DrDolittleDVM is sitting at the bottom of the Marvel Rivals division and in just the 7th percentile of the field, and the roster does not hide why. The receiver group is legitimately strong, with CeeDee Lamb (WR5), Tetairoa McMillan (WR15), Tee Higgins (WR19), and DK Metcalf (WR36) all projected to start, so the top of this roster genuinely glitters. The problem is everything else. Jonathan Taylor (RB4) is a real asset, but the quarterback situation is a quiet disaster waiting to go loud: Sam Darnold (QB21) heads a room where Bryce Young grades out at QB26 and Shedeur Sanders at QB32, and Darnold's own outlook is clouded by a Seattle passing game that already leaned heavily toward its receivers even when Kenneth Walker was drawing defensive attention as Super Bowl MVP. Without that backfield anchor, Darnold needs to become someone he has never consistently been. The draft offered no relief, producing zero steals and zero values across 20 picks. The shiniest wide receiver group in the world cannot carry a team when the floor keeps giving way beneath it.

PhillyDawkins20 finished 58th percentile in scoring last year and somehow came into 2026 and made things worse on paper, landing 11th in the Marvel Rivals division and in the bottom 15 percent of the entire field. The draft tells the story cleanly: zero steals, zero values, and three major reaches. Ashton Jeanty, projected RB7, got yanked off the board nearly a full round early at 2.01, which is the kind of move that announces itself. Then, as if the lesson hadn't landed, the manager turned around and grabbed Mike Washington Jr., a projected RB59, a full three-and-a-half rounds before his market price, and Tre Harris, a projected WR72, nearly three rounds early. That is not aggressive drafting, that is paying a premium for players the industry has largely declined to invest in. Travis Kelce checks in as a projected TE10, a long fall from relevance, and he was still reached for. The Caleb Williams and Rome Odunze stack is the one gesture toward coherence, but a single stack cannot carry a draft this determined to undermine itself.

Last year, kamv finished in the 87th percentile, a 28-8 juggernaut that looked like it belonged in a different tournament than everyone else. This year's version is sitting at the 21st percentile, tenth in the Marvel Rivals division, and the distance between those two versions of this team is genuinely hard to look at. The foundation is real: Brock Bowers at TE1, Nico Collins at WR9, and Rashee Rice at WR13 give kamv a legitimate core. But the roster around that core reveals the problem. Tyler Murray, a projected QB19, arrives in Minnesota still recovering from a Lisfranc injury that cost him all but five games last season, now fighting for a starting job against JJ McCarthy in a competition that sounds open until you remember it's Murray trying to prove he can stay on the field at all. Dak Prescott was a fine value at QB7, but neither he nor Murray is the kind of difference-maker who closes a 66-percentile gap. The reputation says contender. The projection says something much quieter.

Chief Beef sits ninth in the Marvel Rivals division and in just the 24th tournament percentile, and the roster does not offer many places to hide from those numbers. The foundation is real: Harold Fannin at TE6 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 give this team a genuine advantage at the position, and Puka Nacua projecting as WR1 is the kind of asset that can carry a week. The problem is that everything around those pillars gets thin in a hurry. Matthew Stafford checks in at QB14, which is a passable number made slightly more tolerable by his stack with Nacua, but Geno Smith at QB30 is a grim contingency plan. The draft did not help close the gap, producing zero steals across the entire board and two major reaches, including Fannin himself, taken 2.5 rounds before his ADP. Paying a premium for your best player means the rest of the roster was built with what was left over, and Josh Downs projecting as the weakest starter at WR46 is the receipt for that decision. There is talent here, but not enough slack to survive the variance a bottom-quartile squad always faces.

The_GreenLab checks in at 8th in the Marvel Rivals division and sits right at the 48th percentile of the field, which is another way of saying there is no margin for error and no obvious path to climbing out of it. The running back group is legitimately strong, with Christian McCaffrey (RB3), Saquon Barkley (RB8), and Breece Hall (RB14) all projecting as starters, but Barkley is the cautionary tale buried inside that optimism. Coming off a 2025 season where the Eagles offensive line fell apart and his workload started to draw concern from the organization, Barkley at 29 looks more like a hold-and-hope than a cornerstone. Meanwhile, the receiver group is thin at the top, with Malik Nabers (WR12) carrying almost all of the projection weight after the draft reached 1.7 rounds early to get him. Twelve chalk picks and two major reaches later, The_GreenLab is a team that largely paid market rate for upside it may never see. That is not a recipe for anything except a long October.

CommishBcJenks sits at the 50th percentile and seventh in the Marvel Rivals division, which is exactly as lukewarm as it sounds, but the margins here are worth examining because they cut both ways. The receiver group is genuinely strong: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, DeVonta Smith at WR14, Terry McLaurin at WR24, Carnell Tate at WR29, and Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31 give this roster a deep, credible spine that could outperform a middling ranking on any given week. The problem is that the draft decisions surrounding the rest of the roster introduced some unnecessary drag. Reaching 2.2 rounds early for J.K. Dobbins, who projects as RB36, and burning a late pick on Elijah Arroyo at TE40 are exactly the kind of small inefficiencies that separate 50th-percentile teams from the ones that sneak into contention. Quinshon Judkins landing at RB22 two rounds after his ADP partially offsets that, but partial offsets are the currency of middle-of-the-pack rosters. CommishBcJenks has the ceiling to surprise someone. Whether it has the depth to sustain it is a different conversation.

Joses001 sits at 51st percentile heading into 2026, which is the fantasy equivalent of being exactly as good as you fear you might be. The roster is built on a genuinely impressive receiver corps, with Drake London (WR7), Garrett Wilson (WR17), Jameson Williams (WR21), and Luther Burden (WR22) all projecting as starters, and Davante Adams (WR25) and Alec Pierce (WR32) providing real depth behind them. That group is legitimate. The problem is that the players feeding them the ball are not. Baker Mayfield (QB18) is the headliner at quarterback, and he is a shaky one, with Daniel Jones (QB25) and Fernando Mendoza (QB27) as the fallback options. Joses001 drafted chalk almost across the board, which means there is not much hidden upside baked into this roster. At 53 percent wins and 68th percentile scoring last season, this manager knows how to keep it close. Whether close becomes

winning depends almost entirely on whether that receiver talent gets consistent enough quarterback play to actually show up in the standings.

Sitting at the 69th percentile and fifth in the Marvel Rivals division, kipahisbush built this roster the quiet way, not by swinging for a single marquee moment but by steadily coming out ahead on value. The clearest illustration: Jalen Hurts and Patrick Mahomes both fell past their ADPs, landing a full round or more later than the market expected, and now both are projected starters. That is not luck duplicated once, that is a manager who read the room twice and pocketed the difference. The running back group anchors everything, with Bijan Robinson projecting as RB2 and De'Von Achane right behind him at RB6, giving this roster a ceiling that most teams in the field simply cannot match at the top. Kenneth Walker III was a minor reach at RB10, but it is hard to argue with the instinct when the alternative was letting him go. Quentin Johnston is the weakest projected starter in the mix, and the receiver group broadly is the thinnest part of the lineup, but in a positionless format those top backs carry enormous weight. This team does not have a dramatic story. It has a good draft.

jpreziuso didn't win the draft with one flashy pick, just round after round of quiet, consistent execution. The value picks tell the story: Jeremiyah Love landed more than a round after his ADP and projects as RB13, David Montgomery fell a round and a half before jpreziuso grabbed him at RB23, and George Kittle slipped past his ADP by more than a round to give the roster a TE9 with starter upside. Five values across the board, zero major reaches, and the one minor reach, Germie Bernard at WR79, is a late-round flier that cost almost nothing. The projected starting group is the payoff, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Joe Burrow at QB4, and Chris Olave at WR11 forming a core that most managers would not say no to. That combination of draft discipline and projection quality lands jpreziuso at 72nd percentile in the field and fourth in the Marvel Rivals division, a team that earned its standing the boring way, which is usually the right way.

BManson didn't build this roster with one audacious swing. He built it pick by pick, and the ledger quietly adds up in his favor. The centerpiece is Lamar Jackson, a QB3 who slid to 2.11 while the rest of the room looked elsewhere, and BManson was ready. That's not luck, that's preparation meeting opportunity. The Jackson-Mark Andrews stack gives the team a connective tissue that tends to outperform its parts on any given week. Elsewhere, Michael Wilson landed at WR39 nearly two rounds after his ADP suggested he'd be gone, and Jaxson Dart came at QB11 value in the seventh after being priced closer to the fifth. The reaches on Ray Davis and Jaydon Blue at running back are real costs worth acknowledging, but they don't unwind what was largely a disciplined operation. Sitting third in the division and in the 77th percentile of the field, BManson has a team that didn't need a heist to be dangerous. It just needed a sharper eye than most.

AVFCJPS didn't build this roster by swinging for the fences and hoping. They built it by repeatedly coming out ahead on value, and the results speak for themselves: a division rank of second and an 85th percentile standing across the whole field. Six values in the draft tell that story cleanly. Trevor Lawrence came off the board at 6.05 with an ADP of 4.11, Dallas Goedert followed a round later than his market price suggested, and D'Andre Swift slid a round and a half past his number before AVFCJPS quietly took him at 9.08. None of those felt like lottery tickets. They felt like a manager who did the homework and let the board come to them. Stack those values behind a core that includes Josh Allen at QB1 and James Cook at RB5, and the margin built pick by pick starts to look significant. The one blemish is Keenan Allen, reached five rounds early, but one misstep in a draft this disciplined is almost beside the point. This team earned its spot in the conversation.

drinkingbleach didn't win the draft on one flashy pick. They won it on volume and consistency, round after round. The centerpiece is Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, a legitimate top-of-the-market anchor, and A.J. Brown at WR8 sitting right behind him as a projected starter. That's not luck, that's a manager who knew where the value was concentrated and stayed patient. Justin Herbert at QB8 arriving in the fifth round after his ADP projected him nearly two rounds earlier is the kind of quiet win that separates good drafters from great ones. The Bo Nix and Jaylen Waddle stack adds a connected upside lever without compromising the roster's floor. Fifteen chalk picks in a 19-round draft sounds boring until you realize chalk is correct by definition, and drinkingbleach paired that discipline with a Herbert that fell into their lap. The result is an 86th-percentile roster sitting first in the Marvel Rivals division, built not on a single dramatic swing but on a draft that kept coming out ahead.
