Emiliano Lujano is sitting at 12th in the 10 Yard Fight division and the 7th percentile of the field, and the draft record explains why. Three major reaches in the first four rounds set the tone: Jayden Daniels at 1.10 when his ADP sat nearly a round and a half later, Malik Nabers a round and a half early at 2.03, and Sam LaPorta nearly two full rounds early at 4.03. Paying a premium for a QB5, WR12, and TE8 is not inherently fatal, but when those early-round overpays leave the rest of the roster thin, the math gets punishing fast. Mike Evans, now with San Francisco after a brutal injury-shortened season ended his consecutive 1,000-yard streak in Tampa, projects as a WR27 and represents the kind of late-round reclamation that was supposed to patch the gaps. It is not enough. Lujano found some genuine values at receiver down the stretch, but a projected starter at WR48 in Jayden Reed tells you everything about how shallow this roster gets when you scroll past the top names. The lever has already been pulled.

There is no flattering angle here. daniiq lands at 11th in the 10 Yard Fight division and sits in just the 7th percentile of the field, and the draft explains why. Eight minor reaches and three major reaches tell the story of a manager who kept bidding against themselves all night. The most glaring offense is Omar Cooper Jr., taken at WR60 a full four rounds ahead of his ADP, burning a tenth-round pick on a projected non-starter. That kind of impatience cascades. Breece Hall and Quinshon Judkins both cost more than they should have, tightening the budget just enough to leave the receiver group thin and topped by Rome Odunze at WR30 and Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31, with Jalen Coker projected as the weakest starter. Brock Bowers at TE1 is genuinely excellent and Joe Burrow is a real asset, but this roster looks like someone grabbed the foundation of a good team and then panicked through every round that followed. The 2025 record was 83rd percentile. That goodwill has been spent.

Vampiros Fronterizos arrive in the 10 Yard Fight sitting dead last in the division and in just the 19th percentile of the field, and the draft log does not offer much comfort. The decision to take Lamar Jackson at 1.06 when his ADP sat nearly a full round later set the tone for a draft that leaned more on want than on value, producing three major reaches against zero steals and only three values across the entire board. Blake Corum going three rounds before his number was called is the kind of swing that needs to pay off in a big way, and a RB35 projection suggests it will not. The receiver group grades out weak, with Davante Adams projected at WR25 as the clear top option and a significant dropoff to Michael Pittman at WR44 behind him. Managers in this format can field almost any mix of their best players, which means a thin top end simply has nowhere to hide. Vampiros Fronterizos are not in a rebuild. They are in a reckoning.

isamartinez sits ninth in the 10 Yard Fight division and in the 23rd percentile of the field, and the roster doesn't offer much of an argument against either number. The foundation is real, Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Drake London at WR7 give this team a ceiling worth respecting, but the supporting cast falls off a cliff in a hurry. The receiver group beyond London bottoms out at Jauan Jennings (WR63), Ryan Flournoy (WR69), and Brandon Aiyuk at WR81, names that project as depth pieces on competitive rosters. The draft didn't generate much relief either, just one steal across 20 picks, with the notable find being Oronde Gadsden sliding to TE16 in round 11. Against that, De'Zhaun Stribling was pulled three-plus rounds ahead of his ADP and projects as WR73. When your most aggressive draft swing lands you a WR73 and your projected weakest starter is Kenyon Sadiq at TE21, the math is unforgiving. McCaffrey alone cannot carry what looks like a bottom-third roster into contention.

Red_Bird_Gang enters 2026 sitting eighth in the 10 Yard Fight division, and the roster does not make a compelling case for a turnaround. The top end is genuinely impressive: Ja'Marr Chase projects as WR2, De'Von Achane as RB6, and Patrick Mahomes slots in as QB12, a trio that could carry a contender. The problem is the depth behind them falls off a cliff, and the draft did almost nothing to paper over that. Fourteen of the team's picks landed exactly at ADP, meaning the manager largely paid market price across the board, with only Alec Pierce and Stefon Diggs qualifying as genuine value finds. Meanwhile, Justin Fields was taken nearly four rounds early for a player projecting as QB38, a reach that burned a late pick that could have shored up the back of the roster. The weakest projected starter is Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47, and that ceiling tells the whole story. Great players at the top, not much runway beneath them, and a draft that offered no creative solutions.

The Oilers sit at 49th percentile, which is the fantasy equivalent of a perfectly acceptable lunch you'll forget by dinner. There is real talent here: Justin Jefferson at WR6 was a genuine draft-day gift, slipping to 2.04 when his ADP sat at 1.12, and the Kyler Murray stack gives this roster a ceiling most middle-of-the-pack teams cannot manufacture. Trey McBride at TE2 quietly anchors the back end of every optimal lineup. But the margins that will define this season lean toward the uncomfortable. Three major reaches dot the draft sheet, and the most glaring is Romeo Doubs at WR53 being drafted nearly two and a half rounds ahead of consensus, making him the projected weakest starter on a roster that cannot afford dead weight. Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and Kyren Williams at RB15 keep the floor respectable, but the gap between this team's best case and its most likely outcome is thinner than the manager would prefer. Nothing here breaks the tournament. Nothing here wins it, either.

Pittfx16 went into this draft and touched the hot stove three times, and the roster still looks pretty good, which is either vindication or a magic trick depending on how you want to tell it. The most glaring example is Jordan Love, taken at 5.02 when the consensus said QB17s belong nowhere near the fifth round, a full 2.3 rounds ahead of his ADP. That is a significant bet on a quarterback the market had thoroughly discounted. Then there is Ja'Kobi Lane, hauled in 4.7 rounds early, and Ray Davis, taken nearly four rounds before his number was called. The board screamed overpay on all three. And yet here sits a starting corps anchored by Josh Allen, a projected QB1, paired with A.J. Brown at WR8, Ashton Jeanty at RB7, and Harold Fannin at TE6, plus the Allen and D.J. Moore stack as a weekly multiplier. The 2025 résumé, 82nd percentile in scoring, suggests Pittfx16 has a feel for what works. Whether Love and the late reaches pay off determines if this is a contender or a cautionary tale.

Guillemort didn't win the draft on one flashy pick. They won it the same way a good poker player wins a session: small edges, accumulated quietly, round after round. Zay Flowers at WR16 was available a full round and a half after his ADP suggested he should be, and Saquon Barkley slid a full round to land at pick 4.02 as a projected RB8. Those aren't flukes, those are a manager who did their homework and waited. The stacking adds another layer of craft: Jaxson Dart pairs with Isaiah Likely, and Jared Goff locks in with Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, giving the lineup correlated upside on multiple nights. Yes, Dart was a reach at 3.11, and Zachariah Branch coming three rounds early in Round 13 carries real risk. But the rest of the board consistently came out ahead of consensus, and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 anchors a starting group that plays well above the team's 71st-percentile projection. Fifth in the division feels light.

Aatry didn't win the draft with one flashy move. They won it by being right, over and over. James Cook landed at RB5 despite slipping half a round past his ADP, Rashee Rice came off the board more than a full round late at WR13, and Colston Loveland at TE3 gives this roster an anchor at a position where the gap between the top options and everyone else is steep. Those aren't lottery tickets, they're consistent execution, the kind of drafting that quietly separates good rosters from great ones. The one area worth watching is Brock Purdy, who projects as QB13 but arrives with a crowded injury report around him: Kittle recovering from a torn Achilles, Ricky Pearsall's availability reportedly in question, and most of the rest of his supporting cast carrying some kind of concern. Purdy has shown he can produce through adversity, but the uncertainty is real. Still, sitting at 75th percentile in the field and fourth in the 10 Yard Fight division, Aatry built a roster that earns genuine respect before a single game is played.

carlossrarq finished 2025 at the 23rd percentile and came back with something to prove, and the 2026 draft card reads like a series of bold declarations made in public. Four major reaches, zero steals, the kind of sheet that gets you laughed out of a draft recap. And yet here we are: a WR group headlined by Nico Collins (WR9), Chris Olave (WR11), DeVonta Smith (WR14), Luther Burden (WR22), and Terry McLaurin (WR24) all projecting as starters, sitting at 81st percentile in the field and third in the division. The receiver corps alone represents a genuine construction achievement. The reaches tell the real story though, because Jaylen Wright (RB68) was taken six and a half rounds early, Zach Charbonnet (RB42) three rounds early, and carlossrarq did it anyway and landed Kyle Pitts (TE7) and Dallas Goedert (TE15) as values on the back end, with Goedert returning to Philadelphia on a one-year deal after quietly carrying the Eagles passing game. This roster does not look like luck. But conviction and luck have the same face until one of them fails.

JManuel didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't mortgage the middle rounds for one transcendent name. This roster was built on a quieter kind of competence, the kind that shows up when you tally six values against zero steals and realize the draft just quietly kept winning. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 slipping to the second pick, Puka Nacua at WR1 falling half a round, Mark Andrews arriving a round and a half later than his price tag suggested, none of those moves announced themselves, but together they assembled a starting core that lands this team at 83rd percentile in the field and second in the division. The weakness is real, Sam Darnold projects as QB21 and now faces a Seattle offense that leaned heavily on Jaxon Smith-Njigba while Kenneth Walker's departure leaves the backfield unsettled, which could constrain the passing game further. But in a positionless format, Nacua and Taylor give JManuel the kind of foundational production that makes a middling quarterback situation a manageable inconvenience rather than a crisis.

MeanMachine37 sits first in the 10 Yard Fight division and in the 88th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains why. This roster was built with patience and precision, six good values and a steal scattered across the board with only one minor reach and one major reach to account for. That major reach, Jalen Hurts at QB9, is the one place where MeanMachine37 paid up early, and it carries real risk: the offseason departure of AJ Brown to New England puts Hurts' arm under a microscope it has never faced through five consecutive top-10 fantasy finishes, and if the offense stumbles, his rushing touchdown floor takes a hit too. But the rest of the board is a clinic. Travis Hunter fell three full rounds past his ADP and landed at WR62, a gift by any measure. Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3, Tyler Warren as TE4, and Tucker Kraft as TE5, giving MeanMachine37 elite-level production at the top of the lineup. One reach, one question mark at quarterback, and a pile of value everywhere else. That is a clean draft.
