There is a particular kind of exhaustion that comes not from one catastrophic mistake but from a dozen small ones compounding over time, and that is precisely where BrokenHelmet finds itself sitting 12th in the Mortal Kombat division and in just the 7th percentile of the field. The draft tells the story clearly enough: three major reaches against zero steals, with the most damaging being Dontayvion Wicks, taken 5.6 rounds ahead of his ADP and projecting out as WR96. That is not a dart throw, that is a dart thrown blindfolded at the wrong board. Jonathan Taylor grades as RB4 and gives this roster a legitimate foundation, and Joe Burrow at QB4 adds genuine star power, but the projected starters around them, Christian Watson at WR28, Rome Odunze at WR30, and RJ Harvey at RB28, are the kind of supporting cast that asks a lot of the top of the lineup. When the draft produces no steals and the receiver group leans on a WR96 for depth, there is no obvious lever left to pull, and the standings are likely to reflect that all season.

vikingsuperfan sits 11th in the Mortal Kombat Division, and the roster offers very little reason for optimism. The foundation is genuinely appealing: Lamar Jackson projects as QB3, CeeDee Lamb as WR5, and Tyler Warren as TE4, and Warren was one of only two players in the entire draft who fell past his ADP, a small but real win. The problem is that the supporting cast collapses almost immediately after those names. The projected starters beyond that top tier include Javonte Williams at RB17, Quinshon Judkins at RB22, and Jadarian Price at RB26, passable contributors but not the kind of depth that makes a title contender. Worse, the draft was defined by caution abandoned: three major reaches, including Jaxson Dart at pick 3.12 when his ADP sat more than a round and a half later, and T.J. Hockenson taken nearly two rounds early. Those reaches burned capital that could have shored up the back end of a roster now projected to finish near the bottom of the field with no obvious lever left to pull.

There is no sugarcoating the situation for mec0315 in the Mortal Kombat division: sitting 10th in the division and in just the 26th percentile of the field, this roster is already in a hole, and the draft did not supply much of a shovel. The receiver group grades weak, and the projected starter most likely to drag down a lineup on any given week is Jakobi Meyers at WR45, a reach taken a full round before his ADP to boot. Meanwhile, the draft leaned heavily on chalk, producing 13 picks right at market value and only one genuine steal, so there is no buried treasure waiting to be discovered on this bench. Jalen Hurts at QB9 is a legitimate asset, but he cost a full round of premium capital as a reach at pick 2.12. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 is real, and Sam LaPorta at TE8 gives the team a capable piece, but when the floor of your projected starters is Meyers and you drafted conservatively enough to leave almost no upside on the margins, hoping for the best starts to feel less like a strategy and more like a eulogy.

alfredobrown enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Mortal Kombat division and projected at just the 41st percentile of the field, and the draft record does not offer much reassurance. The roster has genuine anchors in Christian McCaffrey (RB3) and Justin Jefferson (WR6), both projected starters who were acquired at value, but the problem is everything downstream. Five major reaches litter the sheet, and two of the most expensive are at quarterback: Tyler Shough (QB20) was taken 2.5 rounds early and J.J. McCarthy (QB37) was grabbed nearly seven rounds before the market said to. Neither projects as a difference-maker, yet together they consumed the kind of mid-draft capital that should be building lineup depth. Kyle Pitts (TE7) was also reached for, landing 1.3 rounds early. The result is a team that leans hard on McCaffrey and Jefferson while the projected weakest starter, Jalen Coker (WR55), underscores how quickly the talent drops off. With the draft behind him and no obvious corrective move available, alfredobrown looks like a team that already spent its margin for error.

Balzer enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Mortal Kombat division and hovering right around the 47th percentile, which is the fantasy equivalent of being exactly mediocre enough to miss out on everything good. The top of the roster is genuinely impressive, Josh Allen at QB1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this team a real foundation, and the Allen/D.J. Moore stack adds a layer of upside that most managers would envy. But the drop-off comes fast and it comes hard. The projected starting lineup leans on Rhamondre Stevenson as its weakest link, and Balzer reached 2.2 rounds early to get him, which means the draft capital is already spent on a player projecting out at RB31. Pair that with a draft sheet showing zero steals, zero real values, and two major reaches, and there is no obvious way to manufacture improvement from here. The wide receiver group grades average at best, the tight end situation is thin, and there are no late-round lottery tickets hiding in the back of this roster to dream on. Balzer is not bad enough to be interesting. They are just quietly, stubbornly stuck.

GregoryTwoGloves sits at 48th percentile and seventh in the Mortal Kombat division, which is exactly as unremarkable as it sounds, and exactly why every decision this season carries real weight. The core is genuinely interesting: Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Colston Loveland and Tucker Kraft slot in at TE3 and TE5 respectively, and a Jordan Love to Kraft stack gives the roster a built-in bonus that could tip close weeks. Jayden Daniels at QB5 keeps the ceiling from caving in. But the margins this team lives by are thin ones. Rico Dowdle, the weakest projected starter at RB32, is the kind of player who holds serve in good weeks and quietly loses you bad ones. The draft itself offered no cushion, producing fourteen chalk picks and four minor reaches with zero identified steals, meaning there is no late-round discovery waiting to emerge as a difference-maker. GregoryTwoGloves did not build a team that will blow anyone out. They built one where Nacua's production, the Love-Kraft connection, and Dowdle's reliability all have to hit at roughly the same time.

hv1619 sits at 50th percentile and division rank six, which means every week is a coin flip dressed up as a football game. The roster has genuine weapons at the top: Drake Maye projects as QB2, Amon-Ra St. Brown as WR4, and Omarion Hampton as RB9, a trio capable of winning any matchup on a given week. But the margins the team lives and dies by show up in the draft tendencies and the projected starters further down the depth chart. Fifteen chalk picks out of eighteen total selections signals a manager who colored inside the lines all draft, and the one major reach, Brock Purdy at QB13 pulled a full 1.4 rounds before his ADP, is the kind of early commitment that costs capital better spent shoring up the back end. Tony Pollard projecting as RB30 is the weakest projected starter on the roster, and in a format this competitive, that slot gets targeted. Maye and St. Brown give this team a ceiling. Pollard and the draft conservatism define the floor.

There was no single moment where ei112 won the draft, just a series of small edges that added up to something real. Caleb Williams at QB6 anchors the passing game, and the surrounding cast was built the same way, through patience and positioning. Nico Collins at WR9, Tee Higgins at WR19, and Bijan Robinson at RB2 give this roster a legitimate top-end foundation, and the middle of the draft filled in cleanly around it. Four values across the board, including C.J. Stroud sliding to WR22 territory and Dalton Kincaid falling nearly a round and a half past his ADP, reflect a manager who let the board come to him rather than forcing anything. The one blemish worth noting is Tyreek Hill, reached three full rounds early at a WR77 projection, which is the kind of swing that can haunt a roster when other late-round options were still on the board. Still, sitting in the 66th percentile of the field with this much projected starter quality is a reasonable place to be. The Mortal Kombat division will not be forgiving, but ei112 earned a seat at the table.

HighHopes77 enters 2026 looking like someone who actually did their homework before the draft, and the results show it. The foundation is legitimately strong: De'Von Achane at RB6, Derrick Henry at RB12, and Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 give this roster a top-end that most managers in the Mortal Kombat division would trade for on the spot. Chase alone is worth the price of admission, and the fact that HighHopes77 landed him a full round past his ADP is exactly the kind of quiet edge that separates disciplined drafters from lucky ones. Tyler Allgeier falling 3.1 rounds past his ADP at RB46 adds real depth at almost no cost. The 2025 campaign backed up the process too, a 28-8 record and 86th percentile scoring are not flukes. Sitting 4th in the division and in the 68th tournament percentile feels like a floor more than a ceiling here. Clean draft, proven manager, legitimate stars at the top of the lineup. HighHopes77 is built to make noise.

ReddiWip77 sits third in the Mortal Kombat division and in the 79th percentile of the field, which is a pretty comfortable place to land after a draft that looked reckless in the moment and vindicated in the rearview. The reach column is long: David Njoku pulled 3.5 rounds early, Brian Robinson nearly three, Jaylen Wright more than five. But here is the thing about reaches, they only look bad when the roster does not hold up, and this roster holds up. James Cook at RB5, Ashton Jeanty at RB7, and Breece Hall at RB14 form a top end that no amount of late-round gambling can undermine, and Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Chris Olave at WR11 arrived as values, not expenses, giving this team its best players essentially at a discount. ReddiWip77 paid above market in the middle and back of the draft and got away with it because the foundation was already locked in by the time the reaches started. Call it conviction, call it luck, call it whatever you want, but the scoreboard in this format does not grade on style.

After a 2025 campaign that landed crzygat1414 in the sixth percentile of scoring, the 2026 roster looks like a genuine resurrection. The engine of this turnaround is a receiver corps that reads like a fantasy manager's wishlist: A.J. Brown at WR8, Malik Nabers at WR12, DeVonta Smith at WR14, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 are all projected starters, giving this team four top-15 wideouts before a single other name gets called. Nabers is the headline steal of the draft, tumbling nearly three rounds past his ADP to land at pick 6.07, a windfall that quietly defines this entire build. Trey McBride at TE2 and Harold Fannin at TE6 add another layer of projected-starter firepower at a position where most managers would kill for one reliable option. The result is a team sitting second in the Mortal Kombat division and in the 79th percentile of the full field, a number that would have seemed hallucinatory twelve months ago. The floor has been raised dramatically, and the rebound looks very, very real.

BallKnower sits atop the Mortal Kombat division and at the 86th percentile of the field, and the draft that built this roster is exactly why. There was no single lottery-ticket swing that either paid off spectacularly or blew up on the launch pad. Instead, pick after pick came in slightly ahead of schedule, the kind of quiet drafting that separates disciplined managers from lucky ones. Garrett Wilson at WR17 and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 were both projected starters taken a round after their respective ADPs suggested they would be gone. Brock Bowers at TE1 anchors the whole operation. Across the full roster, six picks qualified as genuine values against ADP, with only two minor reaches and zero major ones. That ratio is not an accident. When your weakest projected starter is Jayden Reed at WR48, the floor of this roster is already pretty comfortable, and the ceiling, with London, Pickens, Zay Flowers, and Bowers all projecting as starters, is the kind of thing that makes Mortal Kombat opponents check the standings twice.
