Stroud and Matthew Stafford offered decent value, the team's early reach for Justin Jefferson suggests a lack of strategic foresight. Despite stacking

Nico Collins with Stroud, the boost is minimal in the face of such overall mediocrity. As the season approaches, BGoebert's prospects appear grim, and they must brace for what could be another long year of battling to stay relevant amidst stronger competition.

35th percentile overall, the team will need to rely heavily on its running back strength to climb the standings and overcome its shortcomings at wide receiver and tight end. As they vie for success in a highly competitive environment, strategic play and injury management will be crucial for NorthernPlayalistic to make their mark this season.

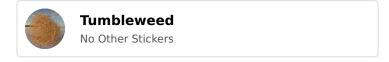

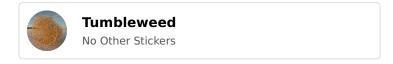
