There is no charitable read on the Mecha Dragon draft, and the numbers do not bother pretending otherwise. The roster sits dead last in the Mega Man II division and in the first percentile of the entire field, which is the kind of distinction that follows you home. The blueprint here was apparently to hoard running backs and figure out the rest later: Jonathan Taylor, Ashton Jeanty, Breece Hall, Cam Skattebo, Bucky Irving, and Quinshon Judkins are all projected starters, and the manager reached on three of them, most aggressively grabbing Irving three-plus rounds ahead of consensus. That aggression crowded out everything else. The receiver corps tops out at Jauan Jennings at WR63, and the quarterback situation is Malik Willis at QB24, a man who earned a starting job in Miami by doing no more than not embarrassing himself in Green Bay. Willis might work as a streaming option in a format this flexible. As the anchor of a QB room with no credible backup plan, he is a prayer dressed up as a strategy.

Victorious Secret did almost everything right on draft day and still landed at 15th percentile in the field, which is the kind of outcome that makes you feel sorry for someone who clearly knows what they are doing. The value hunting was real: Jordan Love fell nearly three full rounds before this team grabbed him at 10.02, and Adonai Mitchell slid 2.4 rounds before getting scooped at 18.02. Those are genuine wins. The problem is that when you zoom out, the top of the roster simply does not project well enough to compete. DeVonta Smith at WR14 is the best receiver on the board, and the projected starter behind him is Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47, which is a significant drop-off no amount of late-round bargain hunting can paper over. Kyle Pitts, Travis Kelce, and Mark Andrews give this team a strong TE group on paper, but Pitts was reached 1.7 rounds early and Kelce checks in at TE10, not the force multiplier this roster needs. Victorious Secret played smart and landed in 11th in Mega Man II anyway, proof that the draft can grade you on a curve and still fail you.

Heat Man sits 10th in the Mega Man II division and projects in just the 17th percentile of the field, and the draft record does not offer much reason for optimism. The manager found genuine value in players like Zay Flowers (WR16) and Brian Thomas Jr. (WR31), both sliding past their ADPs, but that thrift was largely canceled out by four major reaches, most damagingly Romeo Doubs (WR53), grabbed nearly three rounds early, and Trey Benson (RB64), taken almost five rounds before the market agreed. The result is a roster built around a genuinely impressive group of receivers, led by A.J. Brown (WR8) and Nico Collins (WR9), but one that projects weakly enough overall to land near the bottom of the division anyway. When your projected weakest starter is Matthew Golden (WR52) and your most reliable non-receiver contributors grade out as Jayden Daniels (QB5) on the positive side and a thin cluster of running backs in the RB43-to-RB64 range on the other, you are not hiding much firepower in reserve. The ceiling is visible and it may not be high enough.

There is a particular kind of exhaustion that comes not from disaster but from diminishing returns, and that is the forecast for Wood Man in 2026. The backfield is legitimately loaded on paper, with Jahmyr Gibbs (RB1), Saquon Barkley (RB8), and Kenneth Walker III (RB10) forming a headlining group that would make most managers envious. But the receiver corps grades out weak, with D.J. Moore (WR26) as the best option, and the Barkley situation quietly undermines the math further: coming off a down 2025 and entering his age-29 season with Philadelphia reportedly looking to reduce his workload, the floor that made him a cornerstone piece has crept noticeably lower. Patrick Mahomes (QB12) helps at the margins, but drafting Mahomes a round late does not paper over a projected finish of 9th in the Mega Man II division and 29th percentile in the field. The levers are visible. None of them move the needle enough.

Last year, sdygos finished in the 83rd percentile, a genuinely impressive run in the Scott Fish Bowl. This year's roster projects at just the 29th percentile, ranking eighth in the Mega Man II division, and the gap between those two numbers is the whole story. The engine of that 2025 success is not visible in this projection, and the draft did not rebuild it cleanly. The biggest investment of early capital went into the tight end group, with George Kittle taken at TE9 three rounds ahead of his ADP and Sam LaPorta taken at TE8 more than two rounds early, a double reach that pulled resources away from the top of the lineup before it ever got started. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 is the one genuinely elite projected starter, and Chris Olave at WR11 was a real value, but above the skill positions sits a quarterback group projecting no better than Cam Ward at QB23. When your QB room is the ceiling, the distance between who sdygos was and who they are becomes very difficult to close.

BlackDabbath enters 2026 sitting seventh in the Mega Man II division and projected at just the 42nd percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism. The most glaring self-inflicted wound is J.K. Dobbins, reached four full rounds before his ADP to land an RB36, a gamble that would look questionable even if Dobbins grades out as a reliable contributor rather than a borderline starter. Meanwhile, Caleb Williams fell into the lap of this roster two rounds past his ADP, which looks like fortune on paper, but a QB6 projection in a positionless format only matters if the rest of the roster can carry weight around him. The receiver group does genuine work, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba, Malik Nabers, and Jaylen Waddle all projecting as starters, yet the floor keeps dropping, bottoming out with Jayden Higgins as the projected weakest starter at WR54. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, no buried treasure waiting to surface. This roster is what it is, and what it is probably is not enough.

katier4705 didn't build this roster with one flashy swing. They built it the way good drafters actually win, by coming out ahead on pick after pick until the advantages stacked up into something real. The anchor is Puka Nacua at WR1, landed at 1.05 when his ADP sat at 1.01, essentially market value, but locking in the top receiver in the field is its own reward. From there, Drake London at WR7, Tee Higgins at WR19, Davante Adams at WR25, and Mike Evans at WR27 form a projected starting group that just keeps delivering quality. Baker Mayfield fell a full round past his ADP and slots in as a serviceable QB18 option. The one blemish worth noting is James Conner, reached 4.6 rounds early and projecting as RB56, which is a lot of draft capital spent on a back that may not return it. But that's a single stumble in an otherwise disciplined exercise. Sitting 56th percentile in the field with upside to climb, this team looks like it was assembled by someone who actually had a plan and stuck to it.

Big Fish didn't make any single move that will dominate the offseason highlight reel, but round after round this roster quietly came out ahead. The headliner is Lamar Jackson, a QB3 projection snagged almost a full round after his average draft position, paired with Trevor Lawrence, who fell more than two rounds before Big Fish grabbed him at 7.01 to slot in as QB10. That's two legitimate quarterback options acquired at a collective discount, which frees up capital elsewhere. The running back group is where the depth really accumulates, with Bijan Robinson projecting as RB2 and Chase Brown and Derrick Henry both logging as projected starters alongside him, Henry coming in nearly a round after his ADP. The receiver group is thinner on projected rank, but in a positionless format that barely registers when the top of the roster looks like this. A 58 percent win rate and 78th percentile scoring in 2025 suggest this isn't a team figuring things out. Big Fish is already running, and the 2026 draft just gave them more room.

rstrauss21 lands at 78th percentile in the Scott Fish Bowl field, fourth in Mega Man II, and the draft sheet that produced it looks like it should not have worked. Five minor reaches, two major reaches, zero steals. The board said no repeatedly, and rstrauss21 kept nodding yes anyway. The results, though, are hard to argue with. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 slid nearly a full round past his ADP and rstrauss21 was there to collect him. Terry McLaurin came almost two rounds late and landed in the same cart. Those are the kind of windfalls that make a roster, and they offset the conviction calls elsewhere. The concerning one is RJ Harvey, pulled two rounds ahead of consensus and now facing a Denver backfield where Jonah Coleman has joined JK Dobbins to further crowd what was already an unfriendly committee situation. Harvey's path to volume looks narrower by the month. But the Josh Allen anchor, the Jared Goff and St. Brown stack, and Harold Fannin at TE6 give this team a real ceiling. rstrauss21 reached for things and mostly got them. That is either a skill or a story, and this season will sort out which.

fishmandoo did not stumble into 85th percentile. This roster was constructed with the kind of patience and precision that makes other managers feel embarrassed about their own draft boards. The receiver group alone tells the whole story: Justin Jefferson at WR6, George Pickens at WR10, Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, and Rome Odunze at WR30, all projected starters, and Pickens and Odunze both arrived as genuine value plays, falling 0.7 and 1.3 rounds past their respective ADPs. Then there is the quarterback situation, which is where fishmandoo's discipline really announces itself. Dak Prescott, a QB7, slid to pick 5.09 when his ADP sat at 3.07, and the manager was right there waiting. The Prescott-to-Pickens and Prescott-to-Jake Ferguson stacks add another layer of upside that most teams cannot manufacture. No major reaches anywhere on the board, seven players taken at clear value, and a starting lineup that projects with almost nothing to apologize for. Third in the division is a ceiling that undersells what this team is capable of doing.

There are louder rosters in the Scott Fish Bowl's Mega Man II division, but bnel612 may have built the smartest one. The foundation is a tight end group that borders on unfair: Brock Bowers at TE1, Colston Loveland at TE3, and Tyler Warren at TE4 project as three of the four best tight ends in the tournament, and bnel612 holds all of them. That kind of positional equity doesn't happen by accident, and neither does landing Justin Herbert at QB8 a full three rounds past his ADP, giving this roster legitimate upside at the position that matters most in big weeks. Pair Herbert with his stack partner Ladd McConkey, a projected WR20 starter, and the ceiling climbs further. The draft was not flashy, producing mostly chalk with a handful of well-timed values, but that quiet efficiency is exactly the point. Sitting second in the division and in the 94th percentile of the field, bnel612 looks less like a team that got lucky and more like one that just kept doing the math correctly.

nudejogger sits atop the Mega Man II division and in the 99th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record explains exactly why: seven values, one steal, and barely a reach in sight. The foundation is airtight. Joe Burrow at QB4 paired with Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 gives this team a stacked, high-ceiling core before you even get to the depth, and Burrow was still sitting there at pick 2.10 despite an ADP of 2.05, a clean win right at the top of the draft. Then there is Luther Burden at WR22, secured 1.6 rounds after his ADP, entering 2026 as the kind of ascending talent that makes late-draft values dangerous. Ben Johnson spent training camp comparing Burden to Amon-Ra St. Brown, and the second-half snap data from 2025 backs the hype more than it strains it. Rashee Rice at WR13 rounds out a starting group where the weakest projected contributor is Josh Downs at WR46. That is not a flaw. That is a draft that went right.
