on a player who needs no introduction. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 anchors the skill position group with the kind of projection that makes a lineup difficult to beat on any given week. Pair those two with Tyler Warren at TE4 and Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31, both projected starters, and you have a core that gives FTHOSEGUYS a real ceiling. The late-round reaches on Jaylen Wright and Jaydon Blue are the one wrinkle worth watching, since both were taken more than seven rounds ahead of ADP, meaning the upside there is speculative. But with TreVeyon Henderson at RB19 and Emeka Egbuka at WR18 also in the projected starting mix, those gambles sit comfortably behind a lineup that earned its 66th percentile standing through execution, not luck.

FullyLoadedFF looks like a team that simply drafted better than its neighbors, round after round, without needing one spectacular heist to bail out a sloppy board. The foundation is Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, a genuine top-of-the-market asset, supported by a starting corps that includes Drake Maye at QB2 and Jayden Daniels at QB5, the latter paired in a stack with Terry McLaurin at WR24 that gives this roster a built-in multiplier whenever Daniels goes off. Maye himself is the draft's clearest win here, sliding nearly a full round past his ADP to land at 2.12, the kind of quiet overpay by the field that compounds over a season. The rest of the board was largely chalk, which sounds boring until you remember that chalk means the manager identified value correctly and pulled the trigger without hesitation. Coming off an 86-percent win rate and a 95th-percentile scoring season in 2025, FullyLoadedFF enters 2026 sitting fourth in the Mario Division but projecting at the 72nd percentile of the field, a roster positioned to climb with very little needing to go right.

There was no flashy gamble here, no reaching for a guy three rounds early and hoping the football gods cooperate. Well, almost. What davidejberger did was quieter and more reliable: he let the board come to him. Joe Burrow fell nearly half a round past his ADP, Patrick Mahomes slid a full round and change, and C.J. Stroud dropped a round and a half before this team scooped him up. Three quarterbacks, each taken at a discount, each projecting as legitimate contributors at QB4, QB12, and QB22 respectively. That kind of patience at a position tends to compound. Layer in Puka Nacua at WR1 and Tucker Kraft at TE5 anchoring the starting lineup, and you have a team built on real projected value rather than vibes. The 2025 record of 16 and 20 suggests some regression to the mean is waiting to happen in the right direction, and at 79th percentile entering 2026, third in the Mario Division, davidejberger looks positioned to collect.

ElwayRoseHasItsThorn didn't build this roster on one flashy swing. They built it by winning exchange after exchange on draft day, and the cumulative effect is a team sitting second in the Mario Division and in the 79th percentile of the field. The foundation is a backfield headlined by Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7, two projected starters who give this team a ceiling most managers would trade a kidney for. Layer in Caleb Williams at QB6, grabbed nearly two rounds after his ADP, and Sam Darnold at QB21, a steal taken more than two rounds late, and you start to see the pattern: ElwayRoseHasItsThorn consistently found value where the board left it. Travis Kelce, back for another season after some offseason uncertainty and pushing to re-enter the TE12 conversation, adds a familiar name with real upside at TE10. DeVonta Smith at WR14 was the one meaningful reach of the draft, but when the rest of your picks keep coming in under market, you've earned the right to pay a small premium.

TomEverettScott enters 2026 sitting first in the Mario Division and in the 96th percentile of the field, and the draft log explains exactly why. There was no lottery-ticket gamble, no desperate swing for upside. Just a manager who kept coming out ahead on value, round after round. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Drake London at WR7 give this team a receiver group that is genuinely difficult to match at the top, and Zay Flowers at WR16 and Carnell Tate at WR29 keep the quality from dropping off a cliff behind them. Jalen Hurts, snagged a round and a half past his ADP, pairs naturally with Dallas Goedert, and that connection adds a layer of floor that pure upside rosters rarely carry. Harold Fannin came in over a round late as well, landing a TE6 projection at a discount. Three values, sixteen chalk picks, and zero reaches is not a flashy draft story, but it is a winning one. The weakest projected starter is Jakobi Meyers at WR45, which is a fine problem to have.
