As Bulldozer13 gears up for the 2025 fantasy football season, they find themselves in an intriguing position after a stellar 2024 campaign. As a projected starter but potentially the weakest link, his ability to deliver in crucial moments could determine the team's fate. Draft strategy has been a double-edged sword for Bulldozer13, as they managed to secure great value on players like Caleb Williams and Deebo Samuel, while reaching significantly early for key contributors such as Josh Jacobs. The decisions made during the draft will undoubtedly play a critical role in shaping their journey. As the season unfolds, Bulldozer13's path will hinge on the synergy between their elite tight ends and dynamic running backs, while hoping for an unexpected surge from their underwhelming wide receiver unit. Whether they can capitalize on their strengths and overcome their weaknesses remains to be seen, making their 2025 season one to watch closely.

Drafting David Montgomery earlier than his ADP suggests the team's commitment to shoring up this position with reliable contributors. Razorback12's journey this season will be an intriguing one, as they look to rise from their middling division standing and strive for a higher percentile finish. With a few strategic hits in the draft and key performances from their standout players, there's potential for this team to exceed expectations.
