

However, the burden of expectations weighs heavily on Nico Collins and Tee Higgins, as the wide receiver core tries to bolster its ranks amid concerns over Jayden Higgins, who is projected as a starter despite being a

clear weak link. Strategic draft moves could have been more measured, as reaching for players like Burrow, Maye, and others may yet come back to haunt them. A notable, albeit small, silver lining exists with the Joe Burrow and Tee Higgins connection, but overall, robjames824 must navigate a rocky road if they are to rise above their middling placement and avoid another year of underperformance.




