As Ijconforti embarks on their 2025 fantasy football journey, the outlook appears challenging. With a division rank of 12 and sitting in the 21st percentile overall, the team faces an uphill battle. Their strength lies in a noteworthy stable of running backs, headlined by Jahmyr Gibbs, who is expected to carry the load alongside Kenneth Walker III, Tony Pollard, and Isiah Pacheco. This formidable backfield is the backbone of the team's potential success. However, the wide receiver corps leaves much to be desired, with A.J. Brown as the lone standout amongst a lackluster group that includes Josh Downs and Darnell Mooney, the latter being their most glaring weakness. The tight end position offers some redemption, as George Kittle and Dalton Kincaid provide reliable options in this TE Premium league setup, though reaching for Zach Ertz earlier than ideal might prove costly. Notably, Demario Douglas offers some hidden value after being drafted later than anticipated. Yet, questionable draft decisions, such as reaching substantially for Isaiah Davis and Darius Slayton,

have left the team lacking depth. As the season unfolds, ljonforti will need to overcome these hurdles and hope their strengths can compensate for their weaknesses in what promises to be a demanding competition.
