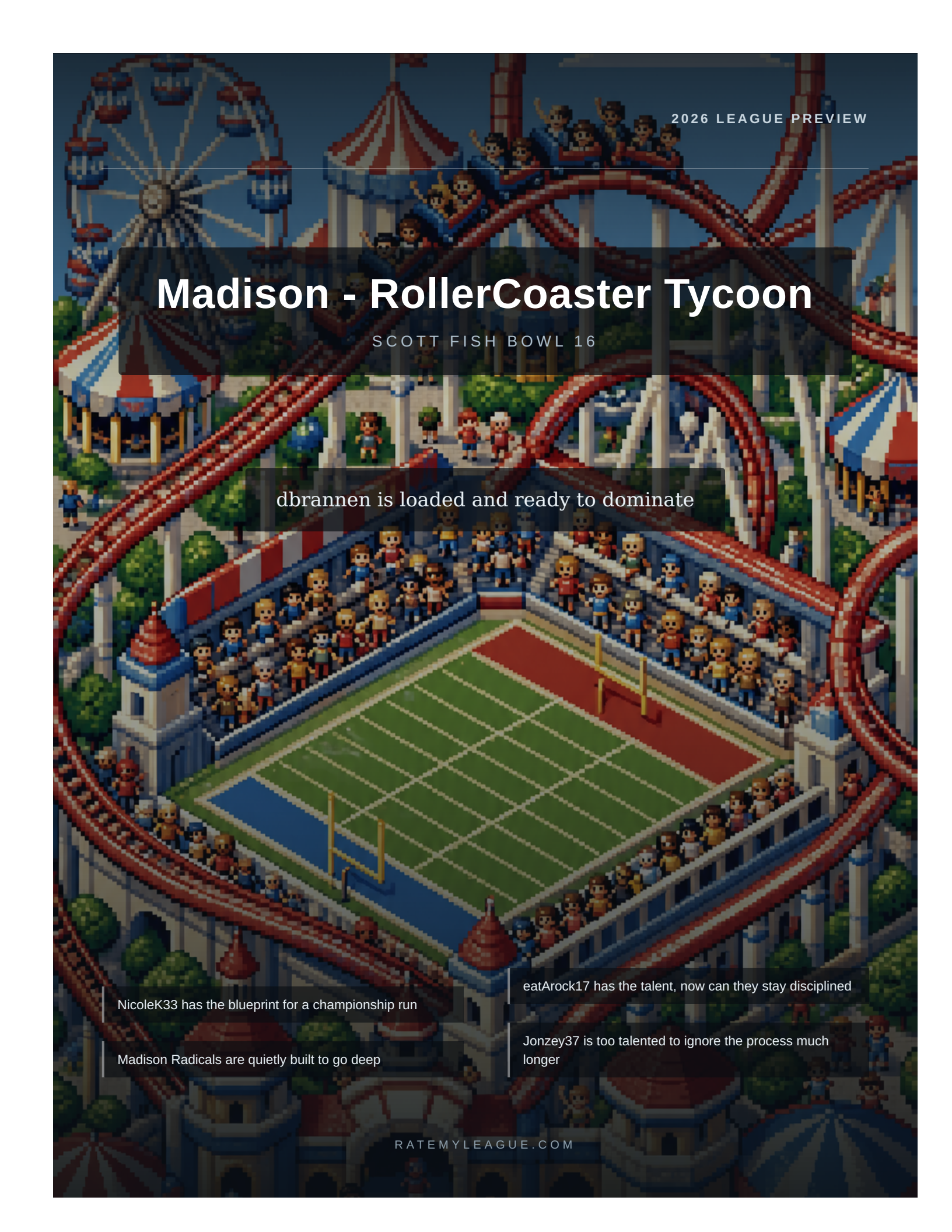

Run13 looked like a competent operation a year ago, finishing in the 66th percentile with a 23-13 record, but 2026 projections tell a bleaker story: 12th in the RollerCoaster Tycoon division and 13th percentile tournament-wide, with almost no obvious way to climb. The quarterback situation is the most glaring drag, with Tyler Shough at QB20 and C.J. Stroud at QB22 forming what is quietly one of the weakest starting pairs in the field. James Cook at RB5 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 are genuine difference-makers, but Jefferson's value hinges on whether Kyler Murray can do what JJ McCarthy never managed, which is actually connect with him, and that uncertainty makes projecting the upside here genuinely uncomfortable. The tight end group centered on Harold Fannin, Sam LaPorta, and Travis Kelce grades out strong, though run13 reached two rounds early to land LaPorta in Round 4, so the cost was real. With no steals in the draft and the quarterback ceiling capped near the bottom of the field, this roster feels like a machine with one very important gear missing.

There is no charitable read available on ahbari98's 2026 draft, and the numbers confirm it with depressing efficiency: zero steals, zero values, eleven chalk picks, and four major reaches scattered across the board like breadcrumbs leading nowhere good. The major reaches are the real story here. Hockenson at TE23 was drafted three-plus rounds ahead of where the market said to take him. Calvin Ridley at WR78 cost nearly five rounds of premium capital. Christian Kirk at WR100 cost four more. The receiver group is thin on projected contribution, with Romeo Doubs, the projected weakest starter, coming in at WR53, and the supporting cast behind him fading fast. The foundation with Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 gives this roster something to stand on, but a manager who spends like ahbari98 did in those middle and late rounds will have a hard time making that foundation matter. Division rank of 11th and a 17th-percentile projection do not feel like a surprise. They feel like an invoice.

There is no charitable read available for CoachCraig in 2026, and the draft receipts make that case better than any editorial could. Six major reaches across the board tell the story, but two stand out as particularly damning: Chris Brazzell II, a WR101 projection, pulled seven rounds before his ADP, and J.J. McCarthy, sitting at QB37, cost a 17th-round pick when the field wasn't taking quarterbacks until round 21. That is not aggressive drafting, that is panic at the keyboard. The one legitimately strong piece here is the tight end pairing of Trey McBride (TE2) and Tyler Warren (TE4), but Warren himself was a reach, taken nearly a full round early. Everything downstream from those decisions lands softly: a quarterback room anchored by Jordan Love at QB17, projected starters like Terry McLaurin (WR24) and Christian Watson (WR28) who are fine but not foundational, and a tournament percentile sitting at 17th. CoachCraig's 2025 campaign finished above water at 58 percent. This roster does not look like a team trying to build on that.

There is a version of hammy88's 2026 season where everything breaks right, and it still probably lands outside the top quarter of the field. Sitting ninth in the RollerCoaster Tycoon division and in just the 29th tournament percentile, this roster has a ceiling problem as much as a floor problem. The top of the lineup is genuinely exciting: Lamar Jackson at QB3 stacked with Zay Flowers at WR16 gives hammy88 a high-voltage pairing that can torch a slate, and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and DeVonta Smith at WR14 are legitimate weekly difference-makers. But the draft process showed its cracks in ways that matter. Matthew Golden, projected WR52, was taken nearly four rounds ahead of his market price, and Jerry Jeudy at WR66 cost three rounds of premium on a player the projections view as a fringe contributor. That is draft capital that could have shored up depth, instead spent on wishful thinking at the margin. When your weakest projected starter is Kenyon Sadiq at TE21 and your best levers have already been pulled, hope is not a strategy.

MsDasher heads into 2026 sitting eighth in the RollerCoaster Tycoon division and in just the 37th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The headliner is Brock Bowers at TE1, a genuinely elite anchor, but the rest of the projected starters cluster in frustrating middle ground: Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and Ladd McConkey at WR20 are fine, not feared. The draft only deepened the concern. Tucker Kraft was the most glaring decision, taken nearly two and a half rounds before his ADP to land a TE5, a price that would sting even if Bowers were not already locking up the position. Malik Washington went five full rounds ahead of his ADP and projects as WR71, which is the kind of reach that haunts a roster in the late weeks when it matters most. Coming off a 33 percent win rate and 27th-percentile scoring in 2025, MsDasher needed a bold, efficient draft to climb the standings. This was not that draft.

codywcarter is 51st percentile made flesh, a team that will win the games it is supposed to win and lose the ones it is supposed to lose and spend the whole season sweating over the handful of matchups that refuse to cooperate with either outcome. The floor is real: Caleb Williams at QB6 anchors the lineup, and the Williams-Luther Burden stack gives the team a bonus multiplier on its best nights. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Malik Nabers at WR12 are legitimate weapons. But the margins are thin enough that the season might hinge on something as mundane as Jordan Addison performing like WR43 on a week the rest of the roster goes quiet. The 2025 campaign ended in the 8th percentile in scoring, which is the kind of result that either reshapes a manager's philosophy entirely or doesn't, and the draft here suggests it didn't, with 16 chalk picks and no steals. Mike Evans, now with San Francisco after his streak of 1,000-yard seasons ended last year, is the wild card. If he holds up, the ceiling rises. If he doesn't, codywcarter is exactly what the division rank suggests: seventh, comfortable, forgettable.

Jonzey37 sits at 69th percentile and sixth in the RollerCoaster Tycoon division, which sounds modest until you look at how the roster was actually built. The board lit up with early pick counts on nearly every selection, four minor reaches and two major ones across the draft, yet the finished product holds Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 anchoring a Burrow stack, George Pickens at WR10, Garrett Wilson at WR17, and Emeka Egbuka at WR18 all projecting as starters. That is not a manager who panicked early and paid for it. That is someone who identified a philosophy, specifically loading up on premium pass catchers, and executed it with enough conviction to ignore the board entirely. The Michael Pittman situation adds a layer of uncertainty, given that Pittsburgh's offense enters 2026 searching for an identity behind a 43-year-old Aaron Rodgers, but Pittman as WR44 was taken before his ADP anyway, suggesting Jonzey37 liked the upside more than feared the risk. Whether that is vision or fortune, the ceiling here is real.

kevob100 didn't swing for the fences and whiff or stumble into something great, they just drafted well, repeatedly, and the cumulative effect is a roster that lands at the 70th percentile with room to grow. The foundation is a deep group of projected starters headlined by Omarion Hampton at RB9 and Jeremiyah Love at RB13, and that ground-level quality extends through Travis Etienne at RB18 and Cam Skattebo at RB20. On the perimeter, Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3 and A.J. Brown as WR8, giving this roster genuine upside at the skill positions where tournaments are decided. The draft itself was disciplined: three good values including Makai Lemon at WR40 taken a full round late, and a steal in Keaton Mitchell at RB49 who slid nearly three rounds past his ADP. The one mild knock is the QB room, where Trevor Lawrence projects as QB10 and Malik Willis is the backup, but in a

positionless format with this much firepower elsewhere, that's a manageable tradeoff. Coming off a 75 percent win rate in 2025, kevob100 looks built to contend again.

The draft board will tell you eatArock17 reached. The roster will politely disagree. This team landed Puka Nacua at WR1 and Colston Loveland at TE3 as projected starters, built a receiver corps that extends through Nico Collins at WR9 and Jameson Williams at WR21, and did it while logging two major reaches and zero steals across the entire draft. That is not a profile that is supposed to produce a 71st-percentile roster. And yet here we are. The Matthew Stafford and Nacua stack gives this team a ceiling that most managers in the RollerCoaster Tycoon division would envy, and Stafford himself was the mildest of the reaches, pulled one round early at a time when QB14 production is genuinely worth the urgency. The two major reaches, Deshaun Watson and Pat Bryant, are the fine print on an otherwise convincing document. Neither projects to matter much. Whether eatArock17 earned this roster through vision or simply got away with aggression, the 2025 scoreboard, 81 percent wins and a 97th-percentile scoring season, suggests this manager knows something the ADP does not.

Madison Radicals finished 25-11 last season and landed in the 84th percentile in scoring, and the 2026 roster suggests that was no fluke. The draft was quiet in the best possible way: three values, sixteen chalk, one reach, and a cumulative effect that left this roster sitting comfortably at 75th percentile in the field. Drake Maye is the engine, a QB2 projection who spent last year making average weapons look like more than they were, and the Patriots' offseason addition of A.J. Brown figures to make that job considerably easier. Jayden Daniels landing at 3.11 when his ADP sat at 2.12 was the kind of small edge that separates a good draft from a sharp one. Kyle Pitts and Isaiah Likely project as starters at TE7 and TE13 respectively, Likely himself sliding a full round past his ADP. Christian McCaffrey, Tetairoa McMillan, and Brian Thomas Jr. round out a starting group with no obvious soft spots. Third in the RollerCoaster Tycoon division is where this team sits entering the season, but nothing about this roster says that ceiling holds.

dbrannen came to the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft with a plan and executed it with the kind of calm that makes other managers second-guess their own boards. The headliners are genuinely impressive: Josh Allen at QB1 anchors a lineup that also features Drake London at WR7, Rashee Rice at WR13, and Derrick Henry at RB12, all projected starters built around a core that carried this team to a 96th-percentile scoring season in 2025. What separates a good draft from a clean one, though, is the value underneath, and dbrannen found it. Gunnar Helm landed nearly three full rounds after his ADP, Hunter Henry and Cade Otton both came at a discount, and Brian Robinson slid into the late rounds as a quiet asset. The one genuine uncertainty is Josh Jacobs, whose off-field situation remains unresolved and puts his availability in question. But a team sitting second in the RollerCoaster Tycoon division at the 78th percentile of the field, with zero reaches on the board and multiple values stacked in

the back half, can absorb that kind of ambiguity. dbrannen drafted for that possibility without panic. That discipline is the whole story here.

NicoleK33 sits atop the RollerCoaster Tycoon division heading into 2026, and the draft tells you exactly why. There was no single moment of genius here, just a manager who kept coming out ahead on value. Jalen Hurts landing at 5.04 when his ADP sat at 3.12 is the clearest example: a QB9 projection for a round-five price is the kind of quiet advantage that compounds across a season. Then there is the backfield, where Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give this roster a top-tier foundation before you even get to Ashton Jeanty at RB7. Six value picks against zero steals and zero minor reaches paints a picture of a drafter who was disciplined, patient, and rarely wrong. The one blemish, Jared Goff taken nearly two rounds before his ADP, is the exception that proves the rule. At the 84th percentile of the tournament field, NicoleK33 has built something worth taking seriously.
