insleycatcat enters 2026 sitting at the bottom of the Alpha Centauri division and in just the 10th percentile of the field, and the draft did little to change that trajectory. The roster carries two major reaches that already sting: Sam LaPorta, a TE8 projection taken nearly three full rounds early at pick 3.03, and Brian Robinson, a projected RB45 grabbed 2.5 rounds ahead of his market value. That is a lot of draft capital spent chasing players who graded out as middling at best, and the rest of the board was almost entirely chalk, with zero steals to compensate. The saving grace is Bijan Robinson as a projected RB2 and Jayden Daniels as a projected QB5, both projected starters who at least give the lineup a genuine ceiling. But with Wan'Dale Robinson projected as the weakest starter at WR47, the floor is uncomfortably close to the ceiling, and a 56 percent win rate last season suggests this is a roster that has been treading water for a while. There is no obvious infusion of upside coming.

ThisSaskatoon sits 11th in the Alpha Centauri division and in just the 27th percentile of the field, and the roster offers little reason for optimism. The brightest spots are real: Brock Bowers projects as TE1, A.J. Brown checks in at WR8, and Dak Prescott sits at QB7 among those eligible to start. But the draft strategy has left the depth chart looking like a house built on a cracked foundation. Three major reaches anchor the back end of this roster, most painfully Jaydon Blue, taken more than seven rounds ahead of his ADP at a projection of RB70, and J.K. Dobbins, grabbed two full rounds early at RB36. Those are the kinds of gambles that need to pay off for a contender to survive, let alone a team already scraping the bottom of the division. They have not paid off in projection. With Kyle Monangai slotting in as the weakest projected starter at RB33, the margin for error is essentially gone before the season even begins.

JayPizzle1107 comes into 2026 ranked 10th in the Alpha Centauri division and sitting at just the 28th percentile of the field, and there is not much in the construction of this roster to suggest those numbers are about to improve. The quarterback situation is the clearest drag: Bo Nix projects as a QB15 and Shedeur Sanders sits at QB32, meaning this team is essentially asking the rest of its starters to carry a dead weight at the most leveraged position on the board. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and James Cook at RB5 are genuinely good players, but the supporting cast falls off quickly, and the draft offered no relief. JayPizzle1107 produced zero steals and zero values across the entire board, instead drafting 15 chalk picks and five minor reaches, including Cook himself, taken before his ADP without any obvious upside justification. After an 11-25 campaign in 2025 that landed in the 24th percentile of scoring, this roster needed a bold offseason. It did not get one.

SaintOfCryptids did everything right and still ended up with a roster that projects 32nd percentile, which is the fantasy equivalent of following the recipe exactly and pulling a casserole out of the oven that somehow tastes like regret. The draft was a model of patience: four values, zero major reaches, thirteen picks taken right at consensus. George Pickens slid to 3.10 despite an ADP of 3.01, Garrett Wilson fell more than a round past his number, and the manager collected both without flinching. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give this team a genuinely elite top end. The problem is the fall-off. The projected starters include C.J. Stroud at QB22, and the rest of the supporting cast sits in ranges where production becomes a matter of faith more than projection. SaintOfCryptids earned every pick on the board and still landed ninth in the Alpha Centauri division. The market was beaten. The standings do not care.

The outlook for jpdidthis in 2026 is about as encouraging as a depth chart held together with tape. Sitting eighth in the Alpha Centauri division and projecting at just the 38th percentile of the field, this roster arrives with structural problems that good vibes cannot fix. The good news is real: Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and Trey McBride at TE2 are genuine difference-makers, and Harold Fannin at TE6 gives the team a second top-tier weapon to deploy. But the draft process quietly undermined whatever platform those stars could stand on. Rico Dowdle, the team's projected weakest starter, was taken nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP, and Kenneth Gainwell was similarly rushed off the board more than two rounds early. That is not bold roster-building, that is burning bullets on players who didn't require them. Last season's 13th-percentile scoring finish suggests this isn't just bad luck looking for a correction, and with three major reaches on the ledger and zero steals, jpdidthis has left itself very little room to outperform the projection.

DaiquiriDaddy enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting seventh in the Alpha Centauri division and projecting at just the 39th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer many reasons for optimism. The foundation is legitimate, Josh Allen at QB1 and Lamar Jackson at QB3 are as good as it gets at the position, but in a positionless format that advantage only carries so far when the rest of the depth chart grades out average across the board. Kenneth Walker III projects as the best non-quarterback on the roster at RB10, and the supporting cast thins out quickly from there. Blake Corum at RB35 projects as the weakest starter, and Dalton Kincaid, who could be a reliable weapon paired with Allen, comes with a knee injury history that Bills GM Brandon Beane would only describe as "too early to tell" heading into the season. That kind of uncertainty is a rough thing to build around. DaiquiriDaddy drafted mostly chalk with no steals and four reaches, leaving little reason to expect hidden upside to surface when the standings get tight.

Mesalex sits at the 52nd percentile and sixth in the Alpha Centauri division, which tells you everything about where this season lives: not in the comfort zone of a contender, not in the resignation of a rebuild, but somewhere in that itchy middle where every close week feels like it could tip either way. The roster has genuine upside concentrated at the top, with Joe Burrow at QB4 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 anchoring a starting group that can absolutely compete on its best weeks. The wild card is Luther Burden, who arrives with Ben Johnson publicly drawing comparisons to St. Brown after a second-half surge last season that projected to elite production at full deployment. If Burden delivers at WR22, this offense has real teeth. If the hype outruns him, Mesalex is leaning heavily on a supporting cast where Javonte Williams at RB17 and DeVonta Smith at WR14 are solid but not difference-makers. Fifteen chalk picks and just two values in the draft means the margin for error was baked in before Week 1 even tips off.

Bear Down didn't need a headline move to build something worth watching. The foundation starts with Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4, two projected starters who would anchor any serious contender, and the supporting cast was assembled with quiet efficiency. Tyler Warren landed at TE4 after slipping nearly a full round past his ADP, and Tucker Kraft followed at TE5 on a similar one-round discount, giving Bear Down a projected starter at that position who cost less than market price and another right behind him who cost even less. That's not luck, that's the draft working as intended. The board fell their way, and they took what it offered. Fourteen chalk picks kept the roster stable while four values added real margin, and the team lands at 63rd percentile in the field with room to climb if projections break right. After a 50 percent win rate in 2025, Bear Down looks like a team that figured out what it was doing wrong and corrected it, pick by methodical pick.

dontstopcollecting arrived at this draft with a plan, executed it with conviction, and left with a roster that is genuinely difficult to argue with, even if the process invites some raised eyebrows. The foundation is unimpeachable: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Drake London at WR7 give this team a top-shelf core that most managers would sign for immediately. Malik Nabers at WR12 arrived as a gift, falling more than a full round past his ADP before this team scooped him up. But here is where the story gets complicated. dontstopcollecting then spent three late picks on Jonah Coleman, Nicholas Singleton, and Demond Claiborne, each of them taken somewhere between three and four rounds ahead of consensus, a collective act of faith in depth that the market had not yet priced in. Whether those calls reflect genuine conviction or inspired recklessness, the top of this roster is good enough to carry a lot of uncertainty. Sitting fourth in the Alpha Centauri division at the 67th percentile, this team has the ceiling to climb and the late-round gambles to watch nervously all season.

There are no heists in utgspecial's draft ledger, no midnight trades for a guy you'd never heard of, just a quiet, relentless accumulation of correct decisions. Drake Maye at QB2 is the kind of anchor that lets everything else breathe, and the addition of AJ Brown in New England gives Maye a genuine alpha for the first time, which means the projection could still be underselling him. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 sitting in the same lineup is the sort of thing that happens when a manager simply keeps winning exchanges at the table. The draft sheet reads 17 chalk calls and nearly nothing in the red, which sounds boring until you realize that most managers burn their edge chasing and lose it on reaches. Trey Benson is the one real reach on the card, taken 3.1 rounds early, but in a positionless format a swing at upside in the back half costs you very little. The result is a roster sitting at the 68th percentile with a floor that looks awfully hard to crack, and third in Alpha Centauri is almost certainly a floor, not a ceiling.

sparklekittymagic sits at 82nd percentile and second in the Alpha Centauri division, and the honest explanation is pretty boring: this roster was built correctly, beat by beat, without any single flashy moment carrying the whole thing. The draft logged four values and only three minor reaches against zero major reaches, which is the kind of quiet discipline that shows up in the standings before anyone notices it in the recap thread. Kyle Pitts at TE7 is the clearest example of that philosophy paying off. Taken at 7.04 when his ADP sat at 5.07, sparklekittymagic got a player who quietly became a top-5 tight end last year and grabbed him a round and a half late, a bargain that looks even better given that Pitts has shown he can produce regardless of who lines up behind center in Atlanta. Pair that with Puka Nacua projecting as WR1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 anchoring the top of the lineup, and this is a team whose ceiling was earned one sensible decision at a time.

Saltyksalts didn't win Alpha Centauri's first division rank by swinging for the fences on one marquee pick. They won it by simply not losing rounds. The receiver corps tells the story clearly: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Nico Collins at WR9 give this lineup a top-end that most managers would mortgage their late rounds to acquire, and then Rashee Rice at WR13 just... shows up too, taken at 4.11 when his ADP suggested he'd be gone before that. That's not a heist, that's a manager who knew what the board was about to do and moved accordingly. The same patience shows up in the tight end room, where Colston Loveland at TE3 anchors a group that also includes Jake Ferguson at TE12. Fifteen chalk picks and four genuine values against zero reaches is a draft that never got greedy and never got cute. At the 89th percentile of the field, Saltyksalts isn't a lottery ticket. It's a well-constructed machine.
