The Dooleynator's draft was less a strategy than a confession, and the confession reads: I panicked, repeatedly, and expensively. Five major reaches across 22 rounds is not bad luck, it is a pattern, and the pattern here is that this manager spent premium capital chasing quarterbacks who did not need to be chased. Brock Purdy at QB13 was pulled 1.7 rounds early, Bo Nix at QB15 came off the board 2.2 rounds ahead of schedule, and Tyler Shough at QB20 got scooped a staggering 2.7 rounds before the market would have asked. In a positionless format where starters are drawn from the whole roster, burning three early picks on the QB13, QB15, and QB20 means three fewer shots at players who actually move the needle, and it shows. Brock Bowers at TE1 is a genuine anchor, one real value in a draft that produced zero steals, and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 gives the roster a second legitimate piece. But two quality players do not redeem a draft this undisciplined. The Dooleynator sits 12th in the Minecraft division and projects at the 5th percentile of the field, which is exactly where a five-major-reach draft belongs.

jimmyt020 lands at 11th in the Minecraft Division and the 13th percentile of the field, and there is not much in the roster construction to argue with that verdict. The running back group is genuinely impressive on paper, headlined by Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10, but this is a positionless format and the rest of the projected starters are what sink the ship. Matthew Golden projects as WR52 and figures as the weakest starter on the roster, and the receivers surrounding him offer no meaningful upgrade. What makes the outlook bleaker is how the draft unfolded: jimmyt020 burned a fourth-round pick on Jordan Love at QB17, then circled back in the eighth for Malik Willis at QB24, two major reaches at a position that earns exactly zero starting spots in most configurations. Those early-round investments could have addressed the receiver ceiling instead. The running backs are real, the rest is a wish, and right now the ledger does not balance.

There is a particular kind of exhaustion that comes not from a catastrophic collapse but from simply running out of road, and that is where UnicornFP finds itself entering 2026. The roster graded out in the 15th percentile of the field last season, the team finished at 47% wins, and the draft did almost nothing to change the arithmetic: two values against two major reaches, with Trevor Lawrence taken a full 1.6 rounds before his ADP and Davante Adams pulled 1.7 rounds early, both of them arriving at QB10 and WR25 respectively rather than the difference-makers that kind of early investment demands. Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 are legitimately elite, and they will keep the lights on, but the rest of the projected starters thin out quickly, ending with Romeo Doubs at WR53 holding down a lineup spot. Doubs at WR53 is not a depth piece absorbing a bye week, he is the projected floor of a starting unit that needs more than a floor. Dead last in the Minecraft division, and no obvious lever left to pull.

PinkPuppy enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Minecraft division and in the bottom third of the field, and the roster does not make a strong case for optimism. The backfield is the one genuine bright spot, headlined by De'Von Achane at RB6 and Derrick Henry at RB12, both projected starters, both acquired with some draft-day competence. Achane alone fell more than a round past his ADP, a genuine score. But that backfield goodwill evaporates quickly once you scroll to the receiver group, where Ladd McConkey at WR20 is the top option and Makai Lemon at WR40 projects as the weakest starter on the entire roster. That is a thin ceiling. The draft did not help matters elsewhere, with Jalen Hurts taken 1.8 rounds ahead of his ADP at pick 2.02, a premium paid for a QB9 that bleeds value from the sheet. Coming off a 36-percent win rate and 19th-percentile scoring in 2025, PinkPuppy needed a bold offseason. This was not it.

theFFrookie sits eighth in the Minecraft Division and in the 38th percentile of the field, and the draft record does little to inspire a turnaround story. Three major reaches dot the board, including Jacoby Brissett pulled four-plus rounds ahead of his ADP and landing at QB28, and Keenan Allen hauled in four rounds early only to project as WR99. Those are the kinds of swings that need to hit to justify the aggression, and neither did. The saving grace is real: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is a genuine anchor, George Pickens at WR10 gives the roster legitimate top-end pop, and a Prescott-Pickens stack at least puts some ceiling in the room. But Chase and Pickens carrying the load while the quarterback situation behind Dak Prescott thins out to Brissett and Jacoby Brissett-tier depth is a precarious tightrope. There is no obvious lever left to pull, no buried value waiting to emerge, and the path to contention runs directly through a projection model that currently wants nothing to do with this roster.

jemrickwilsonFF sits at 44th percentile and sixth in the Minecraft division, which is exactly where the roster deserves to be: capable enough to beat anyone on a good week, fragile enough to lose to anyone on a bad one. The margins here are almost entirely dictated by the QB situation, which is a problem. Baker Mayfield at QB18 and Cam Ward at QB23 were both taken before their ADPs suggested, with Ward the more alarming case, drafted nearly three full rounds early at 7.07 against an ADP of 10.06. That kind of aggressive overvaluation at a position that won't carry a lineup is the kind of quiet mistake that compounds over a long season. The saving grace is the top of the skill group: Trey McBride at TE2, Tyler Warren at TE4, Harold Fannin at TE6, and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 are genuinely excellent, and Lamb arriving as a mild value at 2.06 softens the sting. This team wins by threading needles, not kicking in doors.

Yaircrespo sits at 44th percentile, a team that will beat the people below it and lose to the people above it unless something breaks in its favor, and the margins are thin enough that drafting matters enormously here. The receiver group is genuinely good, with Nico Collins at WR9, Chris Olave at WR11, Luther Burden at WR22, and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 all projected as starters, and Collins arriving as a mild value after falling nearly a full round past his ADP. The problem is that Yaircrespo mortgaged some of that goodwill at quarterback, reaching 1.5 rounds early on Justin Herbert at QB8 in the second round when the draft board could have delivered something comparable later. Herbert is a fine player, but paying a premium for QB8 in a positionless format is the kind of quiet inefficiency that doesn't announce itself until week eleven. The floor here is comfortable. The ceiling depends entirely on whether Joe Burrow and that receiver core run hot at the same time, and in a tournament where 44th percentile usually means a polite early exit, comfortable is not quite enough.

KurtKnwsBest finished 2025 in the 16th percentile and came back swinging, which means either something clicked or the lesson just took a full season to land. The evidence points toward clicked. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this roster a top-end foundation that most managers in the field would trade their draft capital for, and Rashee Rice at WR13 and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 round out a starting core that sits comfortably above the tournament median. The draft board, though, keeps raising its hand. Jaxson Dart was taken two full rounds before his ADP and lands as a projected QB11, which is a reach that paid off in relative terms but still leaves the position as the clearest soft spot in the lineup. The interesting tell is that Kurt's major reaches were both at quarterback, not at the skill positions carrying this roster. That suggests the conviction was deliberate and

directional, not scattered. A team sitting 49th percentile overall has room to climb if the skill position starters perform to projection, and right now that ceiling looks real.

Liam22 didn't need a single splashy moment to build one of the better rosters in the Minecraft division. The draft was a slow, methodical accumulation of value, the kind where the board keeps falling your way round after round. Justin Jefferson at WR6 came off the board at pick 2.04 when his ADP sat a full round earlier, a quiet coup that set the tone. Then the running game materialized the same way: Omarion Hampton at RB9, Jeremiyah Love at RB13, Breece Hall at RB14, and Cam Skattebo at RB20 all slid past their ADPs and into Liam22's lap. Quinshon Judkins, projected RB22, adds another layer, and a fractured fibula that cut short his 2025 campaign appears to be healing on schedule for Cleveland's training camp. The one eyebrow worth raising is the Patrick Mahomes reach at pick 3.09 when his ADP was closer to round five, but at QB12 he is still a functional starter. At the 76th percentile tournament-wide and fourth in the division, this team isn't loud, it's just good.

Mikes Lava Chicken didn't swing for the fences and miss, they just kept hitting singles into gaps nobody else was covering, and somehow looked up to find themselves in the top 10 percent of the field. The engine here is a receiving corps that reads like a fever dream: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, A.J. Brown at WR8, and Malik Nabers at WR12 all projected to start, with Nabers arriving as genuine value after sliding nearly a full round past his ADP. Jonathan Taylor, the RB4, also fell into Mike's lap at pick 2.08 despite an ADP that had him going seventh overall at the position. Five values across the draft, zero major reaches, and a Jared Goff and Jameson Williams stack that gives the team a coordinated ceiling play on top of an already-loaded foundation. Third in the Minecraft Division is where this roster currently sits, but the draft efficiency underneath those standings suggests that number has more room to move upward than it does to backslide.

DanBrownNFL sits at 92nd percentile in the field and second in the Minecraft division, and the draft record explains exactly why: one steal, five values, thirteen chalk, and just a single minor reach across the entire board. That is not luck, that is discipline. The centerpiece is a wide receiver group that reads like a highlight reel, with Puka Nacua projecting as WR1, Drake London at WR7, and Garrett Wilson, Tee Higgins, and Mike Evans all contributing as projected starters. London alone was worth the price of admission, sliding to pick 2.11 despite an ADP of 2.06, and Courtland Sutton arriving at 11.02 when the field had him valued a full two-plus rounds earlier is the kind of find that wins tournaments in November. Caleb Williams at QB6 gives the team a competent pivot at the position, and Brenton Strange at TE17 was squeezed out at a round of discount. The weakest projected starter on this roster is Michael Pittman at WR44. That is not a criticism. That is a testament to how well this draft went.

DrRoto enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting at the top of the Minecraft Division and in the 93rd percentile of the field, and the draft log explains exactly why. This was not a roster built on one lightning-bolt moment. It was assembled pick by pick, with the advantages stacking quietly until the whole thing looked inevitable. James Cook landed at RB5 nearly a full round after his ADP suggested he would, and Chase Brown followed a round and a half later than expected, giving DrRoto a backfield foundation that most managers would have had to reach for. Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 slid more than a round past his number as well, arriving at a price that felt almost rude. Layer in Josh Allen at QB1 stacking with D.J. Moore, and the lineup has a ceiling that the 93rd-percentile projection reflects. The major reaches on J.J. McCarthy and Darnell Washington are real, but they arrive late enough in the draft that they cost opportunity more than they cost damage. After a 26th-percentile finish in 2025, DrRoto came back with a sharper pencil.
