There is not much to argue with when a team sits at the bottom of the Metroid Prime division and checks in at the 7th percentile of the entire field, and TerminalSarcasm gives you very little ammunition to mount a defense. The most damning evidence is in the draft itself: two major reaches, five minor reaches, and zero steals across the whole board. Cam Ward, pulled 3.1 rounds ahead of his ADP and projecting as a QB23, is the kind of swing that needs to hit clean to justify the cost, and right now it is not hitting anything. Trey McBride at TE2 and Colston Loveland at TE3 are genuinely elite and give this team a real foundation, but in a positionless format the question is always whether the next layer of players can hold up, and Emeka Egbuka at WR18 and Luther Burden at WR22 suggest the answer is a reluctant maybe. A team that went 11-25 last season and ranked 9th percentile in scoring does not get the benefit of the doubt here, and this roster, as currently constructed, is not asking for it.

thomweaver is sitting at 11th in the Metroid Prime division and the 10th percentile of the field, and the roster makes that ranking feel about right. The best case for a turnaround rests on Bhayshul Tuten, who lands as a projected RB25 after Travis Etienne's departure opened Jacksonville's backfield. Tuten has the athletic profile to handle a featured role, but "wide open competition" still means competition, and counting on him as a cornerstone is a faith-based exercise at this stage. James Cook projects as a genuine RB5 anchor, and Drake Maye graded out as a minor reach at QB2, but those two bright spots can only carry so much. The draft offered no real windfalls, with zero steals and just two values on a 20-player board, meaning thomweaver built this thing mostly at market rate and got a below-market result. Tucker Kraft at TE5 is a legitimate asset, but when your path to contention runs through a Jacksonville backfield timeshare and a lot of chalk picks, you are not in a position to be optimistic about October.

There is a particular kind of fantasy exhaustion that comes not from a bad pick or two but from a roster that simply grades out near the bottom and offers no obvious path back to relevance, and that is exactly where DrDance finds itself heading into 2026. The team sits 10th in the Metroid Prime division and in just the 24th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet does not offer much comfort: 15 chalk picks, two minor reaches, and a major reach on Emanuel Wilson at RB69, taken nearly seven rounds before his ADP, which is the kind of swing that needs to pay off big and historically rarely does. The bright spots are real, Josh Allen at QB1 and Tyler Warren at TE4 anchoring a starting core that also includes Nico Collins at WR9 and Terry McLaurin at WR24, but those names paper over a roster that gets thin quickly and carries no steals to suggest undervalued upside is hiding somewhere on the bench. DrDance is not without weapons, just without margin for error, and in a tournament this competitive, that distinction tends to matter enormously.

oglewee arrives in the Metroid Prime division carrying the credibility of an 82nd-percentile finish in 2025, which is a fine reputation to have and an awkward one to live up to. The 2026 roster does not look like last year's team, and the gap shows up most clearly at receiver, where Tee Higgins (WR19) and Jaylen Waddle (WR23) are solid but nobody behind them inspires much confidence, leaving the top of the lineup to carry weight that the bottom cannot absorb. Jonathan Taylor (RB4) is a legitimate anchor, and the Lamar Jackson (QB3)/Mark Andrews (TE14) stack gives oglewee a high-ceiling pairing on nights when Baltimore is cooking. But the draft board tells a cautionary story: one major reach in Keenan Allen (WR99), pulled off the board nearly seven rounds early, and just zero steals across the entire roster. That is a lot of chalk for a team sitting at the 33rd percentile in tournament projections, which is a long way from where they finished twelve months ago.

SloanPHI ran a nearly flawless draft by the numbers, and the numbers still do not like them. Fifteen chalk picks, two values, zero major reaches: this is the portfolio of a manager who understood the market and played it straight. The problem is that playing the market straight delivered a roster sitting at 36th percentile and eighth in the Metroid Prime division, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether ADP efficiency was the goal or just the consolation prize. The top end is real: Brock Bowers at TE1 and Drake London at WR7 give this team a legitimate foundation, and Harold Fannin at TE6 adds genuine upside if the Browns' offense takes a step forward, though banking on Deshaun Watson for that step is its own risk. But the roster thins fast after those names, and Wan'Dale Robinson projects as the weakest starter at WR47. SloanPHI did almost everything right in the draft room and still assembled a team that projects to lose more than it wins. That is not a process failure. That is just a cruel result.

thorndj enters 2026 sitting seventh in the Metroid Prime division and in the 38th tournament percentile, and there is not much in the draft log to suggest a turnaround is coming. The roster does have genuine upside at the top, with Bijan Robinson projecting as RB2 and Jayden Daniels slotting in as a QB5 starter, but the margins erode fast after that. The draft was dominated by chalk picks with five major reaches sprinkled in, and those reaches are telling: David Njoku cost four rounds of draft capital ahead of his ADP to land a TE29, and Jake Tonges was grabbed more than four rounds early to net a TE34. That is an aggressive investment in a position group that grades out weak regardless. Meanwhile, the floor of the projected starting lineup is Aaron Jones at RB38, which is a precarious place to be when the schedule stops cooperating. Coming off a 36 percent win rate in 2025, thorndj needed a sharp offseason correction. This draft delivered more of the same.

The Lynnwood Orcas finished at the 90th percentile in scoring last season, then somehow landed at 39th percentile in projected rankings for 2026, which tells you everything about how cruel roster turnover can be. The receiver group is genuinely good: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, A.J. Brown at WR8, Zay Flowers at WR16, and Jameson Williams at WR21 give this team a ceiling that most rosters in the Metroid Prime division cannot match. The problem is that the margins elsewhere are razor thin. Tony Pollard projects as the weakest starter at RB30, and the Jared Goff/Williams stack adds a nice floor on Sundays when Detroit is clicking, but Goff at QB16 is the kind of quarterback who keeps you competitive without ever making you comfortable. Then there is Oronde Gadsden, projected TE16, whose path to production got murkier when the Chargers signed David Njoku late in the offseason. Gadsden showed real receiving chops last year, but now his role carries a question mark. Sixth in the division feels harsh, but not inaccurate.

Jstaring12 finished 2025 at the 70th percentile and comes into 2026 looking like someone who learned from that success, then decided to gamble on doubling it. The roster they built is genuinely good. It is also built on conviction, because the board did not hand this to them. Four minor reaches and two major ones tell a story of a manager who knew what they wanted and paid up. The curious part is that it mostly worked. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Malik Nabers at WR12 give this team a top-end receiving group that can carry a lineup, and Nabers was practically a gift, falling two full rounds past his ADP before Jstaring12 pounced. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 adds another projected starter who can dominate a week outright. Then there is Jakobi Meyers, taken 2.2 rounds early, which is the kind of reach that either looks prescient or embarrassing by October. Sitting fifth in the Metroid Prime division and at the 55th tournament percentile, this team projects as a real contender if the leaps of faith land.

claytongassner didn't land a single steal according to ADP, but four values and thirteen chalk picks paint the picture of a manager who consistently drafted the right player at the right time rather than swinging for miracle upside. The receiver group is where that discipline shows most clearly: CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 anchor the roster, and Chris Olave at WR11 and Ladd McConkey at WR20 give the lineup real depth behind them without any of it feeling accidental. Trevor Lawrence, snagged 1.2 rounds past his ADP, quietly fits the same pattern. The one blemish is Fernando Mendoza, a QB27 taken nearly five rounds early, which is the kind of reach that can haunt a manager when the format asks you to win with your best players regardless of position. Still, the projected starters here are genuinely good, and the 60th percentile tournament ranking feels conservative given how the top of this roster stacks up. Fourth in the Metroid Prime division is a floor, not a ceiling.

FeverishFanaro didn't need a lottery ticket to build one of the better rosters in the Metroid Prime division. This team lands in the 77th percentile not because of one splashy moment but because round after round produced a usable outcome. The foundation is genuinely strong: Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, and Omarion Hampton and Kyren Williams slot in as RB9 and RB15 respectively, giving the lineup a backfield core that most managers would sign for immediately. The quarterback situation quietly overdelivers, too. Joe Burrow at QB4 is the obvious headliner, but Caleb Williams came off the board at 4.07 despite an ADP a full round earlier, the kind of patient value that separates competent drafters from lucky ones. The receiver group rates weaker by projection, with Quentin Johnston as the weakest projected starter at WR41, but in a positionless format the strength at the top of the roster does the heavy lifting. Two values, sixteen picks at or near chalk, and a draft that never really stumbled. Third in the division feels like a floor.

There was no lottery ticket here, no single swing-for-the-fences moment that defined the draft. 6MileKyle just kept winning exchanges, and the cumulative effect landed them at 85th percentile in the field. The centerpiece is genuinely elite: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is a weekly foundation, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 arrived as the draft's clearest gift, falling a full round and a third past his ADP to slot 4.09. That kind of value does not announce itself loudly, but it shows up every week. Ashton Jeanty at RB7 gives this roster a second anchor that most teams would kill for at the top of their board. The one volatile piece worth watching is Rashee Rice, who projects as WR13 but carries genuine uncertainty: a short jail stint stemming from a probation violation, a knee procedure that costs him the early part of the calendar, and a concussion history that has already shortened one season. The Mahomes-Rice stack still has upside if Rice gets and stays healthy, but 6MileKyle has enough elsewhere that they are not waiting on him to function.

jsun44 sits atop the Metroid Prime division at the 99th tournament percentile, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. This roster was built without a single reach, zero minor and zero major, and the value hunting was relentless: Jalen Hurts landed at pick 6.12 despite projecting as QB9, a three-round windfall that looks even more interesting given the pressure he is facing after the A.J. Brown trade shipped his top target to New England. If Hurts rises to the moment and keeps churning out rushing touchdowns the way he has for five consecutive top-10 fantasy finishes, jsun44 is collecting a steal. Saquon Barkley fell nearly two rounds to pick 4.12 and projects as RB8, and De'Von Achane sits behind him at RB6, giving this roster a punishing backfield core before you even get to Breece Hall at RB14. The weakest projected starter is Jadarian Price at RB26, which on most rosters would be a problem. Here, it is barely a footnote.
