Rogi sits 12th in the Ellie Division and in the 4th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record explains exactly how it happened: three major reaches, six minor reaches, and just one steal across the whole board. The steal was Jalen Nailor at WR61, which is the kind of win that doesn't move the needle when everything around it was bought at a premium. Rashee Rice at WR13 is a fine player, but pulling him nearly two rounds early in Round 2 when the board was presumably flush with talent set a tone that never recovered. Then Alec Pierce, a projected WR32, got taken 2.1 rounds ahead of schedule, and J.K. Dobbins, the projected weakest starter on the roster at RB36, cost a Round 10 pick for a player ADP had in Round 12. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 is a legitimate anchor, but he was already the consensus pick at that slot, so Rogi doesn't get credit for correctness there. This is a draft that zigged on every pick where staying patient would have paid off.

DavidMatz enters 2026 sitting 11th in the Ellie division and in just the 10th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The foundation is real enough: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 is a genuine difference-maker, and the Patrick Mahomes and Travis Kelce stack gives the team a floor most managers would envy. But the draft process did this team no favors. Luther Burden cost a pick 1.6 rounds ahead of his ADP, and Kenneth Walker III was grabbed a full round early, meaning DavidMatz paid premium prices for players who graded out as mid-tier contributors. The result is a roster with one elite anchor and a lot of question marks filling out the rest of the lineup. Dalton Kincaid, projected at TE11, is a reasonable piece if healthy, but Bills GM Brandon Beane's "too early to tell" comment on Kincaid's knee is not exactly a rallying cry. DavidMatz had a winning record in 2025. The arrow is now pointing somewhere considerably less comfortable.

Magaddan sits 10th in the Ellie division and in just the 26th percentile of the field, and nothing about this roster suggests a dramatic reversal is coming. The draft is the clearest indictment: three major reaches, zero steals, and a draft board that repeatedly paid a premium for players who did not earn it. Rhamondre Stevenson, reached for nearly two and a half rounds ahead of his ADP and projecting as just RB31, is the weakest projected starter on the roster, a perfectly avoidable problem that is now baked into the season. The one genuine bright spot is Harold Fannin, a TE6 projection who outplayed his veteran competition last year and inherited an even larger target share once David Njoku walked in free agency, though the Browns' quarterback situation remains somewhere between concerning and comedic. Fannin has real upside, but one ascending tight end cannot carry a roster that graded out at the bottom of its draft class. Magaddan needed leverage and did not find any.

IdoloMoctezuma enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Ellie division and in just the 30th percentile of the field, and the roster offers precious little reason for optimism. The foundation is real: Brock Bowers at TE1, Malik Nabers at WR12, and Jayden Daniels projecting as a QB5 give this team a legitimate top end. But the draft process did this roster no favors. Of 17 picks tracked against ADP, zero qualified as steals and two landed as major reaches, including Tyjae Spears, taken nearly three rounds early to land at RB47, and Pat Bryant, hauled in at WR86 after a similar overpay. Those are roster spots that could have compounded the strength at the top and instead became dead weight. RJ Harvey, projected as the weakest starter at RB28, is the ceiling for that tier of the roster. Coming off a 33-percent win rate in 2025, IdoloMoctezuma needed a sharper offseason. Instead, this looks like a team that paid full retail for players the market was trying to warn them about.

GeckoNegro enters 2026 sitting at 39th percentile and eighth in the Ellie Division, and the draft chart does not offer much comfort. The roster leans heavily on a backfield headlined by Bijan Robinson (RB2) and Ashton Jeanty (RB7), which is a genuine strength, but above the line the picture gets murky fast. The receiver group grades out weak, with Tetairoa McMillan (WR15) as the lone credible top-end option and a supporting cast that bottoms out around Elic Ayomanor (WR95) and Christian Kirk (WR100). What makes it worse is that GeckoNegro burned draft capital getting there, reaching three rounds early on Kyler Murray (QB19) and nearly four rounds early on Ayomanor, players who grade out as fringe starters at best. Those early investments in the wrong places left the back of the draft thin, and the two genuine values found, Sam LaPorta (TE8) and Cade Otton (TE27), are nice surprises but not the kind that change a team's ceiling. There is no obvious lever left to pull here.

elmanza sits at the 51st percentile and seventh in the Ellie division, which is another way of saying the margins decide everything. The pieces that could push this roster over the top are real: Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Drake Maye came in as a genuine steal at QB2 despite being taken at 2.10, and the Jalen Hurts and DeVonta Smith stack gives elmanza a built-in multiplier on big Hurts weeks. The concern is that the floor has a trapdoor. Last season's 19 percent win rate and 15th-percentile scoring aren't projections, they're recent history, and this roster doesn't scream "fixed." Josh Jacobs was a minor reach at RB16, and the projected weakest starter, Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47, is the kind of name that shows up in a lineup when the injury gods get creative. Nothing here is broken, but nothing is overwhelming either. Nacua stays healthy and Maye takes a step forward, this team climbs. One bad bounce, and elmanza is right back where 2025 left off.

GaboArrioja didn't swing for the fences and whiff, didn't load up at one position at the expense of another, just drafted a clean, efficient roster that quietly stacks up well against the field. The foundation is real: De'Von Achane at RB6 and Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 give this team legitimate top-tier producers, and the supporting cast around them is more than window dressing. Jeremiyah Love at RB13, Cam Skattebo at RB20, and Zay Flowers at WR16 are all projected starters who would headline weaker rosters. Kyle Pitts at TE7 came as good value, taken a round and a half after his ADP suggested he'd go. The one subplot worth watching is Brock Purdy, who heads into 2026 with a receiving corps full of question marks around injuries and availability. Purdy is still a QB13 projection, so the market has already priced in some of that uncertainty, but it bears monitoring. A 58 percent win rate and 75th percentile scoring in 2025 suggests this manager knows what they're doing. Nothing here looks like a fluke.

Orlazz17 enters 2026 sitting at the 69th percentile, and the draft chart tells you exactly why: two steals, two values, and just three minor reaches across the board. That kind of consistent efficiency doesn't generate highlight clips, but it builds real floors. The headliner is Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, a legitimately elite anchor, but the supporting cast is what makes this roster hum. Nico Collins at WR9 and Chris Olave at WR11 were both taken at value or better, Olave sliding nearly a full round past his ADP. Meanwhile, Lamar Jackson at QB3 came in at a slight discount, and Josh Downs landed at WR46 more than two rounds later than his consensus suggested, the kind of quiet steal that separates a good draft from a great one. George Kittle at TE9 falling two-plus rounds is the other one worth circling. Individually none of these moves looks like genius. Collectively they paint the picture of a manager who trusted the board, stayed disciplined, and consistently came out ahead of the room.

Inglorious Staffords drafted like a manager who trusted their board implicitly, reached on four players by the tournament's own accounting, and somehow came out holding a genuinely good roster anyway. The most telling example is Elijah Sarratt, pulled 6.3 rounds before consensus said to, a pick that looks reckless until you realize the same instinct that grabbed Sarratt early also identified Colston Loveland sliding to 3.11 when his ADP was 2.08, landing a TE3 at a discount. That is the Inglorious Staffords draft in miniature: the reaches and the values are almost impossible to separate, because the same conviction drove both. The foundation this approach built is legitimately strong. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 are projected starters who give this team a top-end ceiling most rosters cannot match, and a Herbert-McConkey stack adds connective tissue. At 69th percentile, this team sits in a genuinely competitive position, and the roster suggests the reaches were less reckless than they were early.

The entire architecture of YOU. ARE. CURSED rests on two stacks, and that is not a flaw in the blueprint, it is the blueprint. Dak Prescott paired with CeeDee Lamb is the centerpiece, a WR5 operating as the preferred target of a QB7 with legitimate ceiling games baked into the schedule. Jared Goff and Jameson Williams form the second pairing, and while Goff projects as QB16, the correlation between that offense and Williams at WR21 means a big Goff day does not just add points, it multiplies them. The receiver group surrounding those stacks is genuinely deep, with Drake London at WR7 and Emeka Egbuka at WR18 giving the manager legitimate upside even on the weeks when neither stack fully ignites. The draft was disciplined, five values against zero major reaches, suggesting the manager executed the vision without overpaying to force it. Sitting third in the division and in the 71st percentile overall, this team does not need luck so much as it needs correlation to do exactly what correlation is supposed to do when it finally shows up.

The Dixie Sharks didn't win their draft on one flashy pick. They won it on accumulation. Start with the backfield, where Jahmyr Gibbs as RB1, James Cook at RB5, and Saquon Barkley at RB8 form a projected-starter group that most managers would rebuild their entire roster around, and this team got all three. Beyond that top tier, Javonte Williams comes in at RB17, taken roughly a round early but not by a margin that should concern anyone. The discipline extended to the later rounds too, where Bo Nix landed at QB15 a full round past his ADP and Jake Ferguson came in at TE12 a round late as well. Two values, zero steals, zero major reaches across the entire draft: that's a manager who stayed patient, let the board come to them, and cashed in when the opportunity arrived. A 72% win rate and an 82nd-percentile scoring season in 2025 suggests this isn't a fluke operation, either. Division rank of second and a 71st-percentile tournament standing in 2026 look, if anything, conservative.

CruzTech89 didn't stumble into a 99th percentile roster, this thing was engineered. The blueprint is visible in the draft receipts: ten values or better against just three reaches, with Joe Burrow landing at pick 3.10 despite a QB4 projection, and Tucker Kraft sliding to 6.03 despite projecting as a TE5. That is not luck, that is a manager who knew what the board owed him and waited until he collected. The starting corps reflects the discipline: Trey McBride at TE2, Tyler Warren at TE4, A.J. Brown at WR8, and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 form a top line that most divisions would envy from a distance. If there is anything to examine with a magnifying glass, it is Parker Washington, who parlayed an improbable 2025 breakout into a WR35 projection despite legitimate questions about whether Jacksonville actually wants him leading their receiving corps ahead of Brian Thomas Jr. Washington

is the floor of this roster, which tells you everything about the ceiling. Division rank first, tournament percentile 99th, and very little for rivals to celebrate.
