TylerFFF enters 2026 sitting 12th in the NBA 2K Series division and in just the 9th percentile of the field, and the roster offers few reasons for optimism. The brightest light is Justin Jefferson at WR6, a legitimate difference-maker, but the support structure around him is where the wheels loosen. The draft was all chalk, zero steals, zero values, and featured a pair of major reaches that failed to upgrade the team in any meaningful way. Kyle Monangai, reached 2.2 rounds early, grades out as the weakest projected starter at RB33, which is a rough return on that kind of currency. Derrick Henry at RB12 is serviceable but not a difference-maker at that rank, and the tight end situation anchors the bottom of the roster with AJ Barner and Greg Dulcich projecting outside the top 20. Jefferson is real, and the Jayden Daniels/Terry McLaurin stack has genuine upside, but good stacks do not rescue a 9th-percentile roster. TylerFFF is not building toward something this season. They are just hoping something goes right.

avigoldstein15 is sitting 11th in the NBA 2K Series division and in the 14th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer many obvious escape routes. The draft was a study in restraint gone wrong: zero steals, zero values, and two major reaches that sting on inspection. Jordan Love came off the board at 5.02 despite projecting as QB17, and Theo Johnson cost a 14th-round pick for what grades out as TE37. Those are the kinds of draft-day decisions that leave a manager with no margin for error elsewhere. Malik Nabers, projected WR12 and a legitimate star when healthy, could theoretically be that margin, but his ACL recovery has been complicated enough that even his return to full speed for Week 1 is not guaranteed, and his chemistry with Jaxson Dart is untested. Saquon Barkley projects as RB8 and Josh Allen grades out as the tournament's top quarterback, so this is not a hopeless roster. It is, however, one where the ceiling depends almost entirely on things avigoldstein15 cannot control, and the floor is uncomfortably close to where the team already stands.

BallBlastEm came into this draft from 91st-percentile scoring a year ago and somehow left it looking like a team that lost a bet. The reach pattern alone tells the story: four major reaches, three minor reaches, one steal, and the one steal was Malik Willis at QB24, which is not exactly the kind of value that earns a drafter a curtain call. The headliner, Justin Herbert at QB8, cost a second-round pick when he was a third-rounder on the board, and the Herbert situation is genuinely complicated, because Mike McDaniels arriving in Los Angeles does add intrigue but the Chargers have won 11 games in each of the last two seasons by running the ball and playing disciplined football, which is not a formula that inflates a QB8 projection into something worth that price. Meanwhile, Makai Lemon at WR40 was drafted nearly two and a half rounds before the market priced him, and Jack Bech at WR94 cost four full rounds of premium. Ja'Marr Chase and Colston Loveland are real, but BallBlastEm paid so far over

market everywhere else that the roster now sits 10th in the division and 21st percentile in the field. The floor fell out slowly, pick by pick.

bytiac did almost everything right in the draft. Fourteen chalk picks, only three minor reaches, and the value column includes Wan'Dale Robinson falling more than two full rounds past his ADP. The problem is that doing everything right still left this roster sitting at 26th percentile in the field, which is the kind of outcome that should come with a formal apology from the universe. The backfield is genuinely excellent, Bijan Robinson at RB2 and De'Von Achane at RB6 anchoring a group that runs five projected starters deep. But this is a positionless format, and the top of the receiver depth chart is Michael Pittman at WR44, with Josh Downs at WR46 and Robinson at WR47 filling out the rest. Those were smart, late-round acquisitions. They are also just not good enough to carry the weight the receiver group needs to carry. Lawrence, Shough, and McCarthy project as QB10, QB20, and QB37 respectively. The pieces were assembled carefully and inexpensively, and they still do not add up. That is the cruelest thing a draft can do to a manager.

SalLeto finished 2025 in the 93rd percentile, and the 2026 roster has the audacity to show up dressed like a different team entirely. The projection sits at the 31st percentile, eighth in the division, and the draft tells you a lot about why. The clearest symptom is Bhayshul Tuten, a RB25 whom SalLeto drafted 2.2 rounds ahead of consensus, burning a sixth-round pick on a player most managers were comfortable waiting on until the eighth. Meanwhile, the receiver group is anchored by genuine talent, CeeDee Lamb at WR5, Garrett Wilson at WR17, and Tee Higgins at WR19, but it thins out fast, with KC Concepcion sitting at WR50 as the projected weakest starter. Joe Burrow and Higgins as a stack gives this team a real ceiling, and Harold Fannin at TE6 is legitimately good. The bones are there. But last year's 67 percent win rate built a reputation that the current projections are quietly, methodically dismantling, and SalLeto will need the ceiling to show up early and often.

Sitting seventh in the NBA 2K Series division and projected at just the 35th percentile of the field, bferrer is staring at a ceiling that feels more like a floor. The foundation here is real, Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1 and Caleb Williams grades out as QB6, but after those two the roster gets thin in a hurry. The draft did not help matters much: nineteen picks produced zero steals, and the most consequential reach was Jordan Mason, taken three full rounds ahead of his ADP and currently projecting as RB41. David Montgomery, brought in to push for a lead role in Houston after getting squeezed out in Detroit, slots in at RB23, but he is already a minor reach and now enters a competition with Woody Marks that is far from settled. Chris Olave at WR11 is the one genuine secondary asset, a slight value pickup, but Marvin Harrison Jr. projecting at WR33 and Denzel Boston at WR58 represent the kind of receiver depth that asks Gibbs and Williams to carry an awful lot of weight with very little margin for error.

Tylerj07 is a team that exists in the exact temperature of lukewarm water, comfortably sixth in the NBA 2K Series division at the 39th percentile, which is the fantasy equivalent of finishing a race and being handed a participation ribbon that reads "we saw you out there." The margins that define this season cut both ways. On the upside, Drake Maye at QB2 and Trey McBride at TE2 give this roster a genuine ceiling, two projected starters who operate at the very top of their positions and can carry a week almost by themselves. The problem is that the supporting cast asks a lot of faith. Chuba Hubbard, the projected weakest starter at RB29, is the player who decides whether this team wins the close ones or loses them, and Tylerj07 paid a round early to get him. Meanwhile, the 2025 résumé, a 6-30 record in the second scoring percentile, is not a foundation so much as a warning. Maye and McBride are real. Everything else is a margin, and margins in this format are where seasons quietly disappear.

lucaswencil didn't need a miracle pick to build something worth watching in the NBA 2K Series. The foundation is a receiver corps that holds up at both ends: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and A.J. Brown at WR8 give this team a ceiling that most managers in the field can't match, and the Goff stacks running through both of them add a bonus layer of upside when Detroit has a big week. The draft itself reflected the same steady competence, picking up Chase Brown as a genuine value at RB11 and landing Cam Ward later than his ADP suggested. There were no heists, but there were no disasters either, and in an 18-round draft that discipline compounds. The 2025 campaign backed the approach up, a 90th-percentile scoring finish that confirmed this isn't a team built on luck. Quentin Johnston at WR41 is the projected starter you'd most want to upgrade, but a lineup anchored by St. Brown and Brown doesn't ask Johnston to carry anything he can't handle.

robbsilv33 didn't swing for the fences and whiff, didn't reach for upside and pay for it later. They just kept coming out ahead, pick after pick. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 slipping to the 2.05 when his ADP sat at 2.01 is a small edge, but small edges compounded across a draft are how rosters like this get built. The projected starting group runs from Christian McCaffrey at RB3 through Kenneth Walker III at RB10, Josh Jacobs at RB16, and Travis Etienne at RB18, with Jadarrian Price at RB26 sitting as the weakest projected starter, which tells you something about how deep this goes. Dak Prescott falling nearly a full round past his ADP adds a QB7 for the price of a QB who should have cost more. Even Oronde Gadsden at TE16, now navigating a tighter target share after the Chargers signed David Njoku, gives this team a legitimate contributor at the position. The draft grade is clean: fifteen chalk, three values, no major reaches. Fourth in the division at the 58th percentile feels like a floor that should get tested.

There was no moment in this draft where @Watch101NFL swung for the fences and missed badly, and there was no moment where they stumbled into a generational steal either. What they did was grind out a roster that looks genuinely competitive from top to bottom. Brock Bowers at TE1, James Cook at RB5, and Jalen Hurts at QB9 give this team a top-end foundation most managers would take without blinking, and the supporting cast holds up under scrutiny. Chris Godwin fell a round and a half past his ADP into their lap at WR38, and Kyle Pitts, who turned skeptics into believers with a top-5 finish at tight end last season, brings real upside to a starting group that is already loaded. The one moment where @Watch101NFL got aggressive was Xavier Worthy, taken nearly three rounds ahead of his ADP and projecting as a WR49, which makes him the most tenuous piece of the puzzle. But one shaky pick in an otherwise disciplined draft is a reasonable price of admission. A 67th-percentile projection and third in the division is a floor this roster looks built to exceed.

Jeremy1982 sits second in the NBA 2K Series division and lands in the 95th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: six values, fourteen chalk, zero reaches. Not a single pick where Jeremy overpaid, which sounds simple until you realize how many managers talk themselves into a guy at the wrong price. The values are spread across the roster but the best ones cluster at the top of the lineup, where it actually matters. Jaylen Waddle fell more than a round past his ADP before Jeremy scooped him at WR23. Travis Kelce, a projected starter at TE10, slipped a full round too. Matthew Stafford dropped nearly a round and a half. Every one of those is a guy who would have been reasonable at his consensus price, and Jeremy got each of them cheaper. With Jaxon Smith-Njigba projecting as WR3, Drake London at WR7, and George Pickens at WR10 rounding out the core, the floor here is uncomfortably high. The weakest projected starter is Jakobi Meyers at WR45, which says everything you need to know about how well this came together.

StephenMurphy sits at the top of the NBA 2K Series division and in the 99th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The foundation is airtight: Puka Nacua at WR1 and Lamar Jackson at QB3 give this roster a ceiling most managers are still dreaming about in round two, and Jackson himself was a value, slipping past his ADP to land at 2.10. Then StephenMurphy just kept finding money on the floor. Tyler Warren fell a full round and a half to 4.10, a genuine steal for a TE4 projection. Nico Collins at WR9 and Luther Burden at WR22 round out a starting group that would be the envy of the division on its own. Across the entire draft, twenty picks produced seven values, one outright steal, and not a single reach. That is not luck, that is process. Some teams win the offseason by accident. StephenMurphy won it with a plan.
