With a small stack bonus from pairing Trevor Lawrence with Brian Thomas Jr., the team is aiming for synergy that could propel them upward in the rankings. As the season unfolds, much will depend on whether the strong passing game can compensate for the potential weaknesses in the running game and tight end positions. The hope is that the calculated risks taken in the draft pay off, pushing HawksHeroes into a more prominent spot in the division and beyond.






