HudsonCullen sits 12th in the Mario Kart 8 Deluxe division and in the 4th percentile of the field, and the roster tells you exactly why. The draft was dominated by chalk, and when the reaches outnumber the steals five to one, you are not building a winner, you are just paying full price for mediocrity. The receiver group has some life, with Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Garrett Wilson at WR17 anchoring the starts, but both were taken before their ADP, meaning HudsonCullen spent premium draft capital to acquire exactly what the market already told you they were worth. The quarterback situation is quietly brutal, with Sam Darnold projecting at QB21 and Aaron Rodgers and Geno Smith sitting behind him at QB29 and QB30. That is not a depth chart, that is a waiting room for bad news. Colston Loveland, Sam LaPorta, and Travis Kelce grade out well, but elite projected performers at one position cannot carry a lineup when the rest of the cupboard is this bare. There is no obvious lever left to pull here.

JTTCupCommish did almost everything right on draft day, which somehow makes this roster harder to look at. Fourteen chalk picks, three minor reaches, and one genuine steal in C.J. Stroud, scooped up in round twelve when his ADP said round nine, yet projected at QB22, he is the weakest projected starter on the board. The tightrope walk at the top was real: Trey McBride and Tyler Warren were both taken early, minor reaches that landed two of the top four tight ends in the field, and Zay Flowers, Ladd McConkey, and Terry McLaurin give the receiver group genuine depth at WR16, WR20, and WR24. On paper, the pieces exist. In practice, this team sits 11th in the division and in the 19th percentile of the tournament, which is the quiet cruelty of a draft where discipline met diminishing returns. JTTCupCommish read the board correctly, extracted fair value at nearly every turn, and still ended up with a roster the projections simply do not trust.

MicahFett23 sits 10th in the Mario Kart 8 Deluxe division and in the bottom fifth of the entire field, and the draft record explains why. Three major reaches, four minor reaches, and only two steals across the board paint a picture of a manager who paid tomorrow's prices for today's uncertainty. The reaches hurt most where they cluster: RJ Harvey at RB28, Blake Corum at RB35, and Trey Benson at RB64 were all taken well ahead of market, and none of them project as starters. Meanwhile, CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Drake Maye at QB2 give the roster a genuine top-end pulse, but a positionless format rewards depth that grades out, and below those two the drop-off is steep. The projected weakest starter, Kenneth Gainwell at RB34, is essentially the canary in the coal mine: when your floor is a RB34, you are hoping for a lot of things to break right. With no obvious trade chips to repackage and the standings projecting a long climb, MicahFett23 looks like a team that drafted its ceiling and priced in its own disappointment.

There is no pretty way to say this: TitanTravis is projected 9th in the Mario Kart 8 Deluxe division and sits at the 21st percentile of the entire field, and the draft did not generate the kind of surplus value that might paper over that gap. Two major reaches, on Tony Pollard at RB30 and Rhamondre Stevenson at RB31, burned roughly four combined rounds of draft capital on players projected outside the top 30 at their position, and Stevenson projects as the weakest starter on the roster. Josh Allen at QB1 is a genuine anchor, and the Jaxson Dart and Malik Nabers stack offers a lottery ticket on upside, but the rest of the supporting cast grades out as average at best. Coming off a 36th-percentile scoring season in 2025, TitanTravis needed an aggressive, value-heavy draft to change the trajectory, and instead got 13 chalk picks and zero steals. The lever everyone hopes exists simply does not appear to be here.

DynastyPJ finished in the 85th percentile last season, and that number is apparently doing a lot of heavy lifting in 2026, because the current projection puts this team at the 28th percentile and eighth in the Mario Kart 8 Deluxe division. The roster has talent, sure: Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3, Ashton Jeanty as RB7, and the tight end group around Harold Fannin and George Kittle is genuinely impressive. But last year's results were built on a version of this team that simply does not exist anymore, and reputation is not a lineup slot. The draft tendencies make things worse. Seven minor reaches and two major reaches against zero steals means DynastyPJ consistently paid above market, most painfully for Jonathon Brooks at RB37, taken nearly three rounds before his ADP, and Michael Mayer at TE39, reached four full rounds early. Those are the kinds of draft-day decisions that hollow out a roster's depth before the season even starts, and when Rashid Shaheed is your weakest projected starter at WR57, there is not much margin left to absorb the consequences.

RamsDad Rams finished last season at exactly 50 percent wins and 51st percentile in scoring, and the 2026 version looks built to replicate that outcome almost precisely. The weapons are genuinely good: Puka Nacua as the WR1, George Pickens at WR10, Tee Higgins at WR19, and Tucker Kraft projected as TE5, assuming the ACL he tore in November holds up through a full season. Kraft came off the preseason PUP list before August, and with Green Bay losing more receivers than it added, his target share should be waiting for him if he can recapture his pre-injury form. That is a meaningful if, and it is precisely the kind of coin flip that separates 48th percentile teams from 60th percentile teams. Fernando Mendoza at QB27 is not a strength, but in a positionless format, it is also not the liability it would be elsewhere. RamsDad does not have a glaring weakness to fix or a dominant edge to press. They have margins, and in Mario Kart 8 Deluxe, margins are everything.

danieldopp didn't build this roster with one knockout punch. They built it with ten of them. The running back group is the story here, and it's a good one: Jonathan Taylor (RB4), James Cook (RB5), and Kenneth Walker III (RB10) all project as starters, and that's before you get to Derrick Henry (RB12) and Josh Jacobs (RB16) waiting in reserve. The draft craft behind it holds up to scrutiny too. Patrick Mahomes (QB12) slipped more than four rounds past his ADP, and Jared Goff (QB16) fell nearly four rounds as well, meaning danieldopp picked up legitimate quarterback depth at prices that would make most managers envious. The result is a team sitting at 60th percentile in the field with genuine upside, landed sixth in the Mario Kart 8 Deluxe division. The 2025 record of 36 percent wins is the obvious concern, but this roster looks meaningfully upgraded, built not through luck or one splashy selection, but through consistent, compounding value from top to bottom.

COTK116 didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by being right over and over again. The centerpiece is a receiver group that would make most managers in the Mario Kart 8 Deluxe division genuinely uncomfortable: Drake London (WR7), A.J. Brown (WR8), and DeVonta Smith (WR14) are all projected starters, and Brown landing here after falling nearly a full round past his ADP is the kind of quiet win that compounds. Smith is the most intriguing piece of the three. With Brown traded to New England, Smith finally steps into a true alpha role in Philadelphia, and if he clears that bar, WR14 starts looking conservative. Brock Bowers (TE1) anchors the back end of the lineup the way only the top tight end in the field can. Baker Mayfield arriving 3.9 rounds after his ADP gives the roster a functional QB at essentially no cost. COTK116 sits at the 70th percentile heading into 2026, and nothing about this roster suggests that ceiling is where the conversation ends.

DadRunner7 didn't stumble into correlation, they engineered it. The spine of this roster is the Joe Burrow and Ja'Marr Chase stack, and everything radiates outward from that pairing. Burrow projects as QB4, Chase as WR2, and when those two are clicking in the same week, the ceiling on this lineup is genuinely alarming. The genius of the build is that the stack wasn't an accident of late value, it was the blueprint from pick three. Burrow slid nearly a round past his ADP and DadRunner7 grabbed him at 3.03, then Chase anchors the top of the board as a weekly WR2 floor with upside well beyond that. Nico Collins projects as WR9 and gives the roster a second receiver who can carry a slate on his own. The path to a deep run here is obvious: Burrow and Chase cook, Collins adds a second surge, and DadRunner7 is assembling scores that opponents simply cannot match. The risk is equally obvious, correlation bets together or it breaks together, and this roster is fully committed to that bargain.

JBBurnsRed did not walk into the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft swinging for the fences. They just kept hitting singles that kept finding gaps. Bijan Robinson at RB2 slid to pick 1.08 when consensus had him gone four picks earlier, and Dak Prescott at QB7 sat on the board until 5.08, more than two full rounds past where the field expected him to land. Those are not lottery tickets, those are quiet, compounding advantages, the kind that put a team at 75th percentile in the tournament without a single moment of heroism. The Jalen Hurts and Dallas Goedert stack gives the lineup a connected upside channel, and De'Von Achane at RB6 means the top of this roster is genuinely formidable. The receiver group is the thinnest layer, with DK Metcalf projected at WR36 leading the way, but in a positionless format the depth at the top more than compensates. Third in the Mario Kart 8 Deluxe division feels like a floor, not a ceiling.

smithr323 didn't reinvent the wheel in the Scott Fish Bowl draft, but that's exactly the point. Sitting second in the Mario Kart 8 Deluxe division and projecting into the 89th percentile of the field, this roster was built on discipline and patience rather than one spectacular swing. The centerpiece is Christian McCaffrey at RB3, a projected starter who anchors the entire enterprise, but the smarter story is what happened in the quarterback room. Jayden Daniels fell nearly a full round past his ADP, and smithr323 pounced at 3.11 to land a QB5. Then Justin Herbert, somehow still available at 5.11 despite an ADP of 3.09, came along two-plus rounds later as the cleanest steal on the board. That's two starting-caliber quarterbacks acquired for prices that would make most managers blush. The 2025 campaign was rough, a 21st-percentile finish that deserves to stay in the rearview, but this draft reads like a manager who learned from it. The moves were quiet, the gains were real, and the cumulative effect put smithr323 in legitimate contention.

Yoshis Island sits at the top of the Mario Kart 8 Deluxe division and in the 91st percentile of the entire field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: fourteen chalk picks, three values, one steal, and barely a reach in sight. This is a manager who knew their price points and held the line. The foundation is Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8, two projected starters taken with discipline, Barkley arriving just half a round early, a price so reasonable it barely qualifies as a reach. Then the draft gets genuinely clever: Lamar Jackson fell 1.2 rounds past his ADP, Trevor Lawrence fell 1.8, and those two quarterbacks now anchor a lineup that also carries a live Jackson-Mark Andrews stack. Rashee Rice at WR13 is the wild card, a player who has spent more time in injury reports and courtrooms than on a football field lately, but when Rice is healthy and available he is a difference maker, and this roster is built well enough to absorb the uncertainty while it waits to find out.
