McCarthy and Cam Ward has left little room for error. Morale is low, as the once-promising fantasy powerhouse now grapples with the cold reality of a challenging campaign ahead.

As the 2025 fantasy football season looms on the horizon, the PurpleRubes find themselves facing an uphill battle. Ranked ninth in their division and languishing in the 16th percentile overall, the team is grappling with significant challenges. While boasting a promising stable of running backs led by Bijan Robinson, Jonathan Taylor, and the hopeful upside of Jaylen Warren and Travis Etienne, the rest of the roster reveals glaring weaknesses. The receiving corps is headlined by A.J. Brown, a solid but solitary standout amidst lackluster performances from Ricky Pearsall and Rashod Bateman, who despite being drafted later than expected, may struggle to deliver consistent output. Compounding matters, Kyle Pitts at tight end, acquired earlier than his projected value, remains a crucial yet precarious cog in their offensive machine. The quarterback position, with Baker Mayfield taken well

ahead of his ADP, adds another layer of uncertainty, and while the stack with Caleb Williams provides a glimmer of synergy, it's unlikely to bridge the gap created by reaching too early for players like Tyler Warren and Jalen Royals. As the PurpleRubes brace for the season ahead, the specter of underperformance looms large, casting doubt over their ability to rise from their current standings.
