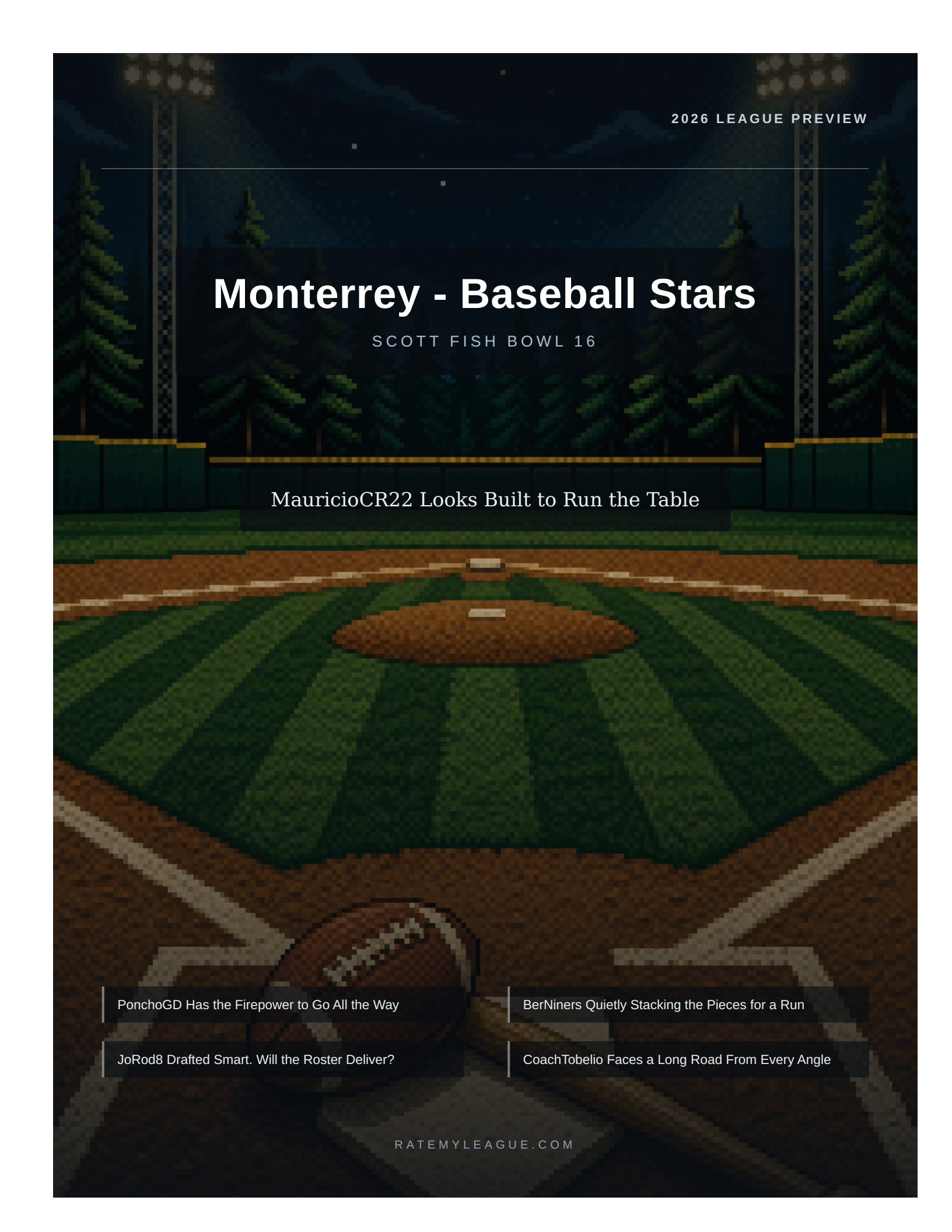

CoachTobelio lands in the 9th percentile of the field and dead last in the Baseball Stars division, and the draft sheet reads like a case study in how to lose before a ball is snapped. The most charitable version of this roster requires A.J. Brown to stay healthy, which, given that Brown has missed at least two games in five of his seven seasons, is the kind of optimism that belongs in a different sport entirely. He was reached on at pick 2.02 against an ADP of 2.10, so CoachTobelio paid a premium for the injury disclaimer upfront. The draft tendencies compound the damage: four major reaches against a single steal, including Darnell Washington pulled four-plus rounds early to project as TE38, and Jaxson Dart taken 1.3 rounds before the market agreed he was worth it to project as QB11. The one genuine find, Tre Tucker falling nearly three full rounds, lands at WR65 on the depth chart. A team that needed home runs got a lot of swings and one bloop single.

AlexHerrera sits 11th in the Baseball Stars division with a roster that projects near the bottom of the entire field, and the draft sheet does not offer much in the way of a silver lining. The reach count tells the story plainly: three major reaches, including Kyren Williams at RB15 taken nearly two rounds early and Justin Fields at QB38 burned in the 15th round at a price better suited for a top-ten signal-caller. Those draft-day gambles cannibalized capital that could have shored up a receiver room projecting well outside the top 75 at most spots. Justin Jefferson at WR6 is legitimately elite and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 gives this team a real foundation, but the supporting cast fades fast, with Kyle Monangai projected as the weakest projected starter at RB33 and names like Kayshon Boutte and Darnell Mooney filling out the back end. There is no obvious move left to salvage this, and barring an injury windfall somewhere in the field, AlexHerrera looks set for a long, grinding season.

There is no polite way to say this: GilMtz is in trouble. Sitting tenth in the Baseball Stars division and in just the 13th percentile of the field, this roster does not grade out as a quiet underdog waiting to surprise anyone. The foundation is real enough, with Christian McCaffrey projecting as RB3 and Drake London projecting as WR7, but the drop-off from those two to the rest of the projected starters is steep and mostly unforgiving. The draft did not help matters. Three major reaches across the roster represent value surrendered that cannot be clawed back, and the most glaring is Rico Dowdle, reached nearly two full rounds early and now projecting as RB32 after landing in Pittsburgh behind Jaylen Warren in an offense that offers him no clarity on a role. GilMtz went 13-23 last season and finished in the 23rd percentile in scoring, and nothing about this roster construction suggests the trajectory bends upward. The lever has already been pulled. The floor is where it landed.

JoRod8 did almost everything right in the draft. Fourteen chalk picks, two genuine values in Jayden Reed and Jalen McMillan, and not a single major reach anywhere on the board. The discipline was real. The result is a team sitting 9th in the Baseball Stars division and in just the 17th percentile of the field, which is the kind of outcome that makes you want to lie down and stare at the ceiling. The core is genuinely appealing: Ashton Jeanty at RB7, CeeDee Lamb at WR5, Zay Flowers at WR16, and DeVonta Smith, who finally gets his unobstructed shot as a true alpha after years of sharing the Eagles' target tree with AJ Brown, now in New England. That group should be producing. The problem is the supporting cast grades out thin enough that Reed, projected WR48, is the weakest projected starter, and two good values cannot paper over that ceiling. JoRod8 played the process correctly and got punished for it anyway. The draft does not owe anyone a trophy for good behavior.

marianasancam enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Baseball Stars division and in just the 37th percentile of the field, and the draft board does not offer much hope for a reversal. The headline is Josh Allen at QB1, a genuinely elite asset, but the supporting cast grades out as average across the board, and the draft process burned capital getting there. George Kittle cost a pick two-plus rounds ahead of his ADP to land a TE9, Tyjae Spears was grabbed nearly five rounds early for an RB47, and Rashid Shaheed was pulled forward two rounds to sit at WR57. Three major reaches in a single draft is not bad luck, it is a pattern, and it leaves the roster thin on upside precisely where depth picks should have been adding it. Jameson Williams falling to the seventh round was a genuine steal, and Nico Collins as a projected WR9 starter is a real weapon, but the rest of the projected starters grade out as middling. Last year's 64 percent win rate looks like a ceiling that this roster, as currently constructed, may struggle to approach.

Richard Raider enters 2026 sitting seventh in the Baseball Stars division and hovering around the 40th percentile of the field, and there is no obvious path to a dramatic reversal. The roster's best asset is a genuinely strong backfield headlined by Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, and the receiver group has real upside with George Pickens, Rashee Rice, and Tetairoa McMillan all projected as starters. But the draft sheet tells a concerning story beneath the surface. Raider made three major reaches, pulling Rice more than a round early and burning late picks on Kimani Vidal and Elic Ayomanor well ahead of consensus, which suggests the value-finding instincts were not clicking on draft day. Worse, the quarterback situation is quietly damning, with Matthew Stafford projecting as a QB14 and everyone behind him falling off a cliff into QB28 territory and beyond. In a positionless format where every lineup spot is a competition, carrying a QB14 as your ceiling is a ceiling that most contenders blow past without blinking. Raider is not without weapons, but the margin for error is thin and the draft did not help him find any.

Danielgt sits at 41st percentile and sixth in the division, which means every week probably comes down to a handful of points rather than a blowout in either direction. The foundation is genuinely strong: Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), Malik Nabers (WR12), and Tyler Warren (TE4) give this roster a ceiling that can beat almost anyone on a given Sunday. The problem is how those pieces were assembled. Nabers cost a round and a half more than his draft board suggested he was worth, and Michael Pittman (WR44) was taken more than two rounds early for a player projected outside the top 40 at his position. Those draft-day premiums left gaps elsewhere, and now the floor depends on how often the weaker projected starters actually deliver. Justin Herbert (QB8) was a reasonable value, and Christian Watson (WR28) falling nearly four rounds past his ADP is exactly the kind of late-round luck that can tilt a close season. Whether that luck is enough to climb out of the division's middle tier is the honest question hanging over Danielgt's entire 2026.

BerNiners didn't make headlines on draft day, and that's kind of the point. This is a team built on quiet competence, the kind that shows up when you tally the final ledger and realize the manager came out ahead almost every time they stepped to the board. The draft produced one steal, three values, and just four minor reaches against twelve chalk picks, a profile that says "disciplined" louder than any flashy move could. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 anchors a starting group that is genuinely hard to attack, and Tucker Kraft landing at TE5 despite falling nearly two rounds past his ADP is exactly the sort of low-drama win that compounds over a full tournament. Wan'Dale Robinson comes in as the projected weakest starter at WR47, but in a positionless format, a WR47 as your floor is a reasonable place to stand. The 56th percentile projection and fifth-place division standing suggest a team on the right side of average, not a lock for a deep run, but one that consistently gave itself the better end of the deal.

EstefyTDF didn't win the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft with a single thunderclap moment. They won it the way a good poker player wins a long session: by consistently getting the better end of the exchange. Puka Nacua at WR1 came off the board five picks after his ADP suggested he would. Lamar Jackson at QB3 slid just enough to feel like a gift. And then there is Alec Pierce, a big-play threat who has led the league in yards-per-reception two straight years, who fell nearly three full rounds past his ADP and landed at WR32 for a team that was happy to absorb the PUP list uncertainty in exchange for that kind of upside. Chase Brown at RB11 rounds out a core that is simply hard to argue with. The draft sheet shows 13 picks that came in at or better than market value against only five minor reaches, none of them damaging. EstefyTDF sits 77th percentile in the field and fourth in the Baseball Stars division. That is not a team that got lucky. That is a team that did its homework.

PacTamezTDF did not win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by staying ahead on transaction after transaction, and the cumulative effect lands them at the 88th percentile, third in the Baseball Stars division, coming off a 75-win-percentage season in 2025. The spine of this roster is genuinely elite: Bijan Robinson at RB2, De'Von Achane at RB6, and Saquon Barkley at RB8 form a top tier that most managers would trade their entire draft capital to assemble. But the quieter wins are what define the hook here. Dallas Goedert fell nearly two rounds past his ADP, and Brian Thomas Jr. slid a round and a half before PacTamezTDF stepped in at RB31. Those are not lottery tickets, those are managers leaving money on the table and this team picking it up. Bhayshul Tuten adds a compelling upside layer: with Travis Etienne now in New Orleans and Jacksonville's backfield genuinely open, Tuten's RB25 projection could be the most conservative number on this entire sheet. Nothing here screams. Everything here adds up.

PonchoGD sits second in the Baseball Stars division and in the 93rd percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why. The value thread running through this roster is relentless: Joe Burrow at QB4 slipped nearly a full round, Brock Purdy at QB13 fell another round on top of that, and Dalton Kincaid at TE11 came off the board a round and a half after the room had already moved on. Stack those with Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, Colston Loveland at TE3, and the Burrow-Chase and Purdy-Mike Evans stacks providing correlated upside, and you have a roster that reads like a case study in disciplined board management. The one blemish, a reach on Michael Mayer at TE39 taken nearly three and a half rounds early, barely registers against a backdrop of six players acquired at better-than-market price. When your weakest projected starter is Josh Downs at WR46, you have not left much room for criticism, and PonchoGD has not.

MauricioCR22 sits first in the Baseball Stars division and in the 96th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The headline is discipline: seven good values, one steal, and zero major reaches across the board. Marvin Harrison Jr. landed at WR33 after falling nearly two rounds past his ADP, Rome Odunze came in at WR30 after sliding a round and a half, and Davante Adams at WR25 followed the same pattern. Each one arrived because MauricioCR22 was patient enough to let the board do the work. The steal of the draft is Quentin Johnston at WR41, grabbed two full rounds after where the field valued him, a pick that looks less like luck and more like a manager who had already done his homework. Anchor the whole roster with Brock Bowers at TE1 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10, and the foundation is as clean as it gets. The two minor reaches on Zach Charbonnet and Jack Bech are barely worth noting against an otherwise airtight sheet. This is what intentional drafting looks like.
