JoeyP17 sits 12th in the Metal Gear Solid division and in the 16th percentile of the field, and nothing in this roster suggests a dramatic reversal is coming. The quarterback group is legitimately strong, with Drake Maye and Lamar Jackson both projected starters, and a Jackson-Zay Flowers stack adds a real ceiling play. But from there, the picture gets grimmer fast. The best available running back is Derrick Henry at RB12, a fine player who is nonetheless one bad month away from reminding everyone why age matters, and the depth behind him grades out as thoroughly ordinary. The draft board tells a similar story of missed opportunities: two major reaches, including Emanuel Wilson pulled nearly eight rounds ahead of his ADP, against just one legitimate steal in Travis Hunter. Jordan Addison projects as the weakest starter on the roster. Maye and Jackson give JoeyP17 a puncher's chance on any given week, but a 36-percent win rate last season was not a fluke, and nothing here suggests the math changes much in 2026.

Roy Campbell's Crushers sit 11th in the Metal Gear Solid division and at just the 26th percentile of the field, and the roster construction explains why. The team's saving grace is a genuinely strong group headlined by James Cook (RB5) and Trey McBride (TE2), but the quarterback situation is where hope goes to die: Matthew Stafford grades out at QB14 and Tyler Shough at QB20, meaning the Crushers are essentially dragging a flat tire around the track no matter how well the rest of the roster performs. That ceiling problem is compounded by a draft that produced zero steals and zero values against ADP, with the most notable deviation being a major reach on Kyren Williams, pulled at 4.06 despite an ADP of 5.10. Williams projects as RB15, which is fine, but paying a round-plus premium for fine is not a winning strategy in a deep field. A 42% win rate and 33rd-percentile scoring in 2025 was a warning. The 2026 roster suggests management did not heed it.

HugeHunter sits tenth in the Metal Gear Solid division and in the 30th percentile of the field, and the roster largely explains why. The foundation is real: Jayden Daniels at QB5, Colston Loveland at TE3, and Malik Nabers at WR12 give this team genuine upside at the top of the lineup. The problem is what happens below that tier. The running back group projects poorly, and the receiver depth thins out fast after Nabers and Jameson Williams, with Michael Wilson grading out as the projected weakest starter at WR39. Worse, HugeHunter burned valuable draft capital chasing the ceiling, reaching nearly a full round early on both Daniels and Loveland, players who were never going to last to their natural spots. That kind of aggressive early spending tends to collapse the middle of a draft, and the back half of this roster bears the bruises. When your path to relevance depends entirely on a handful of top-end players delivering flawlessly, you are not building a team so much as buying a lottery ticket and hoping the odds forget about you.

The Dark Side enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Metal Gear Solid division and in just the 35th percentile of the field, and there is not much in the construction of this roster to suggest a turnaround is coming. The draft tells the story plainly: twelve chalk picks, four minor reaches, and one major reach, with Trevor Lawrence gobbled up 1.8 rounds ahead of his ADP at a QB10 projection that does not justify that cost. The team did coax some value out of the mid-rounds, landing Rashee Rice at WR13, Jaylen Waddle at WR23, and Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 all later than their average draft positions, and the Mahomes-Rice stack gives the lineup a genuine weekly ceiling. But Brock Bowers at TE1 is the kind of anchor that makes a roster feel stronger than it is on paper, and when you peel back that top layer, the drop-off is steep, with Kenyon Sadiq projected as the weakest starter at TE21. This team has talent at the top and questions everywhere the top runs out.

Psycho Mantis enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Metal Gear Solid division and in the bottom third of the field at the 37th percentile, and nothing about the roster construction suggests that number is about to move in the right direction. The headliners are real, Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 give this team a ceiling worth respecting, but the draft that built around them leaned heavily on quarterback love that the projections simply do not validate. Bo Nix cost a fourth-round pick and grades out as a QB15, Baker Mayfield cost nearly six rounds and lands at QB18, and those two early commitments compressed the rest of the board in ways that show up everywhere below the top line. The 2025 campaign finished in the 16th percentile in scoring, and the 2026 projections with RJ Harvey, a projected RB28, anchoring the back end of the starting lineup suggest the underlying weakness has not been addressed. McCaffrey and Lamb are compelling, but a team that already burned its draft capital chasing a position this tournament barely rewards has very few levers left to pull.

TheZacBradley finished 7-29 last season and landed in the 16th percentile in scoring, and the 2026 projection offers little reason for optimism, coming in at just the 41st percentile of the field and sitting seventh in the Metal Gear Solid division. The backfield is genuinely strong, Jahmyr Gibbs (RB1), Ashton Jeanty (RB7), and Saquon Barkley (RB8) form a top-shelf core that most managers would kill for, and that group alone keeps this team from being a total write-off. But the quarterback situation is where the floor caves in. Cam Ward was pulled three rounds early at QB23 and projects as the weakest starter on the entire roster, which is a difficult sentence to type when you also own Gibbs. Fernando Mendoza and Shedeur Sanders were both reached for as well, which means TheZacBradley spent significant draft capital chasing a position that still grades out weak. When your best lever was already pulled and the room still looks like this, it is hard to manufacture a reason for hope.

heavylancer enters 2026 sitting at 48th percentile, which is exactly as unremarkable as it sounds, and the margins of a long season will determine whether that number moves meaningfully in either direction. The foundation is genuinely good: De'Von Achane at RB6 and Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 give this roster two players capable of winning weeks on their own, and a starting four at tight end that includes Sam LaPorta, Travis Kelce, Dallas Goedert, and Juwan Johnson suggests the manager knows where to concentrate resources. The concern is in the draft inefficiencies bleeding around the edges. Aaron Rodgers, projected QB29, was taken 2.3 rounds ahead of his ADP, and Braelon Allen, projected RB58, cost 3.4 rounds of draft capital beyond what the market demanded. Those are real opportunity costs. Dak Prescott and Achane keep the floor respectable, but heavylancer doesn't have the margin for error that a top-quartile roster might. Last year's 56 percent win rate says the same thing this roster does: good enough to compete, not quite built to pull away.

After finishing in the bottom 12 percent of the field in scoring last season, Revovler Ocelot enters 2026 looking like a team that actually did its homework. The engine here is receiver depth that projects to genuinely elite territory: Puka Nacua at WR1 and Nico Collins at WR9 give this roster a top-end that simply did not exist a year ago, and Tee Higgins at WR19 and Christian Watson at WR28 extend that quality well into the projected lineup. Caleb Williams projecting as a QB6 keeps the ceiling honest, and his stablemate Jordan Love pairs with Watson for a stack that adds a little connective tissue to the whole thing. The draft was mostly chalk, but Alec Pierce fell nearly a full round and a half past his ADP, which quietly adds a WR32 projection at a discount. The concern is real, particularly around Daniel Jones as a major reach at QB25. But the bones of this roster are structurally sounder than anything Ocelot ran out last year, and 63rd percentile projections feel like a reasonable floor, not a ceiling.

kjdevore28 didn't need a heist to build this roster, just steady, patient execution that kept paying off. The foundation is hard to argue with: Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 are genuine difference-makers, and the Goff-St. Brown stack adds a layer of upside every week that compounds the value of both. Jared Goff gets dismissed as a ceiling-capped game manager, but four straight top-10 finishes don't lie, and with Detroit's weapons intact around him, he's the kind of QB who quietly wins you weeks while the rest of the room chases upside. The draft story, though, is the consistent way kjdevore28 let value come to them: Garrett Wilson at WR17, Luther Burden at WR22, and Josh Downs at WR46 all fell past their ADP, adding quality at every stage of the draft rather than forcing it at one. Fifth values across the board in a tournament field this competitive is a quiet edge that adds up. Sitting 64th percentile with this much talent at the top, kjdevore28 has every reason to expect more before the season is done.

Pestell didn't win the draft with one flashy swing. They won it pick by pick, consistently finding players at prices that made sense and occasionally finding ones that made no sense at all in the best way. Drake London at WR7 slipping to the second round, Chris Olave at WR11 falling a full round past his ADP, Jordyn Tyson at WR34 doing the same thing in round nine, and then Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47 tumbling more than two rounds to land in round twelve, a late-round gift that most managers would have been thrilled to find three hours earlier. The QB situation carries real uncertainty, particularly with Brock Purdy navigating a weapon corps that looks thin even before the injury reports start piling up, but Josh Allen at QB1 anchors that group in a way that makes the Purdy questions feel manageable rather than alarming. Tyler Warren at TE4 adds genuine upside at a position that often

separates fields. Third in the division and 64th percentile overall is a foundation, not a ceiling, for a team built this carefully.

There was no single headline move in mtfisher0's draft, no moment where the room went quiet and everyone rechecked the board. What there was, instead, was a steady accumulation of correct decisions. Justin Jefferson landing at 2.09 when his ADP sat at 1.12 is the kind of gift that only arrives when a manager stays patient and lets the board come to them, and pairing Jefferson (WR6) with A.J. Brown (WR8), DeVonta Smith (WR14), and Emeka Egbuka (WR18) built a top tier that almost never breaks down. Bijan Robinson (RB2) gives the roster a genuine difference-maker at another position entirely. The quarterback group is the one area where the projections are unkind, with C.J. Stroud checking in at QB22 as the top option, but in a positionless format the ceiling on this roster is set by its best players, not its thinnest position, and the best players here are excellent. After a 25th-percentile finish in 2025, mtfisher0 has quietly assembled something that looks like a legitimate contender in the Metal Gear Solid division.

BigCanadian isn't hoping for stacks to develop organically — they were engineered from the jump, and that intentionality is exactly why this team sits in the 92nd percentile heading into 2026. The spine of the roster is two complete passing game pairings: Joe Burrow with Ja'Marr Chase, and Justin Herbert with Ladd McConkey. Chase is a projected WR2 taken at a slight discount, and when Burrow is healthy and locked in with him, the ceiling on that pairing is genuinely hard to cap. That word "healthy" is doing real work in that sentence, of course — Burrow's injury history is not a footnote but a recurring headline, and a single bad step can unravel the whole blueprint. That's where Herbert and McConkey become more than depth — they're a full backup correlation engine. If Burrow goes down, Herbert as a projected QB8 with his own starter in McConkey at WR20 keeps the stack-dependent model intact. BigCanadian isn't diversified against chaos so much as insulated from it.
