There is no kind way to frame what eregis27 did in this draft, so let's not try. The headline number is five major reaches across the roster, a figure that does not suggest aggressive strategy so much as a manager bidding against himself in an empty room. Kenneth Walker III at RB10 cost a pick nearly a full round early, Kyren Williams at RB15 went more than a round ahead of schedule, and RJ Harvey at RB28 was yanked off the board nearly three rounds before the market said to. That kind of volume reaching does not build upside, it destroys depth, and the downstream evidence is right there in the weakest projected starter slot: Daniel Jones, QB25, holding down the back end of a starting lineup. The one genuine value on the board was Daniel Jones himself, taken slightly after his ADP, which means eregis27's most efficient pick was the player projecting as the 25th-best quarterback in the tournament. Last in the division, first percentile in the field. The roster is not unlucky. It is the draft, faithfully rendered.

BlondeAmbition28 finished 23rd percentile in scoring last season and the 2026 roster offers little reason to expect a different verdict. The team grades out 11th in the Tony Hawk Pro Skater 2 division and sits at the 11th tournament percentile, which is about as far from a turnaround story as you can get. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Tyler Warren at TE4 are genuine pillars, and the Jared Goff to Amon-Ra St. Brown stack gives the lineup a real ceiling on any given week. But beneath those names, the floor drops fast. Goff himself was a major reach, taken more than two rounds ahead of his QB16 projection, and J.K. Dobbins, the projected weakest starter at RB36, was also burned well before his value. The draft produced zero steals and zero values across 19 picks, meaning BlondeAmbition28 had every chance to build a cushion and instead paid market price or above for a roster that grades near the bottom. Taylor and Warren are doing their part. The roster construction is not.

KentW finished in the 82nd percentile last season and somehow turned that into a 2026 roster sitting at 20th percentile and tenth in the Tony Hawk Pro Skater 2 division, which is either a masterclass in regression or a cautionary tale about what happens when reputation shops at a different store than results. The core of the problem is not hard to locate: the receiver group tops out at Jalen Coker at WR55, Denzel Boston at WR58, and Jalen McMillan at WR59, a collection of names that inspires roughly the same confidence as a weather forecast in March. Compounding that, KentW burned his first-round pick on Jayden Daniels at pick 1.10, a reach of over a full round in a positionless format where QB scarcity barely registers as a concern. James Cook at RB5 and Harold Fannin at TE6 are genuinely excellent, and Jeremiyah Love at RB13 and Bucky Irving at RB21 keep the floor elevated, but the gap between what this team was and what the projections say it is now is wide enough that Cook and Fannin cannot close it alone.

Bower of Christ Compels U arrives in the Tony Hawk Pro Skater 2 division sitting ninth and projecting at just the 38th percentile of the field, and the draft record does little to inspire confidence. The manager spent four major reaches on late-depth running backs, pulling Jacory Croskey-Merritt, Isiah Pacheco, Emmett Johnson, and Demond Claiborne each between three and four and a half rounds ahead of consensus, and none of them grades higher than RB40. That is a lot of draft capital chasing thin upside when the roster's real strengths already existed elsewhere. Brock Bowers at TE1 is genuinely elite, and Justin Jefferson at WR6 was the one draft-day gift, landing nearly a full round past his ADP. But Jefferson's current quarterback, Kyler Murray, projects as a QB19, and Brock Purdy, while better at QB13, pairs with George Kittle rather than with Jefferson, so the synergies feel misaligned. This roster has real pillars and then a long drop-off, and with the draft capital already spent, there is no obvious fix coming.

deliciousgrizzly arrives in the Tony Hawk Pro Skater 2 division sitting eighth and projecting at just the 41st percentile of the field, and the draft log does not offer much comfort. The roster has real anchors: Christian McCaffrey grades out as RB3, Trey McBride lands at TE2, and a string of tight ends behind him keeps the positional group genuinely strong. But the draft was riddled with impatience, and that is where this team starts bleeding. Matthew Stafford, a QB14, was taken a full 2.2 rounds before his ADP, while Emanuel Wilson, projecting as RB69, was yanked off the board 6.2 rounds early. Those are not bold bets, those are capital spent chasing upside that the projections simply do not support. McCaffrey and McBride give deliciousgrizzly a floor, but with no steals in the draft, no proven secondary scorer to lean on, and a roster that already grades near the bottom of the division, the margin for error this season is essentially zero.

pfitzsimmons85 sits at the 47th percentile and seventh in the Tony Hawk Pro Skater 2 division, which means every week is a coin flip dressed up as a football game. The ceiling here is genuinely attractive: Lamar Jackson at QB3 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 give the roster two players capable of winning a matchup on their own, and Rashee Rice at WR13 and Jameson Williams at WR21 push the projected starting group into territory that can hang with anyone in the field. The problem is that the margin between hanging with anyone and losing to everyone is razor thin at this tier, and pfitzsimmons85 offers almost no cushion. Wan'Dale Robinson projects as the weakest starter at WR47, which is fine until it isn't, and the draft was largely chalk with just one steal and three values, so there is not much hidden upside waiting to reveal itself. After a dominant 2025, the regression question is real. Jackson and Lamb need to perform at or near projection, because this roster does not have the depth to survive either one of them falling short.

Barrel of McConkeys finished 2025 in the 86th percentile and now sits at 48th, which tells you everything about how thin the margin is between a good team and a great one. The core is legitimately impressive: Josh Allen at QB1 anchors the roster, Saquon Barkley projects as RB8, and Nico Collins comes in at WR9, so when this lineup fires, it fires. The uncertainty creeps in at the edges. Rhamondre Stevenson projects as the weakest projected starter at RB31, and the late-round dart-throws raise some eyebrows, with Dontayvion Wicks and Skyler Bell reached a combined 12.6 rounds ahead of their ADPs, which is the kind of aggressive swing that either looks visionary or quietly drains weekly points. The draft leaned chalk heavily, offering little in the way of upside bets that paid off relative to cost. Sixth in the Tony Hawk Pro Skater 2 division feels about right: this roster can beat anyone on a good week and lose to anyone if Stevenson's production stalls and those late swings come up empty.

BigKato's 2026 roster didn't get built on one flashy moment, it got built on a draft that kept quietly winning exchanges. The four good values tell the story: Patrick Mahomes at QB12 slipping more than a round past his ADP, Sam Darnold at QB21 falling nearly two full rounds, Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31 and Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 both drifting past their price tags in rounds eight and nine. None of those picks individually changes the conversation, but together they represent a manager who was consistently getting more than he paid for while the rest of the room wasn't noticing. Anchor the whole thing with Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and a Mahomes-Travis Kelce stack, and BigKato has genuine upside built on a real foundation. A division rank of fifth keeps this firmly in cautious territory, but last year's 85th-percentile scoring output proves this team can produce, and this draft suggests 2026 should look similar or better.

Don's roster landed at the 80th percentile in the Scott Fish Bowl field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: no major reaches, no dramatic swings, just four values riding alongside fifteen chalk picks that consistently delivered above expectation. Joe Burrow at QB4 and Bijan Robinson at RB2 form a foundation that most managers in the Tony Hawk Pro Skater 2 division would trade for without hesitation, and the value picks quietly make the middle of this roster punching above its draft slot. Chris Olave fell nearly a full round past his ADP before Don scooped him up at WR11, and Ryan Flournoy landed two and a half rounds late. The one genuine question mark is Parker Washington, projected as the weakest starter at WR35. Washington improbably led Jacksonville in targets and receiving yards last season despite playing behind Brian Thomas Jr. and Travis Hunter on the depth chart, and whether that production holds, or whether the Jaguars simply allow it to hold, is unresolved. That uncertainty is real, but it lives at the margins of a roster that is otherwise very comfortably built.

Waffle Bar didn't build this roster on one splashy bet. They built it pick by pick, and the cumulative effect is a team sitting at the 83rd percentile with a backfield that could carry entire months on its own. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, Ashton Jeanty at RB7, and Chase Brown at RB11 are all projected starters, and that kind of top-end depth means Waffle Bar enters most weeks already ahead on the math. The wide receiver group reinforces the same story. Luther Burden fell nearly two full rounds past his ADP before Waffle Bar scooped him at WR22, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and Zay Flowers at WR16 give the manager options that most rosters in the division simply don't have. The draft wasn't flashy, just disciplined: mostly chalk with a couple of genuine values buried in the middle rounds. Third in the division and holding last season's 91st-percentile scoring as proof of concept, Waffle Bar looks like the team that did the quiet work and ended up with something worth talking about.

Sucks to Shough didn't reshape this draft with one flashy move, they just kept coming out ahead of the board, pick after pick. The centerpiece of that pattern is A.J. Brown, a WR8 who fell nearly two full rounds past his ADP and landed at 4.07, the kind of gift that makes the rest of a draft feel easier. From there, Jaxson Smith-Njigba at WR3 and George Pickens at WR10 give this team a top end that most managers would build an entire strategy around, and De'Von Achane at RB6 keeps the pressure on. Jaxson Dart, projected at QB11, came a round late. Brenton Strange and Khalil Shakir each fell over a round and a half past their ADPs. The one real stumble was Chuba Hubbard, reached nearly two and a half rounds early, but that kind of controlled aggression reads more like a manager who knew what they wanted than one who panicked. The result is a roster sitting second in the Tony Hawk Pro Skater 2 division and in the 88th percentile of the field, built not on luck but on a draft that quietly won more exchanges than it lost.

Sitting at 98th percentile and first in the Tony Hawk Pro Skater 2 division, benwkoll's roster reads like a draft clinic. The receiver group is the engine: Puka Nacua at WR1, Drake London at WR7, Emeka Egbuka at WR18, and Tee Higgins at WR19 form a projected starting core that most managers would trade their entire bench to assemble, and Nacua and London both came at value, with London sliding past his ADP by a meaningful enough margin to feel like a gift. The discipline shows throughout. Jaylen Waddle fell 1.5 rounds before benwkoll grabbed him at WR23, and Xavier Worthy dropped nearly two full rounds to land at a back-end pick. Five values and zero reaches across the entire draft is not an accident, it is a manager who set a price for every player and had the patience to wait them out. Colston Loveland at TE3 anchors the rest of the lineup, and the weakest projected starter is Jayden Reed at WR48. That is the floor. Clean roster, clean process, legitimate contender.
