The Flint City Tropics enter 2026 sitting at the 6th percentile of the field, and nothing about this draft suggests that number is about to move in the right direction. The most damning evidence is not what they got but how they got it: zero steals, zero values, eight chalk picks, and ten reaches across the board, including two major ones. Taking Chris Olave at WR11 nearly a full round early would be defensible if it secured a foundational piece, but Olave is a receiver whose best NFL season might already be behind him, and paying a premium for that kind of uncertainty is exactly the wrong lesson this draft teaches on repeat. The tight end group anchored by Brock Bowers at TE1, Kyle Pitts at TE7, and Isaiah Likely at TE13 is genuinely excellent and should carry the lineup on good weeks, but surrounding Bowers with an overpaid WR corps and a running back room that bottoms out at RB34 with Kenneth Gainwell means this team is one injury away from freefall. Last year's 64 percent win rate looks like a ceiling, not a floor.

BoomshakaNiner sits 11th in the NBA Jam division and in the 9th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record explains why: zero steals, zero minor reaches, four major reaches, and fourteen chalk picks across the board. The most charitable thing you can say about this roster is that Tyler Warren (TE4) and Harold Fannin (TE6) are genuinely excellent, and BoomshakaNiner paid early for both, reaching nearly a round on Warren at pick 2.05 and almost two rounds on Fannin at 3.08. That's a lot of draft capital chasing one corner of a positionless format. Meanwhile, the top-end punch that wins these tournaments is thin: Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) is legitimately elite, but after him the projected starters include Jayden Reed (WR48) as the weakest link, and the QB situation with Ty Simpson (QB36) is the kind of situation that doesn't get described with the word "situation" unless something has gone badly wrong. Mike Evans signed with San Francisco carrying the scar tissue of an injury-shortened 2025

campaign and a broken streak, and asking him to anchor anything at WR27 is faith over evidence. This roster didn't get built. It happened to someone.

erichardter did almost everything right in the draft, which makes the 20th percentile projection feel less like a verdict and more like a bad joke. Eighteen chalk picks, one minor reach on Ashton Jeanty at RB7 that barely registered, and the steal of the entire draft in Aaron Rodgers at QB29 taken four-plus rounds past his ADP, a find most managers would frame. The Dak Prescott and CeeDee Lamb stack gives the roster a legitimate ceiling piece, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 is a quietly useful anchor. But the math keeps coming out wrong. The projected starters are fine, not great, and the team sits 10th in the division with a floor that looks uncomfortably familiar to anyone who watched the 2025 season produce a 36 percent win rate. That year's roster was not obviously broken either. This is the cruelest kind of draft outcome, one where you followed the rules, collected the value, and still end up holding a ticket that probably does not get you anywhere.

bdduff did almost everything right in the draft room. Bo Nix, David Njoku, and Hunter Henry all fell past their ADPs, and the roster is littered with chalk picks that came in right on schedule. Thirteen chalk picks, three values, one steal, and the team still lands at 30th percentile and ninth in the NBA Jam division, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether the universe has a sense of humor. The top end is real: Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Drake London at WR7 give this roster a genuine ceiling, and Derrick Henry at RB12 still commands respect. But the floor collapses fast. Wan'Dale Robinson projects as the weakest starter at WR47, and the tight end group maxes out at Henry at TE18, a middling number in a format where tight end production can swing weeks. bdduff got value, avoided disaster on most picks, and built a roster that simply does not add up. Sometimes the math just hates you.

TheSpatula300 sits at 31st percentile and eighth in the NBA Jam division, and the roster explains exactly why. The receiver group is legitimately strong, headlined by Jaxon Smith-Njigba (WR3) and A.J. Brown (WR8), but that positional strength runs headlong into a draft approach that offered almost no margin for error. Of 20 picks, not a single one graded as a steal, and the one player taken well ahead of his ADP was Jalen Tolbert, a WR102 projection grabbed nearly six rounds early. That is not a high-upside gamble, that is burning a late pick on a wishful thinking flier. The quarterback situation, meanwhile, tops out at Trevor Lawrence as a QB10, which is serviceable but hardly the kind of difference-maker a bottom-tier roster needs to climb. Lawrence, Jared Goff, and Baker Mayfield form a QB room that projects to average, not exploit. When your best hope is that Smith-Njigba and Brown outscore the field by themselves, you are not building a contender, you are crossing your fingers.

LeviChappell is a team that will live and die by the margins, and right now the margins are genuinely unclear. The receiver group is the foundation: Ja'Marr Chase (WR2), George Pickens (WR10), Malik Nabers (WR12), and Rashee Rice (WR13) project as four of the better options at the position in the entire field, and the depth behind them gives this roster real staying power through the grind of a long tournament. The problem is that the supporting cast introduces real uncertainty. J.K. Dobbins (RB36), the weakest projected starter, was taken almost two rounds ahead of his ADP, and a 2025 finish in the 14th percentile of scoring is a number that does not simply disappear because the calendar changed. The draft leaned heavily on chalk, with only three genuine values and no steals, which means there is little hidden upside waiting to surface. Seventh in the NBA Jam division and 44th

percentile overall, LeviChappell is not a pretender, but they are not a threat either. Chase and company give them a floor. Whether they have a ceiling is the question.

TheBenEby finished at 47th percentile last season and is projected to land in exactly the same spot in 2026, which is either a sign of roster stability or a warning that the ceiling has already been found. The case for optimism runs through the top of the lineup: Joe Burrow sits at QB4, Trey McBride anchors the tight end group at TE2, and Omarion Hampton projects as RB9. That is a legitimate core. The problem is that the roster thins out quickly after those names, and in a positionless format where every starting spot is earned on merit, the back half of the depth chart matters more than it looks. Terry McLaurin projects at WR24 and Dalton Kincaid, when healthy, adds real value as a TE11, but Kincaid has barely stayed on the field in recent seasons and the Bills themselves sound uncertain about his availability. The margins are thin enough here that one injury, one underperformance from Hampton or McBride, and a middling season tips into a frustrating one.

Donnyshea finished 61 percent of their games last season and arrives in 2026 with a roster that looks better than fifth in the NBA Jam division suggests, built almost entirely on conviction. The draft sheet is not pretty: four major reaches, three minor reaches, zero steals. And yet the result is a starting group headlined by Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, a three-quarterback room where Jayden Daniels and Jalen Hurts project as starters and Patrick Mahomes sits behind them, and a tight end corps that is genuinely difficult to argue with, running from Colston Loveland at TE3 down through Tucker Kraft, Travis Kelce, and Dallas Goedert. Hurts, the clearest value on the board, slid nearly two rounds past his ADP before donnyshea grabbed him, then immediately became the anchor of a Hurts-Goedert stack. Kaelon Black was taken nearly nine rounds before his ADP and represents either the most alarming reach on the roster or the most inspired one, and nobody knows which yet. That uncertainty is the whole draft in miniature: the board said wait, donnyshea said no, and somehow it worked.

jaymstein7 didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. The win came from doing the small things right, round after round. The clearest example is De'Von Achane, a projected RB6 locked into the starting lineup, paired with Breece Hall at RB14 and Bucky Irving at RB21, the latter a genuine value after sliding more than a round past his ADP. At the top of the roster, Josh Allen anchors everything, and the stack with D.J. Moore gives jaymstein7 a built-in multiplier on Buffalo's best offensive moments. Tetairoa McMillan and Zay Flowers project as WR15 and WR16 respectively, meaning the supporting cast behind Allen isn't really supporting cast at all. The draft skews heavily toward chalk, which in another context might read as timid, but when your chalk includes an RB6 and a QB1, it mostly just reads as correct. Sitting fourth in the NBA Jam division and at the 63rd percentile tournament-wide, this roster belongs in the conversation, quietly built to stay there.

After finishing in the 11th percentile last season, paulie23ny went to work, and the 2026 roster reads like a direct response to that misery. The centerpiece is a backfield that would make most managers weep with envy: Christian McCaffrey at RB3, Jonathan Taylor at RB4, and Saquon Barkley at RB8 are all projected starters, giving this team a ceiling that simply did not exist a year ago. Kenneth Walker III, projected RB10 and a starter, came in nearly a round later than his ADP suggested he would, which is the kind of quiet draft-room win that separates good managers from great ones. The recipe here is straightforward and convincing: load up on elite talent, field the best available on any given week, and let the quality speak for itself. Sitting third in the division and in the 64th percentile of the field, paulie23ny is not just recovered from 2025, the team is positioned to make people forget that season ever happened.

There was no blockbuster move here, no panic button, no single pick that defined the draft. @TheJohnLaPresto just kept coming out ahead, round after round, and the cumulative effect is a roster that sits second in the NBA Jam division and at the 77th percentile of the field. The backbone is a backfield anchored by Bijan Robinson, a projected RB2, and supplemented by Josh Jacobs at RB16 and TreVeyon Henderson at RB19, both projected starters secured without overpaying. Then consider that Drake Maye, a projected QB2, slid more than a full round past his ADP and landed at 3.04, and Caleb Williams, a projected QB6, did nearly the same at 4.09. Collecting two quarterbacks ranked that high at a discount is not a coincidence, it is a draft that kept its composure while others reached. Coming off a 28th-percentile scoring season in 2025, LaPresto needed a reset, and this roster, built on consistent value rather than any single gamble, looks like exactly that.

jaymitch84 sits atop the NBA Jam division and at the 100th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. This is not a lucky roster. It is a constructed one. The centerpiece is Lamar Jackson, a QB3 projection snagged nearly a full round after his ADP, and Chase Brown, a projected RB11 taken a full 1.3 rounds late. Both are projected starters, both were available longer than they should have been, and jaymitch84 was patient enough to take them. Kyren Williams and David Montgomery round out a starting-caliber backfield core that was also acquired at a discount, and the draft-value ledger reads like a masterclass in board discipline: two steals, ten values, eight chalk, and not a single reach anywhere on the sheet. Puka Nacua anchors the receiving group as a projected WR1. The 2025 season was respectable but ordinary. The 2026 construction is anything but.
