There is no charitable read available for Always a McBride's Maid, a team sitting at the 6th percentile of the field after a 2025 campaign that produced a 33% win rate and a 22nd-percentile finish in scoring. The draft did not fix anything. Three major reaches define this roster's construction, and the worst of them is Darnell Washington, a TE38 taken six full rounds before his ADP, burning a 16th-round pick on a player who projects as the third tight end on this depth chart. Jared Goff, a QB16, went in round three at the cost of 2.3 rounds of premium draft capital, a price that made sense for nobody outside of this draft room. Meanwhile, David Montgomery, the one player the data credits as a genuine value, arrives in Houston competing with Woody Marks for a backfield that was nobody's idea of a promised land, just the best available exit from Detroit. When your most encouraging roster note is a RB23 who changed teams out of necessity, the rest of the preview writes itself.

JakeFFingTrow enters 2026 sitting at the 8th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The reach count here is genuinely alarming: four major reaches in a single draft, including Travis Kelce pulled two full rounds early at pick 5.04 and Mark Andrews yanked off the board at 6.09, a TE14 projection treated like a first-round cornerstone. That kind of aggressive overpayment does not reflect a manager with a plan so much as one who opened the draft with a theme and refused to let the board talk them out of it. Chigoziem Okonkwo at TE19 cost two rounds of surplus, Greg Dulcich at TE25 cost two more, and the one moment Jake actually let value come to him, Colby Parkinson falling three rounds past ADP, landed a player projected TE31. The team logged a single steal against four major reaches and finished with a projected starter in Hunter Henry at TE18. Last year's 85th-percentile scoring feels very far away right now.

JohnnyBGoodeDFF enters 2026 sitting 10th in the Super Smash Bros division and in just the 24th tournament percentile, and the roster does little to suggest a dramatic reversal is coming. The receiver group is genuinely elite on paper, anchored by Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), CeeDee Lamb (WR5), and Malik Nabers (WR12), and Lamb arriving two full rounds past his ADP is the kind of draft-day win that usually signals a well-constructed team. But the construction around that core is where things get ugly. Jordan Love (QB17) and Baker Mayfield (QB18) represent some of the weakest projected quarterback options in the field, and when your weakest projected starter is Xavier Worthy (WR49), you are leaning hard on the top end holding up with zero margin. Meanwhile, Jack Bech was taken nearly five rounds before his ADP and Tory Horton nearly three rounds early, burning late capital on speculative depth rather than shoring up the foundation. Last season's 44-percent win rate already told a version of this story, and nothing about this roster construction suggests the ending changes.

TheTank77 enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Super Smash Bros division and in just the 41st percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The brightest spots are real: De'Von Achane projects as RB6 and Jaxon Smith-Njigba as WR3, a legitimate one-two punch that gives the team a pulse. But the drop-off beyond those two is steep and unforgiving. Kenneth Walker III at RB10 is a serviceable third piece, yet the rest of the projected starters, including Dallas Goedert at TE15 and Emeka Egbuka at WR18, grade out as the kind of contributors that win you nothing on their own. The draft did not help matters either, producing zero steals, fifteen chalk picks, and a major reach on J.K. Dobbins, grabbed more than two rounds before his ADP. Coming off an 11-25 campaign that ranked in just the 36th percentile of scoring, TheTank77 needed an aggressive, high-upside offseason. What it got instead was more of the same, and in a tournament this competitive, treading water means sinking.

Yoshi-meRollin did almost everything right on draft day, and that makes the projected 48th percentile finish sting more than any reckless reach ever could. The manager found real value, landing Jayden Daniels three rounds past his ADP and Jaylen Warren nearly two rounds late, patience that should be rewarded. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and James Cook at RB5 give this roster a legitimate top-end core, and Caleb Williams sliding to the fourth round was a gift the manager correctly accepted. But somewhere between the smart process and the final roster, the math stopped working. The receiver group projects as genuinely weak, with Makai Lemon at WR40 as the best option among starters, and no amount of backfield depth changes that calculus in a positionless format where the best players simply play. Thirteen chalk picks and four values produced a draft with almost no wasted capital, and the result is a team sitting eighth in the Super Smash Bros division anyway. Good process. Insufficient outcome. The cruelest kind of draft to explain.

Little Mac Attack sits at the tournament's 50th percentile heading into 2026, and the honest case for a better outcome rests almost entirely on a concentration of elite talent at the top of the roster. Joe Burrow at QB4 and Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 are the kinds of projected anchors that can carry a lineup week after week in a positionless format, and the supporting cast underneath them is genuinely interesting. Tucker Kraft projects as TE5, and Kraft landing alongside Kyle Pitts at TE7 and Sam LaPorta at TE8 means three starting-caliber tight ends feeding into a lineup that can simply deploy the best option each week. The draft did show some cracks. Kraft was the most aggressive investment, taken 1.5 rounds ahead of his ADP in round three, and Jonathon Brooks was pulled nearly 2.5 rounds early as well. Whether those bets land will shape whether this team overachieves its projection or confirms it. The talent at the top is real. Everything else is a question.

Wyld Stallions finished 2026 in the 52nd percentile, sixth in the Super Smash Bros division, which is exactly as interesting as it sounds: not threatening enough to fear, not broken enough to bury. The roster is defined by its spine, Christian McCaffrey at RB3, Breece Hall at RB14, and Nico Collins at WR9 giving the team a legitimate floor, but it's the margins where this season gets decided. Collins was a minor reach at 2.05 against an ADP of 2.11, and Jaxson Dart was a genuine steal, falling more than two rounds past his ADP before the manager grabbed him at 7.08, landing a QB11 projection for late-round cost. Those edges matter when the gap between winning and losing a week is three points. What could tilt things the wrong way is Ray Davis, a RB62 projection taken three full rounds before his ADP, which is the kind of optimistic swing that looks prescient if you're right and looks like the reason you missed the cut if you're not. Wyld Stallions isn't built to dominate. It's built to survive long enough for the margins to fall its way.

JT didn't need a headline pick to build something worth watching. The foundation here is quietly strong: Drake London at WR7, Trey McBride at TE2, and Chase Brown at RB11 form a projected starting core that most managers in the Super Smash Bros division would trade for without blinking. What separates this draft from a merely competent one is how consistently JT came out ahead on value. Travis Etienne fell nearly two full rounds past his ADP before JT scooped him at RB18, Courtland Sutton slid 1.7 rounds before landing on this roster, and Cam Ward dropped a full round and a half into JT's lap. That's not luck, that's a manager who did the homework and waited. The one blemish is Calvin Ridley, a 3.3-round reach that stands out on an otherwise disciplined sheet. Still, sitting at 57th percentile in the field and fifth in the division, this team has the pieces to climb. The draft just kept delivering, and that tends to matter come September.

JaMarth Chase landed at 65th percentile in the tournament and fourth in the Super Smash Bros division, and that standing reflects a roster built the right way: not on one flashy swing, but on a draft that kept winning small edges. The centerpiece is Ja'Marr Chase, a WR2 projection who anchors the whole enterprise, and A.J. Brown at WR8 gives this team a second receiver most managers would start a franchise around. The receiver depth continues with Jaylen Waddle at WR23, Mike Evans at WR27, and DK Metcalf at WR36, all projected starters, which means the quality floor barely dips across the lineup. Saquon Barkley at RB8 supplies reliable upside on the ground. The draft chart backs the eye test: one steal, two solid values, and only three minor reaches across the entire board. Justin Herbert, secured a round and a half past his ADP, is the interesting late-stage bet, with Mike McDaniel now running the offense in Los Angeles and reasons to think Herbert's arrow is pointing up after a few quieter years. This roster did not lurch toward upside, it accumulated it.

joeybagobarley landed at 72nd percentile and third in the division, and the most interesting question the roster raises is whether that happened because of the draft strategy or in spite of it. The reach column is the tell: Adonai Mitchell taken 3.1 rounds early, Dontayvion Wicks pulled an almost absurd 5.1 rounds ahead of his ADP. Those are the kinds of picks that make draft analysts wince and post passive-aggressive tweets. But zoom out and the top of this roster is genuinely hard to argue with, headlined by Josh Allen at QB1, Ashton Jeanty at RB7, and Omarion Hampton at RB9, all projected starters. That is a foundation most managers in this field would trade for without blinking. The reaches at the bottom of the board look a lot less reckless when the top is built like that, and the two values, Tony Pollard and Brenton Strange, suggest joeybagobarley was not purely swinging blind. Strange figures to remain the primary receiving option for Jacksonville regardless of the blocking competition around him. Conviction or luck, the result holds up.

Johnson333 didn't build this roster on one flashy pick, just round after round of quiet accumulation. The running back group anchors everything: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Javonte Williams at RB17 give this team a ceiling most managers would envy, and the depth behind them tells the real story of how the draft went. Bucky Irving (RB21), Rhamondre Stevenson (RB31), and Jordan Mason (RB41) were all taken a round and a half to nearly two rounds after their ADPs, meaning Johnson333 consistently got players at prices that belonged to worse ones. Dak Prescott landing at QB7 while slipping nearly two full rounds past his ADP was a similar quiet win, and the Prescott/George Pickens stack gives this team a week-winning ceiling that pure positional quality doesn't capture. The receiver group, led by Pickens and Chris Olave at WR11, holds its own without asking for special treatment. A 2025 record of 58 percent wins already told you this manager knows how to convert a good roster into results, and this one is better.

StephenRoto didn't build this roster with one thunderbolt pick. They built it the way a good poker player builds a stack, steady, disciplined, and almost always holding more than the table expects. Sitting atop the Super Smash Bros division and projecting into the 84th percentile of the field, this team earned its standing the old-fashioned way. The foundation is Lamar Jackson, a QB3 projection landed at pick 2.12 after the board let him drift nearly a full round past his ADP. From there, the draft kept compounding: Rashee Rice came in at WR13 value a round late, and Puka Nacua at WR1 anchors a projected starting corps that also includes Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and Garrett Wilson at WR17. The depth chart reads like someone who attended every pre-draft session and left with receipts. StephenRoto posted just one steal on paper, but with twelve chalk picks, three values, and zero major reaches, this is a roster that never blinked, and that kind of consistency is exactly how you end up first in your division.
