There is no generous interpretation of what crystalscuor did in this draft, and the numbers do not offer one. The team posted zero steals and zero values against twelve chalk picks and seven reaches, three of them major, which is the kind of draft profile that exists as a cautionary tale. The most egregious of those reaches was Fernando Mendoza, taken at 6.04 when his ADP sat at 12.10, a six-and-a-half-round overpay for a QB27 who will not start. That pick alone would be the defining mistake on most rosters, but crystalscuor also grabbed Brock Purdy two full rounds before the market said to, leaving a quarterback room anchored by a QB13 and a QB27 in a format where starters can play anyone. The projected starter list confirms the damage: Stefon Diggs, the weakest projected starter on the board, is a WR56, and the 2025 record of 5-31 in the 4th percentile of scoring suggests this organization has not yet identified the problem. A 2nd-percentile division rank in 2026 suggests it still has not.

The situation in the Mario Kart 64 division is grim for joaomauricio, and the draft tape does not offer much comfort. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with CeeDee Lamb (WR5), Chris Olave (WR11), Garrett Wilson (WR17), and Luther Burden (WR22) all projected starters, but that surface shine obscures a structural problem: the quarterback room is a wasteland. Jacoby Brissett (QB28), Aaron Rodgers (QB29), and J.J. McCarthy (QB37) are the options, and in a positionless format where other managers are unlocking value at every slot, dragging a QB28 into your lineup week after week is like trying to win a road race with the parking brake on. The draft did not help matters either, as joaomauricio reached 2.2 rounds early to land Wilson, surplus value that could have addressed the most visible weakness on the roster. The 2025 campaign ended at the 26th percentile in scoring, and with the team currently sitting 11th in the division and in just the 10th percentile of the field, the arrow is not pointing anywhere encouraging.

The Mario Kart 64 division is not going to be kind to jjockstraps in 2026, and the draft tells you most of what you need to know about why. With four major reaches on the board, this roster was built on aggressive conviction that repeatedly outran the market, and the results are predictable: George Kittle at TE9 and Tyler Warren at TE4 are genuinely productive players, but grabbing Kittle nearly four rounds early and Mac Jones a staggering 4.8 rounds before his TE39-equivalent value suggested the field thought he was worth waiting on, that is capital that never came back. Jalen Hurts is a legitimate asset at QB9 and Brock Bowers anchors the tight end group at TE1, but the surrounding cast grades out thin, with Ladd McConkey at WR20 and Cam Skattebo at RB20 representing the ceiling beyond those headliners. A 23rd-percentile tournament ranking and a division-last projection confirm what the draft board already showed: this team is running out of levers, and the ones that were pulled got pulled too early.

FridgeRaiders finished in the 92nd percentile last season, and the 2026 roster carries that reputation like a credential nobody has bothered to audit yet. The projection tells a different story: 26th percentile, ninth in the Mario Kart 64 division. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Malik Nabers at WR12 anchoring a starting corps that also includes DeVonta Smith at WR14 and D.J. Moore at WR26, but the draft process that assembled it was more aggressive than precise. Nabers was taken nearly a full round early, and Christian Watson, projected WR28, was the most conspicuous overpay at nearly two rounds ahead of ADP. That kind of urgency at the top of the draft tends to compress value everywhere else, and sure enough the projected floor sits at Xavier Worthy at WR49. Travis Kelce arrives at TE10, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 was a genuine value, but the quarterback room is projected weakest of all, with Kyler Murray checking in at QB19. Last year's percentile was real. This year's roster is a separate argument entirely.

Slaash did almost everything right at the draft table, and the roster still lands at 36th percentile, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question the whole exercise. The discipline was real: Bucky Irving fell nearly three full rounds to pick 9.11, Bhayshul Tuten slid almost two rounds before Slaash grabbed him at 10.02, and thirteen picks landed at chalk. The problem is not the process, it is the ceiling. Justin Jefferson and Drake London give this team a genuine top-ten receiver pairing, and the Patrick Mahomes and Rashee Rice stack adds a tournament-relevant upside layer. But Mahomes cost a round and a half of draft capital as a QB12, a price that quietly compressed what the rest of the roster could become. The depth beneath the top names trails off fast, with Courtland Sutton projected as WR37 anchoring the weakest starting spot. Slaash played the draft like a disciplined value investor and got a portfolio that looks fine on paper but cannot quite clear the bar.

JMarschke went 31-5 last year and scored in the 100th percentile, which is the kind of season that turns a manager into a local legend. The 2026 roster, sitting at 39th percentile and seventh in the Mario Kart 64 division, is a quieter story. The top end is genuinely good: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Jonathan Taylor at RB4, and Tucker Kraft at TE5 give this team a spine worth building around, though Kraft's ACL recovery from last November means that TE5 projection comes with an asterisk on the asterisk, contingent on him reclaiming his pre-injury form in a Packers offense that lost more receivers than it added. The draft was mostly chalk, with Taylor representing the one real steal and Ray Davis arriving 3.4 rounds ahead of his ADP as the notable gamble. What makes this roster feel like a step back is not any single weakness but the absence of last year's everything, the sense that JMarschke is rebuilding a reputation that the standings will take some time to confirm.

DrGoutte did not walk away from this draft with one signature moment to brag about. What they walked away with was a roster that kept winning small battles all night long. The foundation is legitimately elite: Josh Allen at QB1 slid nearly a full round past his ADP and landed at 2.01, and Trey McBride at TE2 followed him out of the first round at 1.12, both arriving at prices that feel almost unfair in hindsight. From there, DrGoutte layered in a wide receiver corps with real depth, headlined by Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and Zay Flowers at WR16, with Alec Pierce, DK Metcalf, Michael Wilson, and Jordan Addison all projecting as starters behind them. The draft chart shows two steals, three values, and only nine chalk picks, which is the quiet signature of a manager who came prepared rather than reactive. Sitting sixth in the Mario Kart 64 division and in the 60th percentile of the field, there is room to climb, and this roster looks built to do exactly that.

NorthTampaForty didn't make headlines on draft day, and that's kind of the point. This roster was built the way a good poker player wins, not on one big bluff but on consistently getting value from the cards already on the table. The headliner is Caleb Williams, a QB6 projection that cost a fifth-round pick when the rest of the room let him fall more than two full rounds past his ADP. Pair him with Rome Odunze in the stack and that late-round concession becomes a legitimate weapon. The backfield is where the floor gets set: James Cook at RB5 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 are both projected starters, and Barkley himself was a value, sliding a full round past where he was expected to go. A 2025 season that landed in the 72nd percentile in scoring suggests this manager knows how to convert a draft into points, and the 2026 construction looks like more of the same, steady, positioned in the 69th percentile, and built to stay there or better.

BigDaddyVal did not manufacture a contender through one flashy swing. This roster was assembled the way a good poker player wins, not by bluffing big but by consistently getting value out of every hand dealt. The clearest evidence: Justin Herbert lands as QB8 after sliding nearly two full rounds past his ADP, and De'Von Achane, a projected RB6, was still on the board almost a round later than he had any right to be. Those are not lucky bounces, those are a manager paying attention while others were not. Layer on Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and A.J. Brown at WR8 anchoring the projected starters, and this lineup carries genuine week-to-week ceiling. The Malik Washington reach at 13.05 when ADP had him at 16.07 is the one moment where patience gave way to want, but a single reach in an otherwise disciplined draft is a footnote, not a story. Sitting at the 79th percentile in a field this competitive, BigDaddyVal has built something worth watching in the Mario Kart 64 division.

BrandonMarianne did not build this roster with a single flashy move. They built it by being right, repeatedly, across twenty rounds. The clearest examples: Lamar Jackson at QB3 slipped just past his ADP and landed in their lap, and Ashton Jeanty fell nearly a full round before they scooped him up at RB7. Those are not lottery tickets, they are the compounding returns of a manager who was paying attention while others were not. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 anchors the whole operation, and the supporting cast behind him, Travis Etienne at RB18 and RJ Harvey at RB28, keeps the lineup from ever having a soft week. The receiver group is the one place projections are unkind, with Jaylen Waddle at WR23 and Terry McLaurin at WR24 leading a unit that lacks a top-tier name, but in a positionless format that concern is easy to absorb. The 2025 numbers, 92nd percentile in scoring and a 64 percent win rate, suggest this is not a team figuring things out. It is a team that already has.

Last year, Toadally Cooked finished in the bottom 16 percent of the field in scoring, a miserable 12-24 slog that demanded a serious answer. Consider this the answer. Sitting second in the Mario Kart 64 division and in the 90th percentile of the entire field, this roster looks less like a retooling and more like a resurrection. The engine is a quarterback room that would make most managers weep with envy: Joe Burrow at QB4 and Jayden Daniels at QB5 project as two of the sharpest weapons in the tournament, and the front office acquired both past their ADPs. Burrow slipped half a round, Daniels arrived as a projected starter outright. Layer in Puka Nacua at WR1 and Derrick Henry at RB12, also snagged a full round after his average draft position, and the skeleton of this team is genuinely elite. The 2025 version of Toadally Cooked was a cautionary tale. The 2026 version arrives carrying real receipts, positioned to remind the Mario Kart 64 division exactly what this franchise is capable of.

Banana Peels & Touchdowns didn't need a lottery ticket to build this roster, just a steady hand and a willingness to let the board come to them. The clearest evidence is Omarion Hampton, pulled at 5.03 when his average draft position sat two full rounds earlier, and now projecting as RB9. That's not luck, that's patience paying a dividend. Breece Hall and Kyren Williams, both projected starters, came in at RB14 and RB15 respectively, each falling well past their ADP while the rest of the field apparently looked elsewhere. Add Dak Prescott at QB7, snagged more than a round after he was expected to go, and you have a draft that quietly won pick after pick without ever swinging for the fences. The Prescott and George Pickens stack gives the team a built-in bonus when Dallas clicks. Sitting first in the Mario Kart 64 division and in the 97th percentile of the field, Banana Peels & Touchdowns earned that position the boring way, which is usually the right way.
