DynastyGirlDad sits fourth percentile in the field and dead last in the Skyrim division, and the draft log explains exactly how it happened. This roster was built on the reach, over and over, with four major reaches and three minor ones against zero steals and one value. The damage shows up most clearly in the middle of the draft, where Jameson Williams came off the board 1.6 rounds early and Mike Evans followed 2.2 rounds ahead of his price, burning the kind of capital that builds competitive rosters into picks that the market had already discounted. Williams projects as a WR21 and Evans as a WR27, which are functional starters but not the difference-makers that justify the premium paid. The one genuine bright spot, Brock Bowers at TE1, was inherited rather than engineered, arriving as consensus chalk while the surrounding decisions quietly bled this roster dry. Quentin Johnston projects as the weakest starter at WR41, a fitting capstone to a draft where the biggest swings landed the softest.

There is no polite way to say this: knightofni222 is projected 11th in the Skyrim division and sits in just the 9th percentile of the entire field, and the draft did not do much to change the trajectory. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba (WR3), Chris Olave (WR11), and Jaylen Waddle (WR23) forming a legitimate core, but the draft spending that built that depth came at a cost. Parker Washington (WR35), Jalen Coker (WR55), and Rashid Shaheed (WR57) were all taken well ahead of their ADPs, some by more than three rounds, which means knightofni222 burned early capital chasing receivers who grade out as fringe contributors at best. That aggressive posture left the quarterback room in ruins: Bryce Young (QB26), Fernando Mendoza (QB27), and Deshaun Watson (QB34) are three of the least threatening options a manager could assemble, and in a positionless format where quarterback production feeds directly into your total score, that is a slow leak that no amount of Smith-Njigba magic can fully plug.

FatShady sits 10th in the Skyrim division and in the 11th percentile of the field, and the draft record explains exactly why: five major reaches, five minor reaches, eight chalk picks, and not a single steal on the board. The reach pattern is what really indicts this thing. Zachariah Branch was taken 3.8 rounds ahead of his ADP, Ja'Kobi Lane went 3.0 rounds early, and Ray Davis was pulled 3.5 rounds before the market said he was worth touching. Those are not bold swings that happened to cost a little draft equity, those are the moves of a manager who fell in love with names and let the board fall apart around them. Josh Allen at QB1 is genuinely excellent, and Nico Collins, Tetairoa McMillan, and Garrett Wilson form a projected starting group worth respecting. But the floor under this roster was built with overpays, and when the early-round anchors are surrounded by reaches stacked on reaches, even a strong top end starts to feel like very expensive window dressing on a condemned building.

QuinMyers sits ninth in the Skyrim division and in the 37th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet does not offer much reason for optimism. The roster carries two major reaches, Matthew Golden at WR52 and Elijah Sarratt at WR98, both taken several rounds ahead of consensus, which means QuinMyers paid future-pick premiums for players the market had ranked as late-round fliers. The top of the roster is genuinely good: Bijan Robinson projects as RB2, A.J. Brown as WR8, and Malik Nabers as WR12, and a Caleb Williams stack with Luther Burden adds a nice ceiling play. But after that promising core, the drop-off is steep and the depth thins quickly toward the back of the roster. The weakest projected starter, Dalton Schultz at TE22, signals where the floor lives. There are no steals in the draft log, only chalk and reaches, which means QuinMyers has already spent the leverage most managers use to climb out of a hole like this one.

fantasymeatball drafted with genuine discipline, taking 15 picks at chalk and snagging Bucky Irving at RB21 a full 2.7 rounds after his ADP, which is the kind of patient, process-sound drafting that fantasy writers celebrate in August. And yet here the team sits at 39th percentile, eighth in the Skyrim division, and the gap between the inputs and the output is hard to explain away. Justin Jefferson projects as WR6 and Kyle Pitts as TE7, so the top of the roster has real teeth. The problem is the attrition below that tier: Christian Watson at WR28, Jayden Higgins at WR54, and a projected starting lineup that leans heavily on players whose ranks demand optimism more than evidence. The Baker Mayfield and Emeka Egbuka stack gives the team a correlation play, but Mayfield projecting as QB18 means fantasymeatball is betting on receiver upside while the quarterback himself is barely a league-winner. Doing almost everything right and still landing near the bottom half of the field is the draft equivalent of reading the map perfectly and still missing the exit.

TNSeaGal arrives in the Skyrim Division sitting seventh and at the 41st percentile of the field, and the roster does not suggest those numbers are about to climb. The real problem is at receiver, where the projected starters top out at Davante Adams at WR25 and Rome Odunze at WR30, and then the group slides quickly toward Michael Pittman as the WR44 weakest projected starter, a floor that will cost points week after week. The draft offered almost no relief, producing zero steals and only two values across the entire board, while the one move that stood out for the wrong reasons was burning a pick on Chimere Dike three full rounds before his ADP. Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 are genuine pillars, and Tucker Kraft projects as a strong TE5, but premium assets at a couple of spots cannot paper over a receiving group this thin at the top. Coming off a 66th percentile scoring season in 2025, TNSeaGal needed to upgrade the margins in this draft. It did not, and the standings are likely to reflect that.

ThatKidFett didn't swing for the fences and whiff, didn't load up on upside plays that need three things to go right before they pay off. The draft just kept coming out ahead, round after round, and the roster reflects it. Puka Nacua at WR1 anchors the whole operation, and Harold Fannin at TE6 pairs with Dallas Goedert at TE15 to give this team a genuine advantage at a position where most managers are papering over a weak spot. Goedert is easy to underrate after some noise about his future in Philadelphia, but he stayed, and he showed last year what he can do in the fantasy playoffs when it matters. The running back group adds Derrick Henry at RB12 and Kyren Williams at RB15, both of whom slipped past their ADPs and landed here instead. There are no jaw-dropping steals in this draft, but three genuine values and only one major reach is the kind of quiet, consistent edge that compounds. This team came out ahead at the table, and it shows up in the projections.

The Fus Ro Dawgs didn't swing for the fences and whiff, they just kept making the right call at the right time, and the cumulative effect is a roster that sits comfortably in the 78th percentile of the field. The foundation is a running back group that would make most managers jealous: James Cook at RB5 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 are both projected starters, and Jeanty came at a discount, sliding 1.2 rounds past his ADP before this team pounced at 3.12. Tyrone Tracy is the quieter win, a player who fell all the way to 17.12 despite an ADP of 14.09, landing a projected RB43 essentially for free. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 anchors the receiver group and stacks beautifully with projected starter Jared Goff, giving this team a built-in scoring correlation that can swing a week. The late-round reaching on depth pieces like Ted Hurst is a minor blemish, but when your high-end talent was acquired this efficiently, a few aggressive fliers at the back of the draft are easy to forgive.

Bogle0904 lands at 79th percentile in the field, and the case for that ranking is less about one signature move and more about a draft that kept finding the right price again and again. De'Von Achane at RB6 slid a full round past his ADP before Bogle0904 scooped him at 3.10. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 fell nearly two spots and landed at 2.03. Dalton Kincaid, projected as a starter at TE11, came off the board almost two rounds late. Seven values across the roster is not luck, it is a manager who came in with a number in mind and had the discipline to wait. The two major reaches, Kenneth Gainwell and Skyler Bell, keep this from being a flawless grade, but neither dents the starting lineup in a meaningful way. The projected starter floor, anchored by Achane, Breece Hall at RB14, and Lamb, is legitimately difficult to argue with. Fourth in the Skyrim division feels conservative for a team built this carefully.

HammerJacks didn't need a single audacious swing to land in the 85th percentile of this field, and that restraint is precisely what makes this roster worth respecting. The draft was a quiet accumulation of edges: Jayden Daniels at QB5 slid nearly a full round past his ADP, Jeremiyah Love at RB13 fell more than a round into their lap, and George Kittle at TE9 came a round late to a manager who was clearly paying attention. Stack those gains together and you have the blueprint for a team that consistently drafted the room rather than fighting it. The tight end group alone, with Trey McBride at TE2, Kittle at TE9, and Sam LaPorta at TE8 all projecting as starters, gives HammerJacks a week-to-week baseline that most of the Skyrim division cannot match. Calvin Ridley at WR78 stands out as the one moment the board was forced rather than read, but one reach across a full draft is a footnote, not a flaw. Third in the division is the current projection, but the process behind this roster suggests the ceiling is higher.

Bstephens77 didn't stumble into correlation, this roster was engineered around it. The crown jewel is the Joe Burrow and Ja'Marr Chase stack, a pairing that puts two of fantasy's most dangerous weapons on the same trigger. When Burrow slings it and Chase catches it, both scores climb together, and that's exactly the kind of ceiling multiplier that wins weeks in a field this competitive. Travis Etienne, snagged more than two rounds after his ADP, gives the roster a legitimate RB18 contributor acquired at a discount, padding the floor underneath those boom-game projections. The question mark wrapped inside all of this is Rashee Rice, projected WR13 and a projected starter, but carrying a mountain of off-field uncertainty into 2026 after a suspension, a knee procedure, and now a reported probation violation. If Rice is healthy and active when it matters, he turns a strong supporting cast into something genuinely dangerous. If he isn't, the stack still works, it just has less company at the top. Currently sitting second in the Skyrim division and in the 90th percentile of the field, this team has the architecture to go deep.

Rusher34 sits first in the Skyrim division and in the 92nd percentile of the entire field, and the draft record explains exactly why: five values, fifteen chalk, and not a single reach anywhere on the board. That is not luck, that is discipline. The foundation is Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8, two projected starters who give this lineup a ceiling most managers would trade half their roster to acquire. But the sharper story is what Rusher34 did in the middle and late rounds, landing Patrick Mahomes at QB12 nearly two rounds after his ADP, Omarion Hampton at RB9 almost two rounds late, and Jonah Coleman at RB51 a full two-and-a-half rounds past where the rest of the field valued him. Tyler Warren at TE4 anchors the position. Even the projected weakest starter, RJ Harvey at RB28, is a player most teams would be comfortable deploying. There is no soft underbelly here, just a manager who knew what things were worth and waited until the board agreed.
