As the 2025 fantasy football season looms, the outlook for RetiredFFPodGuy looks anything but promising. After riding high last year with a respectable finish, the team now finds itself struggling with an 11th place rank in their division and languishing in the 17th percentile overall. Despite boasting a decent quarterback lineup led by Jayden Daniels and a shaky supporting cast with Trevor Lawrence and Anthony Richardson, the team's other positions leave much to be desired. The tight end situation is particularly grim, with Kyle Pitts failing to perform as hoped, ranking only 17th. In the wide receiver department, Terry McLaurin barely cracks the top 20, while Jayden Higgins is a glaring weak link as a projected starter, dragging down their divisional rank to 11th. Concerns over the roster's depth and consistency are exacerbated by questionable draft decisions, including

reaching on players like Trevor Lawrence and Cam Skattebo. Even the occasional value picks can't offset the inexplicable risk-taking, leaving this youthful squad, with an average player age of just 24.5, needing a miracle to escape mediocrity.
