DiamondMikeUSA did almost everything right on draft day. Chase Brown fell nearly a full round past his ADP before being scooped at 4.04. Mike Evans and Jayden Reed each slid a round and got grabbed. Travis Hunter tumbled more than three full rounds and landed right in this roster. The draft grades out well on paper, and yet here sits a team projected 12th in the NHL94 division and in the 11th percentile of the field, which is the specific kind of outcome that makes fantasy football feel genuinely unkind. The issue is that doing the value game correctly only pays off if the players themselves perform, and this group is thin at the top where it counts most. Jalen Hurts enters 2026 without A.J. Brown after that offseason trade to New England, meaning the passing game that propped up his fantasy ceiling now faces real questions, and a Hurts regression would hollow out a starting lineup that was already leaning on projections that feel fragile. DiamondMikeUSA shopped smart. The shelves just did not have much on them.

MartyE enters 2026 ranked 11th in the NHL94 division and sitting at just the 23rd percentile of the field, and there is not much in the roster construction to suggest that number is wrong. The foundation is real: Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, Colston Loveland slots in at TE3, and the supporting cast has genuine depth. But this is a positionless format, and what ultimately wins weeks is the quality of your projected starters top to bottom, and that is where the wheels come off. The quarterback situation is genuinely grim, with Kyler Murray at QB19 and Sam Darnold at QB21 leading the charge, and Jadarian Price, the identified weakest projected starter at RB26, was taken a full 2.7 rounds ahead of his ADP. That is not a calculated gamble on upside, that is paying a premium for a question mark. After a 2025 campaign that produced a 5-31 record and landed in the 15th percentile of scoring, MartyE needed a clean reset. This draft did not deliver one.

Last year NewClearHarley finished in the 83rd percentile, and the roster sitting in front of us right now is doing its best to make that feel like ancient history. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is a genuine anchor, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 gives this team a second piece worth believing in, but the drop-off from those two projected starters to the rest of the lineup is where the trouble lives. George Kittle, projected TE9, is the kind of player who can reshape a season when healthy, but he is coming off an Achilles tear and his availability for Week 1 is genuinely uncertain, which means the team is essentially betting on a question mark to fill what should be a position of strength. Jared Goff at QB16 was already a modest return for a second-round-equivalent investment, and the draft log shows zero steals and two major reaches against no values, which is the profile of a team that paid full price for a discount result. The 2025 version of this roster earned its reputation. The 2026 version is living off it.

PhilosopherKing enters 2026 sitting ninth in the NHL94 division and at just the 35th percentile of the field, and the draft log offers little reason for optimism. The top of the roster is legitimate, CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 give this team a ceiling, and the Dak Prescott and Lamb stack adds a nice upside lever on big weeks. But the draft that built this roster leaned heavily on wishful thinking, logging three major reaches that now look like anchor weight. RJ Harvey at RB28 was taken more than two rounds early, Tyler Allgeier at RB46 came off the board over three rounds ahead of schedule, and Michael Penix Jr. grades out as a QB33 after being drafted like a premium asset. Three major reaches in a single draft is not bad luck, it is a pattern, and the resulting roster grades out near the bottom of the division because of it. Lamb and Jefferson keep the floor from caving entirely, but there is no obvious move left to close the gap.

Andrix enters 2026 ranked eighth in the NHL94 division and sitting at just the 37th percentile of the field, and the roster profile does not make a compelling case for a reversal of fortune. The receiver group is genuinely impressive, headlined by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Nico Collins at WR9, but that strength runs directly into a quarterback situation that could quietly strangle the whole operation. Bo Nix projects as a QB15, which is a middling asset at best, and the depth behind him is Ty Simpson at QB36, a player Andrix reached on by nearly five rounds. That is not a contingency plan, that is a prayer. The draft itself produced no steals and two major reaches, and last year's 42 percent win rate shows this is not a team in temporary decline waiting to bounce back. With Ashton Jeanty at RB7 providing genuine star-level production, Andrix is not without hope, but hope is doing a lot of heavy lifting on a roster with no obvious lever left to pull.

Minnoman3 enters 2026 sitting seventh in the NHL94 division and projecting around the 40th percentile of the field, and the draft record does not offer much reason for optimism. The foundation is real enough: Josh Allen at QB1 anchors the roster, and Saquon Barkley at RB8 and A.J. Brown at WR8 give this team legitimate top-end talent. But the draft decisions underneath those stars are where the wheels come loose. Reaching 1.7 rounds early for Javonte Williams, who projects as RB17, is the kind of move that costs you depth picks, and then pulling Dallas Goedert nearly two and a half rounds before his ADP for a TE15 projection compounds the damage. The projected weakest starter, KC Concepcion at WR50, was actually the draft's lone steal, which tells you something about the ceiling of the supporting cast. With a 36th-percentile scoring finish in 2025 already in the rearview, Minnoman3 looks less like a team on the rise and more like one still paying for the same habits.

Mgoess sits at 41st percentile heading into 2026, which is about as middle-of-the-road as a roster can get without actually being boring. The ceiling is real: Puka Nacua at WR1 is a genuine difference-maker, Tyler Warren (TE4) and Sam LaPorta (TE8) give this team one of the stronger tight end combinations in the field, and Caleb Williams (QB6) was a reach at 2.08 but the upside justifies the anxiety. The floor, though, is where the questions live. Williams was taken nearly a full round before his ADP, and Josh Jacobs at RB16 cost a premium too, drafted 1.3 rounds early. That is two of the most important roster spots carrying draft-day debt. Throw in Tyler Shough (QB20) as the contingency, a 27-year-old whose Year 2 leap is genuinely uncertain despite real weapons in New Orleans, and you start to feel the tightrope. This team went 15-21 last season and scored in the 35th percentile. Nothing here screams that the margins have shifted decisively in their favor.

Last year was a disaster for thorku, a 7-29 record and a finish in the bottom 6 percent of scoring that left little to build on. The 2026 roster looks like a genuine correction. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give this team a pair of elite projected starters, and the supporting cast around them, including Rico Dowdle at RB32 and George Pickens at WR10, keeps the floor from cratering. The draft theft that stands out most is Jameson Williams, projected WR21, grabbed at 7.08 when his ADP sat at 5.01, a two-and-a-half-round discount on a receiver who projects as a genuine starter. Kyle Pitts at TE7 adds another projected difference-maker. The one nagging concern is the reach on J.J. McCarthy, taken nearly seven and a half rounds before his ADP, a speculative swing that could cost thorku late-draft depth if McCarthy disappoints. Still, this roster projects to the 61st percentile of the field. After last season, that is not a ceiling to apologize for, it is a comeback.

BaldEagle22 drafted like someone who had done their homework and then actually showed up to the exam. The headliners are legitimately elite: Brock Bowers at TE1 and Jayden Daniels at QB5 give this roster a ceiling that most managers in this field are chasing, not owning. But the hook here is the value extraction in the middle rounds. Malik Nabers fell nearly two full rounds past his ADP, and BaldEagle22 was right there waiting. Trevor Lawrence, projected at QB10, slid even further, landing in round six despite a career year that featured 4,000 passing yards, nearly 30 touchdowns through the air, and nine more on the ground, the kind of floor-raising performance that makes Lawrence genuinely dangerous as a streaming piece behind Daniels. Across the entire draft, BaldEagle22 logged two steals, four values, and zero major reaches. That is not luck, that is discipline. Division rank of fourth and a 69th percentile tournament projection are the floor here, not the ceiling, and this roster has the construction to climb.

AndyMac222 reached on seven players in this draft, and the roster looks better for it. The three major reaches tell the story most clearly: Isaiah Likely at TE13 went six rounds before his ADP suggested he would, Chuba Hubbard at RB29 went two rounds early, and Emanuel Wilson at RB69 was taken more than five rounds ahead of consensus. On paper, those are the picks that get you laughed out of the draft recap. In practice, they fill out a team that sits third in the division and clears the 71st percentile of the field. The foundation that makes those swings survivable is legitimate: Bijan Robinson at RB2 anchors the whole operation, Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and Drake London at WR7 give the lineup genuine upside, and the Jaxson Dart and Likely stack adds a layer of week-winning correlation. AndyMac222 did not get here by waiting for value to fall. They decided what they wanted and went and took it, and when you look at the projected starters, it is pretty hard to argue with the results.

SkolBretheim didn't win the draft with one thunderclap moment. They won it pick by pick, round by round, in the quiet way that actually holds up over a long tournament. The cornerstone is Amon-Ra St. Brown, a WR4 projection taken at 2.02 when his ADP sat at 1.10, a full round of free value on a player who projects as one of the best at his position in the field. From there, the roster just kept accumulating: Tee Higgins at WR19, Carnell Tate at WR29, Courtland Sutton at WR37, all taken later than the market expected them to go. Then Joe Burrow fell a round and a half past his ADP into SkolBretheim's lap at 3.11, landing the QB4 projection alongside Higgins as a ready-made stack. Five values and a major value across a single draft is not luck, it's positioning, and it shows up in the division ranking: second, at the 82nd tournament percentile. This roster isn't built on a gamble. It's built on the math being right more often than wrong.

Ditclapp1 didn't win the draft on one big swing. They won it on volume and timing, picking ahead of the market often enough that it looks less like luck and more like a plan. Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 came 1.5 rounds after his ADP suggested he'd go. Christian Watson, projected WR28, slid nearly a round and a half into Ditclapp1's lap. Chris Godwin fell almost three full rounds to land at WR38, which in a positionless format is not a consolation prize, it's a gift. Anchor those receivers to a Patrick Mahomes and Rashee Rice stack and the upside starts to feel real, though Rice remains genuinely difficult to trust given his legal situation and a knee procedure that will keep him sidelined well into the season. If Rice gets healthy and stays on the field, he's still a difference maker and that stack becomes one of the most dangerous in the division. The team sits first in the NHL94 division and in the 91st percentile of the field. That's not a fluke draft. That's a good one.
