LliwDrabbuh sits 12th in the Mega Man II division and in the 8th percentile of the entire field, and the draft did almost nothing to change the trajectory. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is a genuine building block, and Malik Nabers at WR12 gives this roster a receiver group that is legitimately strong, but the rest of the roster reads like a cautionary tale about drafting quarterbacks too aggressively. Jared Goff, taken a full 1.7 rounds before his ADP and projecting as a QB16, was already a questionable investment. Then the manager came back and took C.J. Stroud 2.2 rounds early in round seven, landing a QB22 who has spent two seasons trying and failing to recapture his 2024 form, with a concussion and a shaky offensive line doing nothing to help the case. Combined, those two early investments pulled capital away from positions where it could have mattered. Chase and Nabers give LliwDrabbuh a puncher's chance on any given week, but the math is unforgiving when your quarterback situation is this thin this early.

There is a version of this roster that looks fine on paper, and then you notice the receiver group. Calvin Ridley at WR78, Troy Franklin at WR80, Elic Ayomanor at WR95, and Ricky Pearsall without a ranking at all. That is not a depth chart, that is a support group. The backfield has genuine quality, Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Chase Brown at RB11 among the projected starters, and Drake Maye projects as a QB2, so the ceiling exists in theory. But the draft did not help manufacture a path forward. Raiderest logged three major reaches, including Jaydon Blue taken a stunning 6.2 rounds ahead of his ADP, and came away with zero steals. You can survive a reach or two when you are picking up value elsewhere, but zero steals on a roster sitting 11th in the division means there was no draft capital quietly working in the background. The lever everyone looks for when a team is struggling, a hidden asset, a discount pick, simply is not here.

There is a version of this roster that looks interesting on paper, and then you remember Brandon Aiyuk is projected WR81 and the bottom falls out. WRs Are Overrated sits 10th in the Mega Man II division and in just the 16th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet offers little comfort: no steals, no values, 15 chalk picks, and a major reach on Jake Ferguson taken more than two full rounds before his ADP. The tight end group anchored by Harold Fannin, George Kittle, and Travis Kelce is legitimately strong, and Joe Burrow at QB4 gives the team a real foundation. But this format rewards depth of quality across the whole lineup, and when your projected weakest starter is Hunter Henry at TE18, that means the top of the roster is carrying an enormous amount of weight with almost nowhere to hide. The draft generated no surplus value to paper over the gaps. For WRs Are Overrated, the math is just the math, and the math is not kind.

dadof3MB sits ninth in Mega Man II and at just the 33rd percentile of the field, and the roster explains why. The backfield looks like the engine room of a contender, with Ashton Jeanty (RB7), Saquon Barkley (RB8), and Kyren Williams (RB15) all projecting as starters, and Josh Allen (QB1) anchoring the whole operation. The problem is that this team's receiving corps is where the ceiling caves in. The projected starters at receiver are Tee Higgins (WR19), Quentin Johnston (WR41), and Josh Downs (WR46), and Johnston is the weakest projected starter on the entire roster, a telling detail about how thin the top-end talent gets once you scroll past Higgins. The draft offered no escape hatch: zero steals across the whole board, three minor reaches including Kyren Williams and Blake Corum, and nothing that reframes the outlook. dadof3MB drafted almost entirely to chalk, which is fine when your pool is strong, but when your receiver pool grades out this soft, chalk just locks in the problem.

maddrd played the draft about as cleanly as you can on paper. Jordan Addison fell nearly two rounds and landed at WR43, Wan'Dale Robinson slipped almost two rounds to WR47, and the roster still clocks in at just 42nd percentile in the field and eighth in the Mega Man II division, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question what drafting well even means. The problem is not the process, it is the ceiling. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and De'Von Achane at RB6 are legitimate stars, but the projected starters beyond them thin out quickly, and the receiver group peaks at Zay Flowers as WR16 before sliding toward a weakest projected starter in Addison at WR43. You squeezed value out of every discount bin available and still ended up with a roster that projects like a team that paid full price for average. Getting good picks at bad prices only matters if the players themselves push the needle, and right now this lineup is asking a lot of some players who have not yet earned that trust.

ninthstringrb sits at the 49th percentile and seventh in the Mega Man II division, which is exactly where the roster looks: capable enough to beat anyone on the right week, beatable enough that no one is losing sleep over the matchup. The case for optimism runs through Drake London (WR7) and Brock Bowers (TE1), two projected starters who give this team a genuine ceiling, and the fact that London was drafted at 2.12 when his ADP sat at 2.06 is the kind of small edge that compounds over a long season. The case for concern runs through the same draft board in reverse: Daniel Jones cost a 9.01 pick for a QB25 projection, a reach of 2.3 rounds that represents real draft capital surrendered for a player who may never see a meaningful snap. In a format where margins decide everything, burning that kind of equity on a quarterback is the variable that separates contention from a middle-of-the-pack finish ninthstringrb is currently projected to earn.

Spy007 sits at 55th percentile and sixth in the Mega Man II division, and those numbers probably undersell a roster built through relentless, unglamorous efficiency. The draft logged 16 chalk picks and only two values, yet the values landed cleanly: Jordan Mason at RB41 slid nearly two rounds past his ADP, and Michael Pittman arrived at WR44 more than a round late. Neither pick is a lottery ticket, but both represent the kind of quiet margin that accumulates into a real edge. The foundation is legitimate, starting with Bijan Robinson at RB2 and A.J. Brown at WR8, a pair of starters who anchor a starting lineup without apology. Layered in behind them, Isaiah Likely projects as TE13 after following John Harbaugh to the New York Giants, where a light tight end room gives him every chance to produce, and he is already stacked with Jaxson Dart for a bonus that sharpens the roster's upside. The one eyebrow-raiser is a four-round reach on J.J. McCarthy at QB37, but in a positionless format, a late-round flier at a position with depth elsewhere is a gamble Spy007 can afford.

WillBrinson drafted like someone who came to the board with a list and was not moving off it, consequences be damned. The reach count is hard to ignore, with four minor and two major reaches across the draft, including Brian Robinson pulled 2.5 rounds early and Mason Taylor taken 2.7 rounds ahead of schedule. Those are aggressive calls that would look embarrassing if the roster were a mess. It is not a mess. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 anchors the group, Lamar Jackson landed at QB3 as a genuine value, falling past his ADP, and the Mahomes-Rashee Rice stack gives this team a weekly ceiling that most managers would envy. Nico Collins at WR9 and Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 round out a starting group that punches above what the draft board suggests. After an ugly 2025, WillBrinson projects at the 66th percentile, which is not a championship contender but it is a real turnaround. The reaches did not sink them. Make of that what you will.

FRANKCASTLE004 didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't load up on one marquee name and hope for the best. This team just kept coming out ahead, pick after pick, round after round. The foundation is a receiver corps that legitimately belongs in elite company: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, DeVonta Smith at WR14, and Ladd McConkey at WR20 all project as starters, and McConkey came a full round later than his ADP suggested he should. Luther Burden fell a round past his number too, landing at WR22 and giving this roster four projected starters who could anchor lesser teams all by themselves. The Jalen Hurts and Smith stack adds a ceiling that pure depth charts can't capture. Colston Loveland at TE3 is a minor reach on paper but the kind of minor reach that wins leagues when he hits. The result of all this steady, unflashy drafting is a team sitting at the 75th percentile of the field, fourth in Mega Man II, and built to climb both.

GOAT District didn't stumble into correlation, they architected it. The Matthew Stafford stacks are the clearest expression of the philosophy: Puka Nacua projects as WR1 and Davante Adams as WR25, and both are paired with their own QB, meaning a big Stafford day lifts two projected starters simultaneously. Layer the Jayden Daniels and Terry McLaurin pairing on top, and this roster has three distinct stacks that can each catch fire independently or compound into something genuinely hard to beat. That's not an accident, that's a draft plan. The ceiling here is legitimately high, which helps explain a tournament percentile of 83rd despite ranking third in the division. The one thread worth watching is Dalton Kincaid, a projected starter at TE5 whose knee has been an ongoing concern, with Buffalo's front office stopping short of any clean bill of health heading into the season. If Kincaid is limited, the stack architecture still holds, but depth and correlation are doing a lot of heavy lifting, and in a tournament built on variance, GOAT District is betting that all three of those fuses get lit at once.

AllWright21 sits second in Mega Man II and at the 89th percentile of the entire field, and the draft log explains exactly why. This roster was built with a steady hand, six values and fourteen chalk picks and not a single reach anywhere on the board. Justin Jefferson at WR6 anchors the skill talent, and the Kyler Murray stack gives the whole lineup a ceiling most managers in this field are still hunting for. Then there is the value discipline underneath: Khalil Shakir fell 2.2 rounds past his ADP, Isaac TeSlaa fell 2.1, and Jalen Nailor fell 1.8, meaning AllWright21 collected late-round depth at early-round prices. Trey McBride at TE2 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 give the team a positional advantage that compounds over a full season. The one subplot worth watching is Carnell Tate, who projects at WR29 and heads to Tennessee to build chemistry with Cam Ward, the same pairing the Titans are counting on to justify consecutive top-four picks. If that connection clicks, this team gets scarier. If it does not, there is still plenty here to win.

JerseyFootball didn't win the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft with one thunderbolt pick. They won it the way a good poker player wins a long session: consistently getting value, round after round. Consider the evidence. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 are the kind of top-end anchors that separate genuine contenders from pretenders, and Lamb was somehow available at 2.04 despite an ADP nearly two full rounds earlier. Garrett Wilson, projected WR17, fell almost two rounds into JerseyFootball's lap as well. Five values against a single major reach, Chris Bell at WR87, is the kind of draft ledger that earns a team its division rank, which here is first in Mega Man II and 94th percentile in the field. Caleb Williams at QB6 steadies the foundation. The 2025 campaign was a quiet disaster at 36 percent wins and 25th percentile scoring, but this roster looks nothing like that one. JerseyFootball came prepared, drafted with discipline, and now sits exactly where that approach deserves: at the top.
