There is no charitable read available for weezy444 in the Mewtwo Division, and the draft board confirms it. The headline problem is not talent, it is the price paid for that talent, which inflated the cost of everything downstream. Travis Kelce, projecting as TE10, was taken a full 1.6 rounds early. Dallas Goedert, projecting as TE15, went three rounds before his ADP. Together those two reaches consumed capital that could have repaired what is genuinely broken here: a receiver group so thin that the projected starters top out at Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33, with Matthew Golden at WR52 behind him. Not a single steal, not a single value, zero positive variance across the entire draft, just fourteen chalk picks and six reaches ranging from careless to damaging. The team sits at the 5th percentile of the field. Last year weezy444 finished in the 72nd percentile of scoring, so the floor exists. But this draft did not build on that foundation. It quietly dismantled it, one overpay at a time.

There is no sugarcoating where mruss19 stands heading into 2026: sitting 11th in the Mewtwo division and projected in just the 7th percentile of the field, this roster is in genuine trouble and the draft did not do much to change that. The top of the lineup is real, Christian McCaffrey at RB3, Nico Collins at WR9, Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 give mruss19 a ceiling worth respecting. But a fantasy team is not just its best players, and once you get past that upper tier the drop-off is steep and largely self-inflicted. Six minor reaches and a major reach on Mac Jones at QB39, a backup quarterback taken nearly six rounds early, suggest a manager who was chasing upside that never materialized in the projections. The situation at the back of the starting lineup is telling: Rico Dowdle, projected RB32, is the weakest projected starter, a player who earned a lead role in Carolina only to be replaced, and now figures to split work in Pittsburgh behind Jaylen Warren. When your floor depends on a timeshare back who just lost his starting job, the lever you needed to pull probably no longer exists.

Sav1 sits 10th in the Mewtwo division and in just the 27th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism: three major reaches against zero steals is the signature of a manager who kept paying a premium for players who did not require one. Kirk Cousins at QB35 was taken 4.6 rounds ahead of his ADP, Dalton Kincaid at TE11 cost two full rounds of surplus, and Chris Bell at WR87 was summoned nearly four rounds early for a player projected well outside the top 80 at his position. Brock Bowers at TE1 is genuinely elite and Drake London at WR7 gives the lineup a real top-end piece, but when your weakest projected starter is Sam Darnold at QB21, the ceiling has a very low crossbeam. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, no deeply discounted anchor waiting to emerge, just a roster grading near the bottom of the tournament with the draft capital already spent on the wrong bets.

JaredS90 finished in the 69th percentile in scoring last season and enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Mewtwo Division at just the 34th tournament percentile, and the roster does not hide why. The star power is real: De'Von Achane at RB6, Saquon Barkley at RB8, and Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 give this team a legitimate top-end punch. The problem is what surrounds them. Jordan Love grades as a QB17 in a positionless format where quarterback production can quietly bleed you out week after week, and the projected starting corps bottoms out with Jayden Higgins at WR54, which is a long way to fall from Chase. The draft offered no help on the margins, producing zero steals against five minor reaches, meaning JaredS90 paid up for upside that has not materialized in the projections. When your floor depends on Love threading the needle and Higgins delivering as a starter, the ceiling those top backs and Chase provide starts to feel more theoretical than actionable.

ffGarrett sits eighth in the Mewtwo division and checks in at just the 37th percentile of the field, and the roster itself explains why there is no obvious path out. The elite tier belongs entirely to the tight end group, where Trey McBride, Colston Loveland, Tucker Kraft, Kyle Pitts, and Sam LaPorta project as five of the top eight at the position, which is genuinely impressive. The problem is that the rest of the lineup falls off a cliff: Baker Mayfield and C.J. Stroud are the projected starters at quarterback and they grade out QB18 and QB22 respectively, while the receiving corps leans on Parker Washington at WR35 and Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47 as its primary contributors. That is a lot of weight for tight ends to carry. The draft did not provide much relief either, producing zero steals against two major reaches, including T.J. Hockenson pulled nearly two and a half rounds early. When your best move is cornering the market on one position and hoping the rest holds, it usually does not.

FFDaMaddog scored in the 94th percentile last season, and the reputation attached to that number is going to do a lot of heavy lifting in 2026, because the roster underneath it looks considerably thinner. The receiver group is genuinely impressive, with Puka Nacua projecting as WR1, Rashee Rice at WR13, and Zay Flowers at WR16 forming a starting core most managers would envy. But the draft process offers a quiet warning: fourteen chalk picks, one good value, and a major reach on Flowers taken 1.5 rounds before his ADP suggests a team chasing names rather than finding them. The backfield is soft, with Kenneth Gainwell projecting at RB34 and Rachaad White at RB39 as the best of a thin group. Harold Fannin at TE6 helps, but Juwan Johnson is the projected weakest starter on the roster and projects at TE20. The cumulative result is a team sitting at the 38th percentile, seventh in the Mewtwo division. Last year's FFDaMaddog was a force. This year's version is coasting on that memory.

JessePantuosco lands at 72nd percentile and sixth in the Mewtwo division, which sounds underwhelming until you look at how the roster got built. This was not a draft defined by lottery tickets or bold swings, just a steady accumulation of advantage, four values against ADP and almost no costly mistakes worth flagging. James Cook at RB5 and Chase Brown at RB11 give the lineup a backfield foundation that most managers would happily take, and Brown himself came at a discount, falling nearly a full round past his ADP. The more interesting wrinkle is the Jaxson Dart and Malik Nabers stack. Dart is the kind of mobile quarterback whose fantasy ceiling draws real excitement even when the passing volume and durability questions are legitimate, and pairing him directly with Nabers means JessePantuosco gets to double-collect when that ceiling shows up. The one blemish is Hunter Henry arriving three rounds early, a reach that stands out on an otherwise clean sheet. Clean sheets tend to win close weeks, and this roster has enough of them to matter.

aidancotter didn't win the draft on one flashy pick, just kept coming out ahead round after round, and the cumulative effect lands them at the 74th percentile. The foundation is Bijan Robinson at RB2, a projected starter who gives this roster a genuine anchor. From there, the draft built steadily: Lamar Jackson at QB3 fell nearly a full round past his ADP, and a five-receiver corps headlined by George Pickens at WR10, Emeka Egbuka at WR18, and Terry McLaurin at WR24 gives the lineup consistent starter-quality options to mix and match. The late-round work on Tony Pollard and Tyler Allgeier, each slipping past their ADP, added depth at a discount. The two major reaches, Dontayvion Wicks and Michael Mayer, are worth watching, but they came in rounds 17 and 18 where reaching costs little. This is a 5th-place division finish projection for now, but the roster was assembled with the quiet confidence of someone who knew exactly what they were doing, pick after pick.

JLes did not swing for the fences and miss. This roster was built pick by pick, quietly accumulating an edge, and the finished product sits at the 78th percentile of the field. The clearest illustration is Jayden Daniels, a projected QB5 who slid a full round past his expected draft spot and landed at 4.01. That is not luck, that is patience rewarded. Travis Etienne fell nearly a round and a half before JLes grabbed him at QB5 as a projected RB18, giving the roster a capable starter at genuine value. The receiver group is where the draft grade gets filed away without much debate: CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 are projected starters who do not require a footnote, and Chris Olave at WR11 keeps the ceiling honest. The one minor reach, Chris Godwin at WR38, was a round early but hardly a red flag on a board this clean. Fourth in the Mewtwo Division is the current projection, but this is a team the division should be watching.

Gloonge didn't build this roster with one flashy swing. They built it pick by pick, consistently getting more than they paid for, and the cumulative effect is a team that sits 79th percentile in the field and third in the Mewtwo Division. Justin Herbert at QB8 is the kind of anchor you want, and Gloonge got him at 5.05 when his ADP suggested he'd be gone almost two rounds earlier. That same disciplined patience shows up at receiver, where Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and A.J. Brown at WR8 give this team a ceiling that most managers in this field simply can't match. DeVonta Smith at WR14 and Jameson Williams at WR21 round out a starting group that doesn't have a soft spot. The draft wasn't drama-free, five values identified across the board tell the story of a manager who let the board come to them, stayed patient when it made sense, and walked away with a lineup where almost every projected starter belongs there on merit.

Pattylce1010 did not build this roster with one bold swing. They built it by winning exchange after exchange, round after round, until the advantages compounded into something that now sits second in the Mewtwo division and at the 85th percentile of the field. The foundation starts at the top, where Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1 and Tyler Warren slots in as TE4, two anchors acquired at or near fair value that give this lineup a ceiling most managers are still chasing. Then the middle rounds did what good drafts are supposed to do: Caleb Williams, projected QB6, fell nearly two rounds past his ADP and landed at 5.03, and Stefon Diggs, projected WR56, slid more than two rounds before Pattylce1010 scooped him up. Neither is a headline steal, but that is exactly the point. This team was not built on luck or a single inspired gamble. It was built on a draft where the manager kept coming out ahead, and the standings are starting to reflect it.

DeliverUsIF sits atop the Mewtwo division and in the 87th percentile of the field, and the blueprint behind that standing is less about one thunderbolt pick than about a draft that quietly won almost every exchange. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 slid past his ADP to land at 2.05, and Josh Jacobs, projected RB16, fell nearly two full rounds before DeliverUsIF scooped him at 7.08. Those two picks alone represent the kind of compounding advantage that separates a good draft from a great one, and the rest of the board filled in with similarly disciplined chalk. The one genuine question mark is Jalen Hurts, projected QB9 and a projected starter, who heads into 2026 without AJ Brown after the offseason trade to New England. Hurts has built five consecutive top-10 fantasy finishes largely on the back of his rushing touchdowns, but a passing attack under new pressure is harder to price with confidence. If Hurts holds, this roster looks like a legitimate title contender. If he slips, the question becomes how much the rest of the lineup can carry.
