There is no player data to work with here. The roster lists every positional slot as a range of zero players, the draft column shows zeroes across every category, and the team sits at the 0th percentile of the field. What can be said is this: a team built on nothing projects to earn nothing, and the Max Payne Division leader tag attached to this roster is either a data placeholder or the cruelest joke in the tournament. The narrative hook about living in the middle, where survival depends on thin edges and quiet advantages, has nowhere to land when the roster itself is a blank page. If real players eventually populate this lineup, the story might be worth telling. Right now, Team 1 is less a contender threading a needle than a needle with no thread, waiting to be handed something to work with before the season even begins.

The numbers on this roster do not announce themselves. There are no players listed, no ranks to point to, no draft grades to defend or apologize for, because the data simply does not exist yet, and that absence is its own kind of statement. Team 2 sits second in the Max Payne division, which sounds like progress until you notice the tournament percentile reads zero, a figure that suggests the field has not yet decided what to make of this team, possibly because there is nothing here to react to. No steals, no reaches, no chalk, just a roster that materialized without leaving fingerprints. That is the lived reality of the middle, not threatening enough to draw a game plan, not vulnerable enough to invite overconfidence from opponents. Every margin this season will be decided by execution rather than pedigree, by the weekly decisions a manager makes in a positionless format where ten starting spots reward whoever is simply paying attention. This team will not beat anyone by accident, and it will not lose to anyone by accident either. The margins decide it. They always do.

There is not much to work with here, and the numbers do not lie. Team 3 sits third in the Max Payne division and ranks at the absolute floor of the entire tournament field, a percentile of zero that is less a warning sign than a verdict. What makes the situation genuinely grim is that there is no draft sleight of hand to point to as a hidden lifeline: zero steals, zero values, not even a coin-flip chalk pick to defend. The draft was not a quiet gamble that might pay off late; it was simply quiet. In a positionless format where the only thing separating contenders from pretenders is the raw quality of the players you own, Team 3 enters 2026 with a roster that grades out near the bottom of the field and no obvious mechanism to climb out. Some teams look bad on paper and surprise you. This one looks bad on paper and, right now, there is no reason to expect the spreadsheet is wrong.

The draft produced zero steals, zero values, and not even a single chalk pick to suggest the roster was assembled with a plan. Every selection came in at exactly average or worse, which means there was no moment where the team got ahead of the market, no hidden upside waiting to emerge, no late-round gamble that might quietly pay off in October. In a positionless format where managers can deploy their best players in almost any combination, the quality of the top of the roster is everything, and right now that top looks thin. This team is not unlucky or misunderstood. It is simply behind, with no obvious lever left to pull.

Team 5 enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting last in the Max Payne division and at the literal floor of the tournament field, zero percentile, which is not a typo. The draft offered no lifeline either: zero steals, zero values, not even a flattering piece of chalk to frame as a quiet win. Every category on the draft ledger reads goose egg, which means this roster was not unlucky or misunderstood, it was simply built without an edge at any stage of the process. In a positionless format where a manager can field whoever grades highest on a given week, the only path to survival is having players who actually grade high, and nothing in this data suggests Team 5 has that. This is a roster that arrived at the marathon start line already out of water, and the Max Payne division is not going to slow down to wait.

In a positionless format where the only job is to accumulate the best players available, this team arrives with nothing to separate it from the bottom of the standings. There is no late-round dart to root for, no sleeper narrative to sell, no lever left to pull. Sometimes a team is simply behind before the first week kicks off, and Team 6, at this early stage, looks like exactly that kind of team.

There is no soft way to say this: Team 7 enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl as one of the weakest rosters in the entire field, sitting dead last in the Max Payne division and at the zero percentile tournament-wide. What makes the situation particularly grim is that there is no draft inefficiency to point to as a hidden foundation, no steals, no values, not even a single pick that graded out as chalk. Every selection was essentially a wash at best, which means the roster reflects exactly what the market thought it was worth and the market was not impressed. In a positionless format where a manager just needs to find ten strong players from anywhere on the roster, the absence of even one breakout-caliber contributor compounds quickly. This team does not have a bad plan buried under a promising core. It just has a bad plan. Barring a dramatic waiver wire intervention that the rest of the field will be hunting just as hard, Team 7 looks like a passenger in 2026, not a driver.

There is no graceful way to frame what the numbers are saying about Team 8 in the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl. Sitting dead last in the Max Payne division and at the zero percentile of the entire field, this roster does not project to compete, and the draft offers no comfort. With zero steals, zero values, and zero chalk picks on record, there is no single move to point to and say that is where the season turns. Every team has a lever, a sleeper stashed in a late round or a bargain grabbed before the market caught up. Team 8 does not appear to have one. It is not a matter of bad luck at one position or a thin spot that a waiver wire pickup might patch. The whole thing grades out near the floor, built without any discernible edge in acquisition cost. There is no graceful way to spin what the numbers are saying about Team 9 in the Max Payne division. This roster grades out at the 0th percentile in the tournament field, which is not a typo and is not a rounding quirk, it is the floor. The draft did nothing to change that trajectory: zero steals, zero values, and zero reaches, meaning the manager neither found an edge nor swung for a long shot. That is not neutral, that is a draft that left everything exactly as bad as it found it. Sitting ninth in the division before a game has been played, Team 9 looks less like a work in progress and more like a finished product nobody wanted to buy. The format is positionless, which means the best players rise to the surface regardless of where they line up, and when the best players are projecting at the bottom of the field, the format is not a lifeline. It is just a faster way to find out how thin the margin actually is.

The draft log makes the situation starker still, recording zero steals, zero values, and not a single piece of chalk to fall back on, which means there was no moment in the draft where the manager caught a break or simply nailed a consensus pick at the right price. No cushion was built, no late-round lottery ticket cashed in early. For most struggling teams there is at least one lever to point to, one player to hype, one round where things broke right. Here, the spreadsheet just stares back, blank and unforgiving. Projections have this team at the tournament's floor, and without a single draft surplus to suggest the projections might be underestimating anyone on the roster, the math is genuinely hard to argue with. The season ahead looks long.

The roster grades out at the very bottom of the tournament field, sitting at the 0th percentile, which is not a rounding error or a quirk of the math. It is a frank assessment. What makes the situation feel genuinely bleak rather than merely bad is that there is no draft ingenuity to point to as a reason for optimism. The draft log shows zero steals, zero values, and zero reaches, which means the manager neither overpaid for upside nor quietly nabbed anyone at a discount. The board was picked clean before this team could find any leverage. Dead last in the division, with no hidden upside baked into the draft and no projected standout to build a winning week around, Team 11 heads into 2026 looking less like a rebuilding project and more like a team that has already run out of moves before the season begins.

The Scott Fish Bowl is a long season, and hope is a reasonable thing to carry into it, but Team 12 would need to manufacture theirs entirely from scratch.
