CarlosCasas finished 13th percentile in scoring last year, and the draft did nothing to change the trajectory, landing this team at 12th in the Cabela's Ultimate Deer Hunt division and 18th percentile in the tournament. The reach chart tells the whole story: four major reaches, two minor reaches, and not a single steal across the entire board. Omarion Hampton at RB9 is a fine player, but CarlosCasas paid a nearly full round premium to get him, and then turned around and spent three more draft picks on Kaytron Allen, Jaylen Wright, and Mike Washington Jr., three backs ranked RB61, RB68, and RB59 respectively, each pulled anywhere from five to nearly seven rounds ahead of where the market said to take them. That is not a strategy, that is a fixation. The Jalen Hurts and DeVonta Smith stack is the one genuine structural positive here, but Hurts carries an asterisk and Smith projects as WR14, and two connected pieces do not paper over a draft that spent its middle and late rounds chasing a position at prices that would make a reasonable person wince.

Jperri14 did almost everything right on draft day and still landed at 11th in the Cabela's Ultimate Deer Hunt, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether the draft matters at all. Saquon Barkley slid nearly a full round, Khalil Shakir fell more than two, Michael Pittman dropped nearly two more, and Jperri14 was there to collect all of them. The value board basically cooperated. The problem is that "collected value" and "built a winner" are not the same sentence. The projected starters read like a team that won every battle and lost the war: Ashton Jeanty and Barkley are legitimately elite, CeeDee Lamb is CeeDee Lamb, and then the drop-off arrives fast and stays. Rashee Rice at WR13 is fine, but beyond him the supporting cast thins into projections like Pittman at WR44 and Shakir at WR51, players who were worth their prices but are not difference-makers. A 25th-percentile projection does not lie. Jperri14 got fair value for nearly every dollar spent and still came up short.

There is no gentle way to say this: dwilks92 is sitting at 10th in the Cabela's Ultimate Deer Hunt division and the 26th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason to expect a reversal of fortune. The receiver group is genuinely excellent, Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and A.J. Brown at WR8 forming the kind of top-end talent that wins weeks outright, but the backfield is where this thing quietly unravels. J.K. Dobbins projects as the weakest expected starter at RB36, and dwilks92 reached 3.4 rounds early to get him, which is a painful combination of overpayment and underperformance baked into a single pick. The draft as a whole produced zero steals and two major reaches, meaning the roster is already operating near its ceiling with almost no surplus value left to trade on. Jayden Daniels stacking with Terry McLaurin is a clever touch, but clever touches do not fix a foundation that was priced at a premium and delivered at a discount.

Sashtrone enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Cabela's Ultimate Deer Hunt division and in the 27th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism. The team lands four major reaches against just one steal, which is a telling imbalance. Jaxson Dart was taken 1.3 rounds early, J.J. McCarthy a staggering 4.9 rounds early, and T.J. Hockenson 2.2 rounds early, meaning sashtrone burned real draft capital on upside that the consensus never priced in. The redeeming pieces are genuine: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Lamar Jackson at QB3 give this roster a real foundation, and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 and Luther Burden at WR22 are credible contributors. But once you scroll past that core, the projected starters thin out fast, with Kyle Monangai grading as the weakest projected starter at RB33 and late-round reclamation projects like Stefon Diggs and Deebo Samuel asked to carry real weight. The ceiling exists, but the path to it requires every optimistic projection to land at once, and drafts built on reaches rarely survive contact with reality.

JerrySinDWZ enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Cabela's Ultimate Deer Hunt division and projecting at just the 38th percentile of the field, and there is not much in the draft record to suggest a turnaround is coming. The roster has real weapons at the top, with Jahmyr Gibbs projecting as RB1 and De'Von Achane at RB6, but the draft board tells a rougher story everywhere else. The manager reached on tight ends early and often, taking Kenyon Sadiq a full 2.4 rounds ahead of his ADP at 9.01 and David Njoku 3.8 rounds early at 11.01, only to end up with a TE21 and a TE29 as the projected starters at the position. Those are not the kinds of early-round investments that move the needle at the tournament level. The quarterback room, meanwhile, is a collection of reaches on middling options, with Jared Goff projecting at QB16 as the best of the group. Coming off an 11-25 record in 2025, JerrySinDWZ needed a bold, precise draft and instead got an expensive lesson in paying up for depth that never arrives.

kbw612 sits at 47th percentile and seventh in the Cabela's Ultimate Deer Hunt division, which tells you everything and nothing at the same time. This is a roster built on a genuinely elite top end, Puka Nacua at WR1 and Dak Prescott at QB7 and Justin Herbert at QB8 give the lineup a ceiling most managers in this field cannot match, but the margins that separate 7th from 3rd in this division live in the middle and late rounds, and that is where kbw612 gets complicated. Prescott was a reach at 2.10 against an ADP of 3.07, a small overpay that compounds when you consider Dak's injury history has made him one of the more volatile QB7 projections in the field. The two genuine values, Rhamondre Stevenson and Colby Parkinson, are speculative upside plays rather than foundational pieces. Stevenson at RB31 and Parkinson at TE31 can each contribute, but neither moves the needle alone. If Nacua stays healthy and Herbert stays efficient, kbw612 wins close games. If either slips, there is no margin left to absorb it.

Everydayffb sits at the 47th percentile, and that number feels earned in the most unremarkable way possible. The roster has real upside baked into it, James Cook at RB5 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 give the team a legitimate top-end backfield foundation, and the Burrow-Tee Higgins stack adds a layer of ceiling that most mid-table rosters simply cannot match. But Joe Burrow is the catch, as always. When healthy he projects as a QB4 and the offense around him is intact, yet he has missed enormous stretches in three of his last four seasons with injuries that were not minor inconveniences but season-altering catastrophes. That single variable bends the team's ceiling in half if it goes wrong. On the draft side, Everydayffb found genuine value on Breece Hall, Higgins, Davante Adams, and DK Metcalf, all falling past their ADPs, but also burned early capital reaching for Patrick Mahomes a full round-plus ahead of schedule. The margins are right there, visible on both sides. Which ones break in their favor is the only question worth asking.

Big_Red_Machine07 didn't win the draft with one splashy move, they won it by consistently being the sharpest person at the table. The foundation is genuinely elite: Trey McBride at TE2 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 give this roster a top-end advantage that most managers in the field simply cannot match, and McBride arriving at 1.12 when his ADP sat at 1.08 means the value was real, not manufactured. Drake Maye projects as a QB2 and anchors a starting lineup that also includes Chris Olave at WR11 and Emeka Egbuka at WR18, a pair that makes the receiver group quietly dangerous. The one blemish worth noting is Jalen Nailor, a WR61 taken more than four rounds ahead of his ADP, which is the kind of reach that tends to haunt a roster when depth decisions get tight. Still, one overpay on a late-round flier does not undo a draft this well-constructed. Sitting fifth in the Cabela's Ultimate Deer Hunt division and at the 52nd percentile of the field, this team has the talent to climb both.

vcstaff did not chase the highlight-reel pick in the Scott Fish Bowl, and the draft board rewarded that patience at nearly every turn. The foundation is genuinely elite: Josh Allen at QB1 and Colston Loveland at TE3 give this roster a ceiling that most managers in the Cabela's Ultimate Deer Hunt division cannot match, and the Allen-Loveland stack adds a bonus layer of upside when Chicago's offense clicks. The middle of the draft is where the quiet competence really shows. Chase Brown fell nearly a full round past his ADP before vcstaff scooped him at RB11, and Jordan Addison dropped a round and a half before landing at WR43, both exactly the kind of patient value that separates a good draft from a great one. Five values across the roster against just one major reach tells you this manager was not forcing anything. A 53rd-percentile projection is not a flashy number, but it reflects a team built with enough quality at the top and enough depth behind it to make noise as the season unfolds.

Brewtus76 didn't need a home run swing to build one of the more quietly impressive rosters in the Cabela's Ultimate Deer Hunt. The foundation is real: Jonathan Taylor at RB4 came off the board at 2.05 against an ADP of 2.01, a small gap that still represents getting the best running back in the tier without paying a premium, and the receiver group is legitimately strong, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, George Pickens at WR10, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 all projecting as starters. Mike Evans adds a layer of intrigue, moving to San Francisco after injuries held him to eight games last season and snapped an 11-year consecutive 1,000-yard streak, and if he rebounds anywhere close to form as a WR27, that is legitimate late-round value. The draft had more chalk than fireworks, but chalk at the right spots is how you land in the 74th percentile, third in the division, and legitimately in the conversation. Brewtus76 never needed to get lucky. They just kept coming out ahead.

SupaDupaFlex is what happens when a manager trusts the board instead of forcing the draft, and the results speak for themselves: 80th percentile in the field, second in the Cabela's Ultimate Deer Hunt division, and a roster with zero reaches against three good values and a steal. The steal is the story. Justin Jefferson falling to 2.08 when his ADP sat at 1.12 is the kind of gift that reframes an entire draft, and SupaDupaFlex had the discipline to take it without overthinking. From there the lineup builds itself around a WR6 and a TE1 in Brock Bowers, with Nico Collins at WR9 and George Kittle at TE9 giving the manager real top-end firepower to work with. The Kyler Murray and Jefferson stack is a clean bonus on top of an already loaded core. The quarterback group is the one soft spot, with Sam Darnold projected QB21 as the weakest likely starter, but when you are fielding Jefferson, Bowers, Collins, and Kittle, that is not a problem, it is a footnote.

There are drafts that make you nervous and drafts that make you nod, and imalionsfan's 2026 Scott Fish Bowl entry is emphatically the latter. Sitting first in the Cabela's Ultimate Deer Hunt division and in the 91st percentile of the entire field, this roster did not get there by accident. The blueprint is clean: no major reaches anywhere on the board, and nine players taken at genuine value, including Keaton Mitchell and Mark Andrews, who each fell more than two full rounds past their ADPs. You do not stumble into that kind of efficiency twice. The projected starters carry real weight, anchored by Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Drake London at WR7, with Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 and Tyler Warren at TE4 adding layers that most managers would envy. The one honest uncertainty is Dalton Kincaid, whose knee has lingered long enough that Bills GM Brandon Beane was still hedging publicly, but even if Kincaid's availability is limited, the depth here absorbs that concern without breaking a sweat. This is a meticulously constructed team that came to win.
